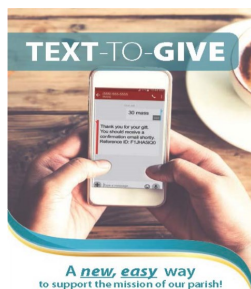

- Listen/ Read (*Lectio*): Ponder God's word and listen for what touches your heart.
- Meditate (*Meditatio*): Attend to what you notice. Allow God's word to resonate in you.
- Speak/Share (*Oratio*): Prayerfully share with Jesus or with the group your thoughts and feelings.
- Rest in God's presence (*Contemplatio*): Notice God's presence and be still, surrounded by God's love.
- Choose to act (*Actio*): Trusting in God's nearness, commit to action rooted in love.

Children:

What do you know about your own baptism? What happened on that important day?

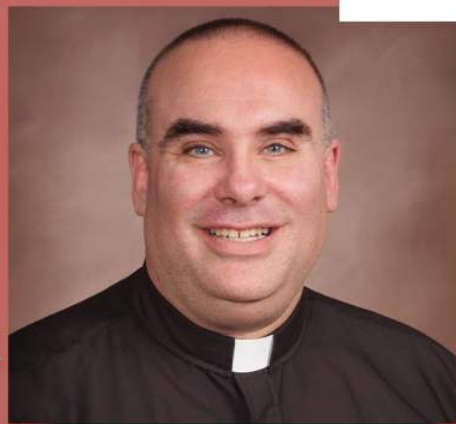

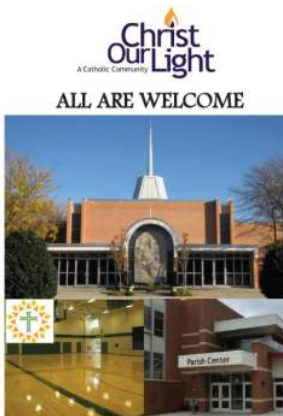

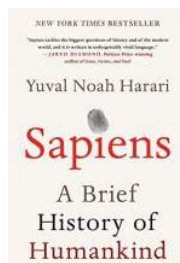

Pastoral Council's Spotlight on Ministry: Liturgical Ministries Part 2

Spotlight on Ministry

Here is a look at some of the other liturgical ministries that John spoke to the Pastoral Council about at our November meeting.

Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion (EM's) – EM's serve the community by assisting in the distribution of communion at all parish liturgies. EM's are trained through the diocesan Office of Worship School of Liturgy programs. Once that training is complete, individuals are prepared to serve at Christ Our Light by parish staff or other experienced EM's. schedules are created based on individual availability and the needs of the parish. There are currently 58 EM's, with 5 new prospective ministers. Mass Assistants – formerly known as the Usher ministry, this new ministry serves the parish community in the celebration of the liturgy. As ministers of hospitality, Mass Assistants greet people and assist in seating as needed. Their responsibilities include coordinating the offering of gifts, assisting anyone with special needs, ensuring the church is ready for the next Mass, and other duties as necessary for special occasions. The goal is to have 3-6 Mass Assistants at every Mass. There are 26 active Mass Assistants. 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7 Themes of Catholic Social Teaching



Modern Catholic social teaching has been articulated through a tradition of papal, conciliar, and episcopal documents. In seven reflections, the key themes at the heart of our Catholic social tradition are highlighted.

Theme 2 of 7: Call to Family, Community, and Participation

The person is not only sacred but also social. How we organize our society – in economics and politics, in law and policy – directly affects human dignity and the capacity of individuals to grow in community. Marriage and family are the central social institutions that must be supported and strengthened, not undermined. We believe people have a right and a duty to participate in society, seeking together the common good and well-being of all, especially the poor and vulnerable.

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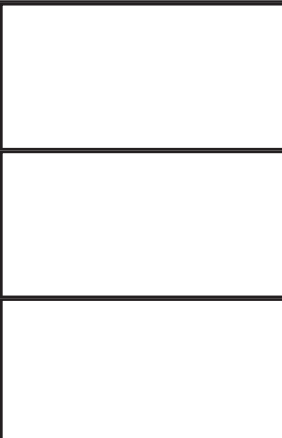
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
