### Catechetical Sunday



PLEASE JOIN US FOR CATECHETICAL SUNDAY – SEPT. 18, 11:00AM MASS

**"THIS IS MY BODY GIVEN FOR YOU"  
LUKE 22:19**

Catechetical Sunday is a wonderful opportunity to reflect on the role that each person plays, by virtue of Baptism, in handing on the faith and being a witness to the Gospel. This year, the Church will celebrate Catechetical Sunday on September 18, and the theme is *"This is my body given for you."* Those who the parish community has designated to serve a catechists will be called forth to be commissioned for the ministry.

The Eucharist is the source and summit of the Christian life. The term "Eucharist" originates from the Greek word eucharistia, meaning thanksgiving. In the celebration of the Eucharist, bread and wine become the Body and Blood of Jesus Christ through the power of the Holy Spirit and the instrumentality of the priest. The whole Christ is truly present – body, blood, soul, and divinity – under the appearance of bread and wine, the glorified Christ who rose from the dead. This is what the Church means when she speaks of the "Real Presence" of Christ in the Eucharist

Reading for September 11, 2022

Luke 15:1-10

- Listen/ Read (*Lectio*): Ponder God's word and listen for what touches your heart.
- Meditate (*Meditatio*): Attend to what you notice. Allow God's word to resonate in you.
- Speak/Share (*Oratio*): Prayerfully share with Jesus or with the group your thoughts and feelings.
- Rest in God's presence (*Contemplatio*): Notice God's presence and be still, surrounded by God's love.
- Choose to act (*Actio*): Trusting in God's nearness, commit to action rooted in love.

#### Children:

Can you think of a time that you said, "I'm sorry?" and really meant it? Why is it important to apologize?

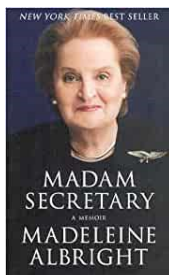

**Mark Your Calendars! Our next delivery of casseroles to Joseph's House of Camden will be Monday morning, Sept, 19, 2022.**

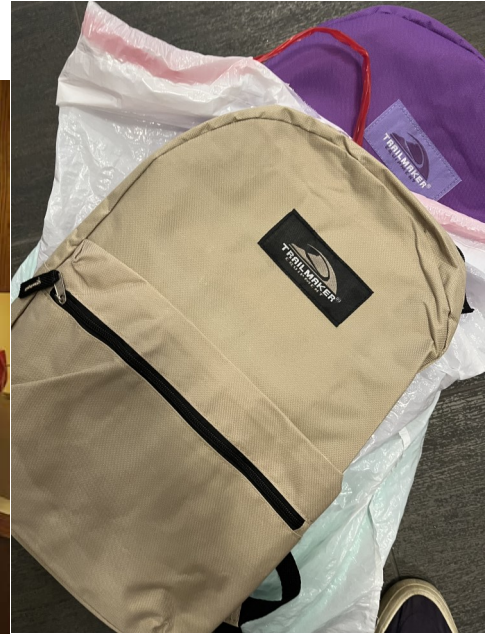

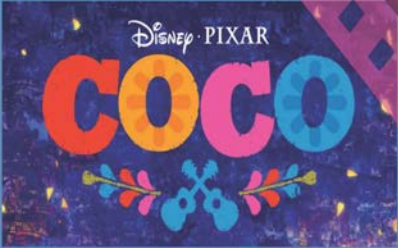

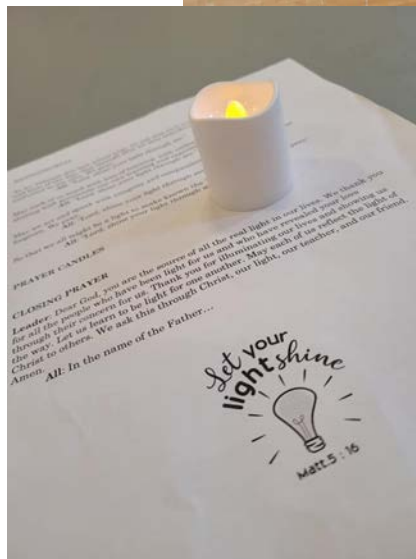
