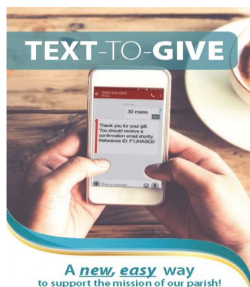

- Choose to act (*Actio*): Trusting in God's nearness, commit to action rooted in love.

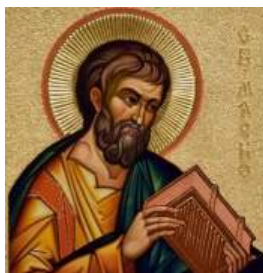

Wool Dryer Balls

One can use wool dryer balls instead of fabric softener or dryer sheets. They are all natural wool so they are excellent to use if someone has sensitive skin. What they do is to

bounce around in your dryer, separating the clothes and towels. Using wool dryer balls will dry clothes more quickly and efficiently. The wool in the balls helps to absorb moisture and prevent static. Thus, your clothes will have fewer wrinkles and will be soft to the touch. Using the wool dryer balls prevents damage to clothing from extended drying time. An extra plus is that your towels will have better absorbency because fabric softener is not being used. Finally, you can use the wool dryer balls over and over again. (In a report a few years ago, Consumer Reports stated they can be used 1000 loads. There are many wool dryer balls on the market. If you rely on Consumer Reports, they did a study using 10 brands of wool dryer balls. The one held up best to testing was Simple Natural Products Wool Dryer Balls.)

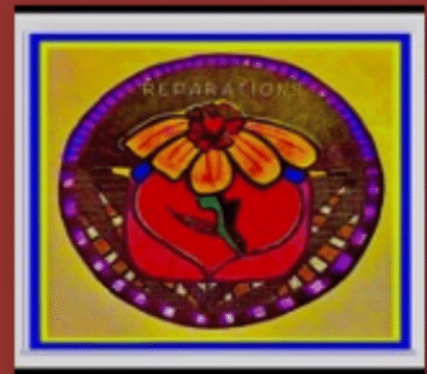
