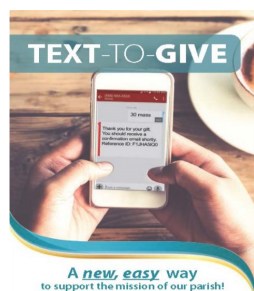

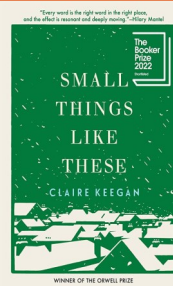

The Sentinels of Christ Our Light

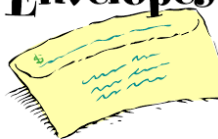
We are looking to begin a new ministry at Christ Our Light, "The Sentinels."

Spotlight on Ministry



I Chose All Young Adult Ministry

At the March Pastoral Council meeting, Cheyenne Schuster, our Echo Catechetical Apprentice, came to tell us about “I Choose All”, the Young Adult Ministry at Christ Our Light. They chose the name from St. Therese of Lisieux’s autobiography *Story of Soul*, where she expressed her desire to take on all that Jesus asks of her.

In this ministry, young adults are invited to spend time in fellowship and stewardship as to strengthen their understanding of faith and community through liturgy, parish life and service in seeking to live in the world as followers of Jesus. This ministry is for all those in the 20s, 30s and 40s, whatever their vocation, job, relationship status, relationship to the Church, anything that makes you who you are.

They have been meeting on the 2nd and 4th Saturdays of the month after the 4:30 Mass. Gatherings consist of various activities such as prayer, service projects, movies, carry-in and going out to dinner, game nights, Youth and Young Adult Masses, and speakers. They also take part in parish-wide activities – sandwich making, helping the Art & Environment committee, parish seasonal retreats, as well as Diocesan events such as Theology on Tap, Holy Hour, and Praise & Worship nights.

They are interested in creating interest groups for specific stages of life, rather than the large age range being the common denominator, for example, a group of moms. They are starting a bible study/dinner group for adults in their 30s and 40s; their 1st meeting is on March 29th at 7:45pm. 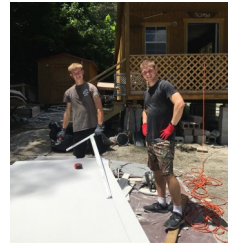

Offering of Letters - SNAP



In October, Congress will be authorizing the Farm Bill. The Farm Bill, among other functions, funds the SNAP program (Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program), emergency aid both domestic and abroad as well as many other programs which support nutrition, sustainability of our farming system and equity in that system. Bread for the World is sponsoring what is called an Offering of Letters. These are letters to our senators and representatives to support the Farm Bill so that it supports people who are poor and in need in our country and around the world. For example, one of the policy platforms that BFW is proposing is that Congress remove the mandate for college students to work 20 hours a week in order to qualify for SNAP. Hunger on college campuses is one of the hidden pockets of hunger in our country.

We will be holding our own Offering of Letters campaign at Christ Our Light the weekend of May 6-7. At that time we will have preprinted letters available which you can just sign and add your address. These letters will be delivered to local congressional offices during the summer. You are also welcome to do an online letter. Once you fill out your contact information, the website will generate letters to our two Senators and your local representative. Olga's Story

Our support team of friends, has been working for months to bring a family from Ukraine here to safety until they are able to return home. We were matched with Olga and her 3 daughters, who now have permission to travel to NJ. Although this is not a parish-sponsored effort, because of the generosity of our parishioners we thought you may want to support this project.

Here is their story-

Olga is a 34 year old divorced mother of 3 girls, Emily and Nicole, 4 year old twins, and Stefania, age 9. Olga, a successful screenwriter, producer, and editor for 15 years, has seen her life and the lives of her daughters toppled.

In her own words, "But the war destroyed everything in one day. My business. Income. My stability. My dreams. My future. And the worst thing is the happy life of my children. I am divorced and raise three daughters alone, twins Emily and Nicole and Stefania. If I could tell you what it's like to live under the constant threat of missile strikes. When your child at school hears an air raid warning and heads to the bomb shelter. And the twin in the kindergarten runs away to shelter. And when, in the middle of the night, 12-meter rockets are shot down over your house, and you already thought that the rocket was flying into your apartment, at your children... And in the morning, you collect the remnants of the rocket in the area. Shaking walls, a deafening whistle... it's terrible, constant fear..."

Olga hopes to continue her profession here in NJ; she has stated she can work anywhere, provided there is stable internet and light, things no longer available in Ukraine. Most important to her, she wants her daughters to be safe and happy again.

Olga and her girls are not alone; thousands of Ukrainian people are seeking refuge until they can return home. But we can help one family and that is what we plan to do.

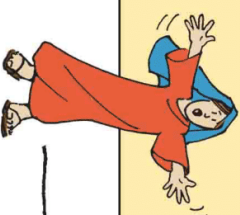

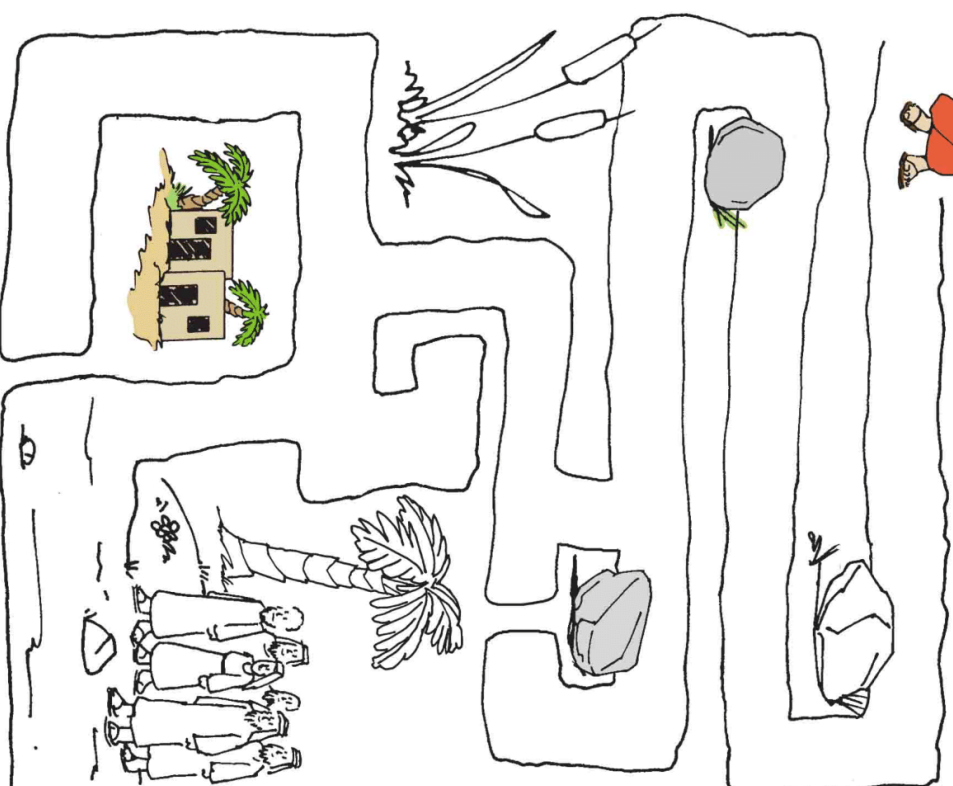

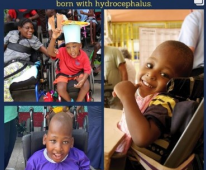
