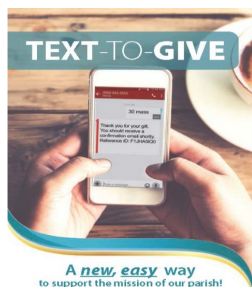

I Chose All Young Adult Ministry

At the March Pastoral Council meeting, Cheyenne Schuster, our Echo Catechetical Apprentice, came to tell us about "I Chose All", the Young Adult Ministry at Christ Our Light. They chose the name from St. Therese of Lisieux's autobiography *Story of Soul*, where she expressed her desire to take on all that Jesus asks of her.

In this ministry, young adults are invited to spend time in fellowship and stewardship as to strengthen their understanding of faith and community through liturgy, parish life and service in seeking to live in the world as followers of Jesus. This ministry is for all those in the 20s, 30s and 40s, whatever their vocation, job, relationship status, relationship to the Church, anything that makes you who you are.

They have been meeting on the 2nd and 4th Saturdays of the month after the 4:30 Mass. Gatherings consist of various activities such as prayer, service projects, movies, carry-in and going out to dinner, game nights, Youth and Young Adult Masses, and speakers. They also take part in parish-wide activities – sandwich making, helping the Art & Environment committee, parish seasonal retreats, as well as Diocesan events such as Theology on Tap, Holy Hour, and Praise & Worship nights.

They are interested in creating interest groups for specific stages of life, rather than the large age range being the common denominator, for example, a group of moms. They are starting a bible study/dinner group for adults in their 30s and 40s; their 1st meeting is on March 29th at 7:45pm. The Farm Bill - SNAP



In October of 2023 Congress will reauthorize the Farm Bill. The Farm Bill provides the funding for the [Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program](#) (SNAP, formerly known as food stamps) is the nation's most important anti-hunger program, reaching **38 million people** nationwide. In the U.S. alone 34 million people suffer from food insecurity (do not know where their next meal is coming from). Nine million children in the U.S. suffer from food insecurity. Any cuts to SNAP will severely impact families who are already on the edge. As it presently stands, recipients of SNAP are subsidized about \$1.61 per meal. With the price of food rising, can you imagine any help being cut?

Christ Our Light will be participating in the Offering of Letters sponsored by Bread for the World. This is an advocacy effort to assure that the Farm Bill works for people who are poor in the U.S. and around the world.

In Matthew 25 Jesus talks about the judgment of the nations.

Then the king will say to those on his right, 'Come, you who are blessed by my Father. Inherit the kingdom prepared for you from the foundation of the world.

For I was hungry and you gave me food, I was thirsty and you gave me drink, a stranger and you welcomed me, naked and you clothed me, ill and you cared for me, in prison and you visited me.'

Then the righteous will answer him and say, 'Lord, when did we see you hungry and feed you, or thirsty and give you drink? When did we see you a stranger and welcome you, or naked and clothe you? When did we see you ill or in prison, and visit you?'

And the king will say to them in reply, 'Amen, I say to you, whatever you did for one of these least brothers of mine, you did for me.' (Mt. 25: 34-40)

OFFERING of LETTERS

Brice and Nikki Mosher own and operate Infinity Microfarm in Missaukee County, Michigan, which works within a Community Supported Agriculture (CSA) framework, bringing together a group of local people who support the farm's work. The Moshers charge \$20 per box of fresh fruits and vegetables. Thanks to a federal nutrition program called the Gus Schumacher Nutrition Incentive Program (GusNIP), about half of the farm's CSA shareholders also participate in the Supplementary Nutrition Assistance Program, better known as SNAP. The SNAP participants pay only \$5 of the \$20 cost, with the rest covered by a GusNIP grantee. It's a great deal for both the families that participate in SNAP and the Moshers.



Unfortunately, only a small fraction of the 41 million people who receive SNAP benefits have access to GusNIP incentives. **Increasing U.S. government support for GusNIP in the Farm Bill will help ensure more families have access to fresh, nutritious fruits and vegetables.**



Every year, Bread for the World organizes churches, community organizations, and people of faith from across the country to write letters and emails to their members of Congress who have the power to impact the policies and programs that can end hunger.

By taking part in Bread for the World's 2023 Offering of Letters in support of the Farm Bill, you will help support domestic nutrition programs like GusNIP and SNAP, as well as funding for critical international food assistance programs.
