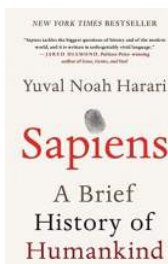
Christ Our Light Giving Tree

We offer this form of *Lectio Divina* (sacred reading) for pondering Scripture and for faith sharing with family members and other people.

- Listen/ Read (*Lectio*): Ponder God's word and listen for what touches your heart.
- Meditate (*Meditatio*): Attend to what you notice. Allow God's word to resonate in you.
- Speak/Share (*Oratio*): Prayerfully share with Jesus or with the group your thoughts and feelings.
- Rest in God's presence (*Contemplatio*): Notice God's presence and be still, surrounded by God's love.
- Choose to act (*Actio*): Trusting in God's nearness, commit to action rooted in love.

Pastoral Council Commissioning

Today, at the 11 AM Mass, the Members of this year's Pastoral Council were commissioned by Fr. Picinic. The Pastoral Council is called "pastoral" because of its unique relationship to the pastor, who initiates and establishes the council, who convenes its meetings and presides at them. The pastor seeks the good of his people as he consults with the council. The Parish Pastoral Council looks to pastoral concerns and is an important group of lay leaders who collaborate with the pastor to advance the gospel vision through its work of pastoral planning.

A major function of the Parish Pastoral Council is pastoral planning, and it is the task of the Council to know the people of the parish well and bring that knowledge into the planning process. The Council must discern the needs and strengths of the community and determine how the parish should best proceed toward realizing its preferred future.

The work of this Council began with the development of Vision 2024, introduced last year, and continues with the implementation along four pathways: Life-Giving Relationships, Unity Rich in Diversity, Healing and Vital Structures.

Pastoral Council serves as the ordinary planning instrument of the parish and provides counsel to the pastor on practical matters of the parish. Pastoral Council gives the pastor a means of consulting the people and seeking their wisdom. The pastor seeks the Council's advice, encourages their prayerful reflection on various matters, and considers their recommendations in his decision making.

Pastoral Council members should not be chosen for their leadership positions in the parish, but rather so that they reflect the various age groups, cultures, and interests of this community of the faithful.

John Vovak, our Pastoral Associate for Worship and Music, was the Ministry Guest Speaker at the November Pastoral Council meeting. He enlightened us about many of the liturgical ministries at our parish.

Here is a look at some of the liturgical ministries John oversees.

Lectors – Lectors proclaim the Word of God during liturgy, at all weekend Masses and on Holy Days. Lectors prepare by praying with the readings before Sunday and individual practice of the readings. Lectors are trained through both the Diocesan Office of Worship School of Liturgy programs and through the parish. They are encouraged to participate in the various continued formation opportunities. Schedules are based on the individual's availability and the needs of our parish. Altar Servers – Children, youth and young adults 4th grade and older are welcome to serve as Altar Servers. They assist in the celebration of the liturgy, as book bearers and table servers.
