With Sarah Hart & Iván Diaz

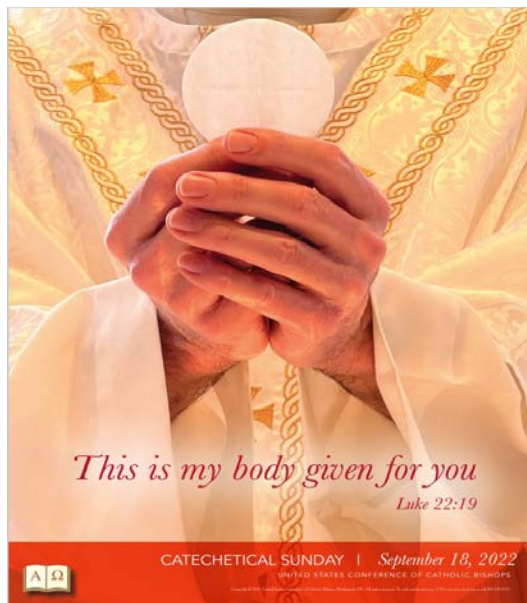

Reading for September 18, 2022

Luke 16: 1-13

Adults:

What “masters” keep you from serving God with all your heart, all your mind, and all your soul?

We offer this form of *Lectio Divina* (sacred reading) for pondering Scripture and for faith sharing with family members and other people.

- Listen/ Read (*Lectio*): Ponder God’s word and listen for what touches your heart.
- Meditate (*Meditatio*): Attend to what you notice. Allow God’s word to resonate in you.
- Speak/Share (*Oratio*): Prayerfully share with Jesus or with the group your thoughts and feelings.
- Rest in God’s presence (*Contemplatio*): Notice God’s presence and be still, surrounded by God’s love.
- Choose to act (*Actio*): Trusting in God’s nearness, commit to action rooted in love.

Children:

Who in your life do you trust? How do you show that you trust Jesus?

Catechetical Sunday



On the third Sunday in September, the Church in the United States celebrates Catechetical Sunday. We as Church have taken the opportunity each year to reflect on the role that each person plays, by virtue of Baptism, in handing on the faith and being a witness to the Gospel.

We highlight the Real Presence of Christ in the Eucharist during this time of Eucharistic revival with this year’s theme: ***“This is my body given for you” (Luke 22:19).*** *We hear these powerful words spoken by Jesus during the Last Supper at every mass. They are a reminder of the gift that Jesus is to us and how we are called to go forth and serve. We are the Body of Christ in and for the world today. We participate in Christ’s saving action every time we put our faith into practice and reflect the light of Christ into moments and places of darkness*

"Catechesis," is from a Greek word meaning "to echo, or resound." Catechesis is the act of resounding or bringing the Church's teachings to the world. A catechist is one who teaches in the name of the Church. Parents, guardians, and families are the first catechists for children in making the home a place where the faith is passed from one generation to the next. We also have members of our community who serve as catechists for all the faithful of our parish community. Children learn about sacraments, youth grow and strengthen their faith, and adults fall deeper in love with the God who loves us unconditionally, all through the faithful and dedicated service of our parish catechists and school teachers.

In May of 2021, Pope Francis formally established the lay ministry of catechist in the Catholic Church in his apostolic letter *Antiquum ministerium*. *This officially declared that catechists are to be recognized as lay ecclesial ministers in the Catholic Church and are due the training and support they need to be successful in their ministry. We take this opportunity to express our unending gratitude to these men and women who give of themselves in this ministry!*

Mitzvah Day 2022 Kick-off



This weekend is the kick-off for Mitzvah 2022, our fourteenth year for our parish-wide day of service. Mitzvah will be held on Saturday, Oct. 15. We will be doing a hybrid version again to allow people to volunteer according to their comfort level. So there will be opportunities to serve in person like serving at Cathedral Kitchen, Joseph's House or Ronald McDonald House. But there are also opportunities to do things at home with your family and to drop off things on Mitzvah Day.

For those wanting to do projects at home, the supply pick up days are Saturday, Oct 1 from 2:30- 6:30 pm (except during Mass time) and Sunday, Oct. 2 from 8:00 am – 12:30 pm. All supplies will be in the parish center.

There will be paper registrations available at all the church doors and you can register electronically through the parish website. If you have any questions, please contact Pat Slater in the parish office: 856-667-2440 x. 327 or by email at pslater@christourlight.net

We also have a long list of donations being requested by various agencies. Bins will be out in the gathering space beginning after the parish confirmation on Oct. 10th. **Please do not place anything in the gathering space until after Confirmation.**

Here is a list of donations that are being requested: pillowcases or large or extra large t-shirts, Toiletries (soap, toothpaste, deodorant (men and women's), toothbrushes (full size), hand lotion; new wash cloths, new socks for adult men (white socks) and women, men's briefs or boxer shorts and women's hipsters (especially size 6), Cases of bottled water

Healthy snacks in individual serving packets, like the kind you can get at BJ's, Sam's Club, etc.: like, granola bars, peanuts, trail mix, pretzels; personal care/toiletry items in sample sizes: like body lotion, hand lotion, Body wipes (like baby kind, not the hand sanitizer kind), Tampons (all sizes), rain Ponchos (heavier kind, not one use disposable kind), Adult backpacks; new or used luggage on wheels; warm hats and gloves The Animal Welfare Association is requesting : small Ziploc bags, medium kitchen garbage bags, towels, wash-cloths and non-fitted sheets (can be used, but should be clean). We will also be collecting women's hand-bags filled with toiletries (e.g. toothbrush, toothpaste, deodorant, lotion, small package of tissues, or anything else that might be useful to women).

We could also use gift cards to Shoprite, BJ's, Acme, Costco, Wegmans and Home Depot or Lowe's. Please drop all gift cards at the parish office or put them in an envelope marked Mitzvah and put them in the parish collection.

And, yes, you are all in charge of praying for good weather.

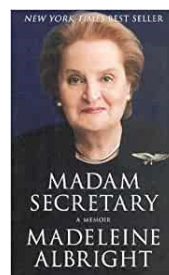

Ministry Spotlight



Bereavement Ministry

The time following a loved one's death is often difficult for family and friends. The Bereavement Ministry is a vital ministry at Christ Our Light which provides compassionate care for those in need.

Bereavement Ministry/funeral preparation

This is a huge ministry just by volume. We typically have about 100+ funerals at Christ Our Light each year. Maybe half of them are parishioners or are related to parishioners. We get a lot of calls from funeral homes asking for us to have a funeral for someone who was Catholic and did not have a home parish. All are welcome, alive or deceased. Trained bereavement ministers meet with family members to plan the funeral for their deceased loved one.

Cards that are sent out throughout the year for those who have lost a loved one

We send out cards on the first anniversary of loss. We include a Care Note on the first anniversary of your loss. We also send out a card prior to Christmas for those who lost a loved one since last Christmas along with a Care Note about getting through the holidays when you've lost a loved one. The bereavement ministers sign the card for the families they ministered to.

November 2 Mass of Remembrance

This is a lovely memorial, and the friends and family members who come really appreciate it. Bereavement volunteers also help with this Mass. A letter goes out to all those who lost a loved one since the last November 2 Mass. Bereavement ministers follow up with a phone call to all the families they ministered to the previous year.

Care Notes

We have a Care Notes rack. We try to include ones for mental health, spiritual life, ones for teens, family issues and issues of loss.

Remembrance for those who have lost a child

Oct. 15 is the international day for those who have lost a child. Our tradition has been to put out a tablecloth and people can put the name or other remembrance of a child or grandchild they have lost. We don't make any distinction if the child died pre-birth, after birth, as a child or even an adult child of someone. Losing a child is losing a child. This cloth is put on the altar for the month of November as we remember All Souls.

Some other aspects of bereavement ministry include helping people find an appropriate grief support group if they are looking for one. This may include making them aware of TLA (To Live Again), a support group specifically for widows and widowers or helping them find a support group from another loss through Grief Share (griefshare.org) or through services provided by one of our local hospices. This may also include a referral to one of our Stephen ministers.

If anyone is interested in learning more about this ministry, please contact Pat Slater in the parish office. Training is done online with a session that lasts two hours. Trainees then shadow experienced bereavement ministers until they feel comfortable in that role. 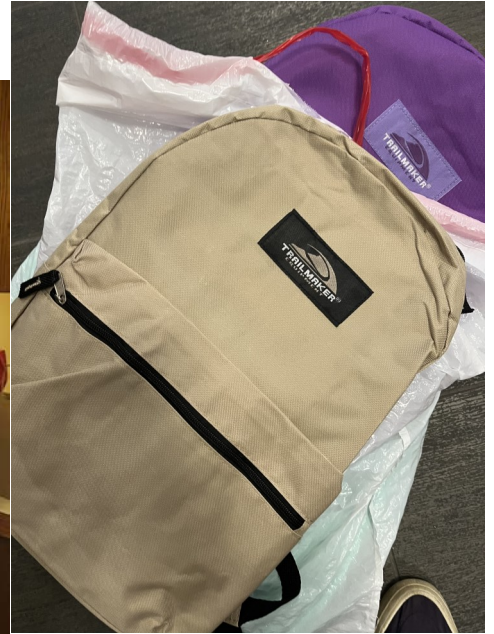
Hour of Adoration

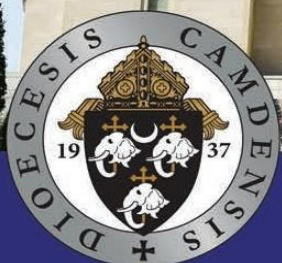
