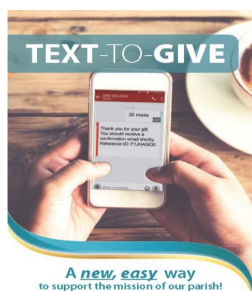

Reading for April 16, 2023
John 20:19-31

Adults:

When has your faith in the living Christ helped you overcome fear?

We offer this form of *Lectio Divina* (sacred reading) for pondering Scripture and for faith sharing with family members and other people.

- Listen/ Read (*Lectio*): Ponder God's word and listen for what touches your heart.
- Meditate (*Meditatio*): Attend to what you notice. Allow God's word to resonate in you.
- Speak/Share (*Oratio*): Prayerfully share with Jesus or with the group your thoughts and feelings.
- Rest in God's presence (*Contemplatio*): Notice God's presence and be still, surrounded by God's love.
- Choose to act (*Actio*): Trusting in God's nearness, commit to action rooted in love.

Youth:

Thomas did not believe because he had not seen Jesus with his own eyes. What helps you believe in God without being able to see God?

Children:

What could you do this Easter season to help someone feel less afraid?

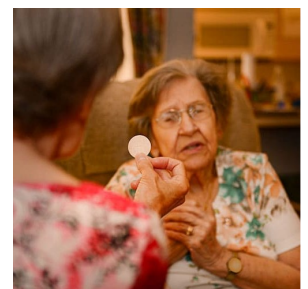
The ministry of visiting homebound parishioners continues to expand and we need your help...**only once a month.**

Offering of Letters - SNAP



In October, Congress will be authorizing the Farm Bill. The Farm Bill, among other functions, funds the SNAP program (Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program), emergency aid both domestic and abroad as well as many other programs which support nutrition, sustainability of our farming system and equity in that system. Bread for the World is sponsoring what is called an Offering of Letters. These are letters to our senators and representatives to support the Farm Bill so that it supports people who are poor and in need in our country and around the world. For example, one of the policy platforms that BFW is proposing is that Congress remove the mandate for college students to work 20 hours a week in order to qualify for SNAP. Hunger on college campuses is one of the hidden pockets of hunger in our country.

We will be holding our own Offering of Letters campaign at Christ Our Light the weekend of May 6-7. At that time we will have preprinted letters available which you can just sign and add your address. These letters will be delivered to local congressional offices during the summer. You are also welcome to do an online letter. Once you fill out your contact information, the website will generate letters to our two Senators and your local representative. You will fill out contact information. Identify your congregation as Christ Our Light, Cherry Hill, NJ. The contact information also makes sure that the information is sent to the correct legislators based on your address.
