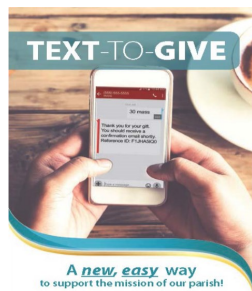

Reading for February 19, 2023

Matthew 5: 38-48

Adults:

How do these teachings of Jesus run counter to our culture? What difference does it make?

We offer this form of *Lectio Divina* (sacred reading) for pondering Scripture and for faith sharing with family members and other people.

- Listen/ Read (*Lectio*): Ponder God's word and listen for what touches your heart.
- Meditate (*Meditatio*): Attend to what you notice. Allow God's word to resonate in you.
- Speak/Share (*Oratio*): Prayerfully share with Jesus or with the group your thoughts and feelings.
- Rest in God's presence (*Contemplatio*): Notice God's presence and be still, surrounded by God's love.
- Choose to act (*Actio*): Trusting in God's nearness, commit to action rooted in love.

Youth:

What does loving your enemy look like?

Children:

Talk about a time you saw someone respond in love after they were treated badly by another person.

Chair Yoga

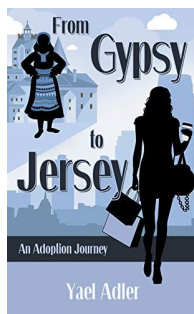


This practice links the movement of the breath with gentler yoga postures. De-stress while you stretch, strengthen, and breathe from the comfort of your chair.

7 Themes of Catholic Social Teaching



Modern Catholic social teaching has been articulated through a tradition of papal, conciliar, and episcopal documents. In seven reflections, the key themes at the heart of our Catholic social tradition are highlighted.

Theme 7 of 7 Care for God's Creation

We show our respect for the Creator by our stewardship of creation. Care for the earth is not just an Earth Day slogan, it is a requirement of our faith. We are called to protect people and the planet, living our faith in relationship with all of God's creation. This environmental challenge has fundamental moral and ethical dimensions that cannot be ignored.

Youth Faith Formation

At the January Parish Council, Sherine Green, our Director of Youth Faith Formation (YFF), came and spoke to us about the YFF program at Christ Our Light. She shared that Youth Ministry is a space where all students are reminded that we belong to God and to each other. The ministry of **advocacy, catechesis, community life, evangelization, justice, leadership, pastoral care and spirituality** are reflected in each designed program. The aim is to invite young people into a safe sacred community of fellowship. The simple ministry of presence is the most important. As youth ministers, Sherine and her team are ready to listen to the fears, cares, anxieties and aspirations of the students and their families. Youth Ministry is about fostering relations and building solid Catholic leaders.

Students are asking for: church leaders/mentors who can relate, those who will not judge but will offer sound reason; leaders who are authentic; those ready to be present through accompaniment.

Sherine shared that the needs of this ministry are: Christian Worship nights; more Young Adult Mentors; a bigger pool of volunteers that are ready to bake, to write letters of support, to lead conversations, to greet, and to chaperone events. 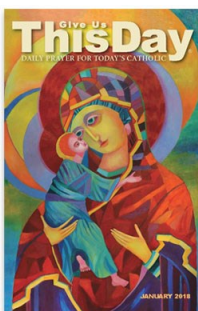
Christ Our Light Prayer Group

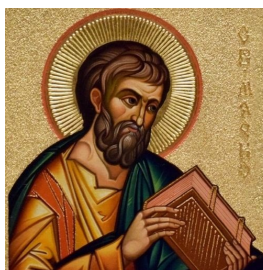

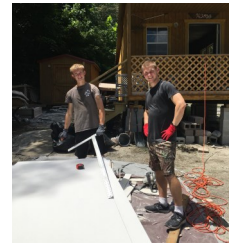


Get Back to Your Roots

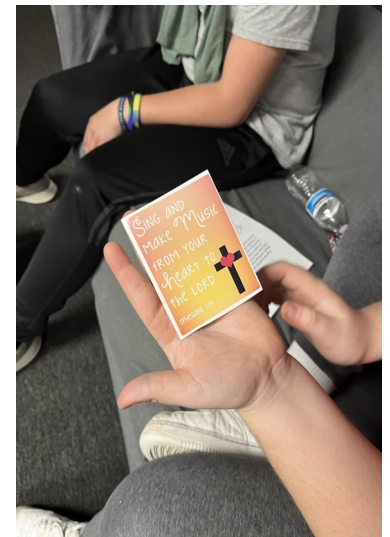
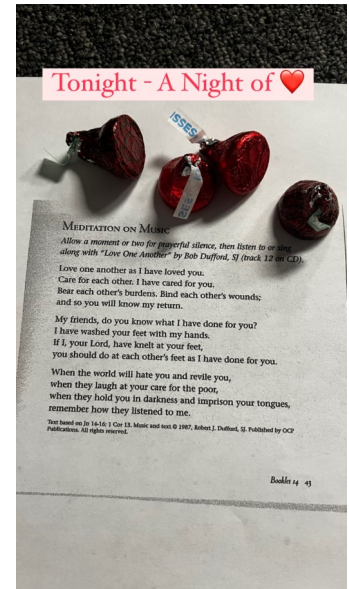
