The ministry of visiting homebound parishioners continues to expand as the Pandemic becomes normative and **we need your help...** only once a month.

WE WILL TRAIN YOU IF YOU ARE NOT AN EXTRAORDINARY MINISTER OF THE EUCHARIST, and you do not need to minister on the altar, you can focus on serving the homebound

There are 5 Eucharistic Ministers on each of the five Sunday teams. One member of each team visits 2-3 parishioners each week. Each person has an assigned week of the month and **visits on that one day per month**. The 5th team member is a "substitute" for that team and for the occasional "5th week" when it occurs. The mid-week team has a less formal schedule.

- Choose to act (*Actio*): Trusting in God's nearness, commit to action rooted in love.

CHILDREN'S LITURGY OF THE WORD

Children's Liturgy of the Word (CLOW) will resume on September 25th at the 9:00 a.m. and 11:00 a.m. Masses.

The purpose of this special Liturgy is twofold:

- To provide a quality liturgical experience
- To facilitate the proclamation and breaking open of Scripture with the children

What is Children's Liturgy of the Word?

- CLOW is a part of the Mass
- The Church encourages a separate liturgy to allow the children to participate and understand
- Appropriate for children between the ages of 5 and 12
- All are welcome - No registration is necessary
- We meet in the church and the children remain with the assembly and their parents for the opening of Mass
- The children are dismissed by the celebrant after the Opening Prayer.

Gather the Children

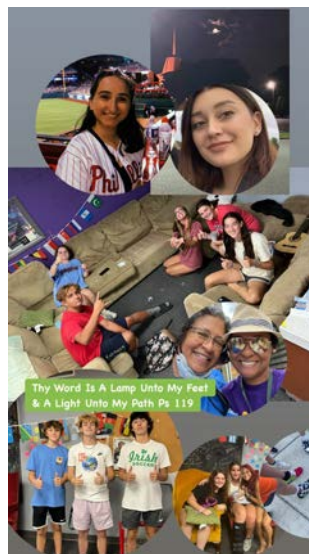
- The children form two groups: second grade and younger; third grade and older
- They are led to rooms in the Ministry Center of the church
- A candle is lit to remind the children of the presence of the Lord; they are reminded that they are still at Mass.
- A Reading, Responsorial Psalm, and Gospel are read.
- An interactive sharing follows: the children discuss what they heard; what the readings mean to them; practical ways they can incorporate what they heard into their everyday lives.
- The children return to the assembly after the Offertory Procession



VOLUNTEERS ARE NEEDED

- Adults and teens are needed to proclaim and share the Word of God
- Requirements: enthusiasm and the willingness to share your faith with the children of Christ Our Light Parish
- Scheduling is approximately once a month
- All materials are provided and mailed home the week before you are scheduled
- Facilitators do not have to come up with ideas - just present them and, most of all, let the children LEAD you.
- Feel free to come back with the children during a CLOW session to observe.
- Facilitators have commented that they learn so much from the children
- As one child said, "CLOW helps me understand; I don't understand all those big words."
