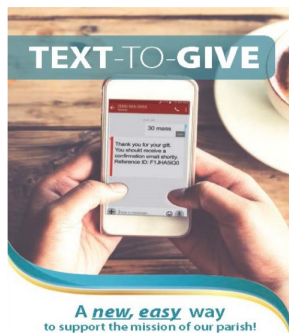

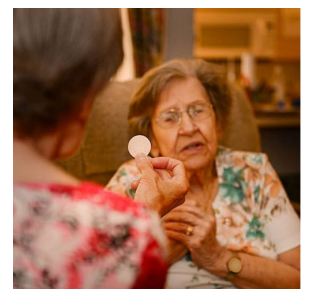
The ministry of visiting homebound parishioners continues to expand and we need your help...**only once a month.**

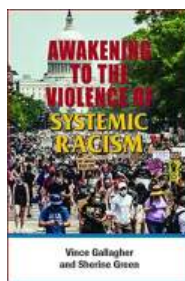

Offering of Letters - SNAP



In October, Congress will be authorizing the Farm Bill. The Farm Bill, among other functions, funds the SNAP program (Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program), emergency aid both domestic and abroad as well as many other programs which support nutrition, sustainability of our farming system and equity in that system. Bread for the World is sponsoring what is called an Offering of Letters. These are letters to our senators and representatives to support the Farm Bill so that it supports people who are poor and in need in our country and around the world. For example, one of the policy platforms that BFW is proposing is that Congress remove the mandate for college students to work 20 hours a week in order to qualify for SNAP. Hunger on college campuses is one of the hidden pockets of hunger in our country.

We will be holding our own Offering of Letters campaign at Christ our Light the weekend of May 6-7. At that time we will have preprinted letters available which you can just sign and add your address. These letters will be delivered to local congressional offices during the summer. You are also welcome to do an online letter. Once you fill out your contact information, the website will generate letters to our two Senators and your local representative. 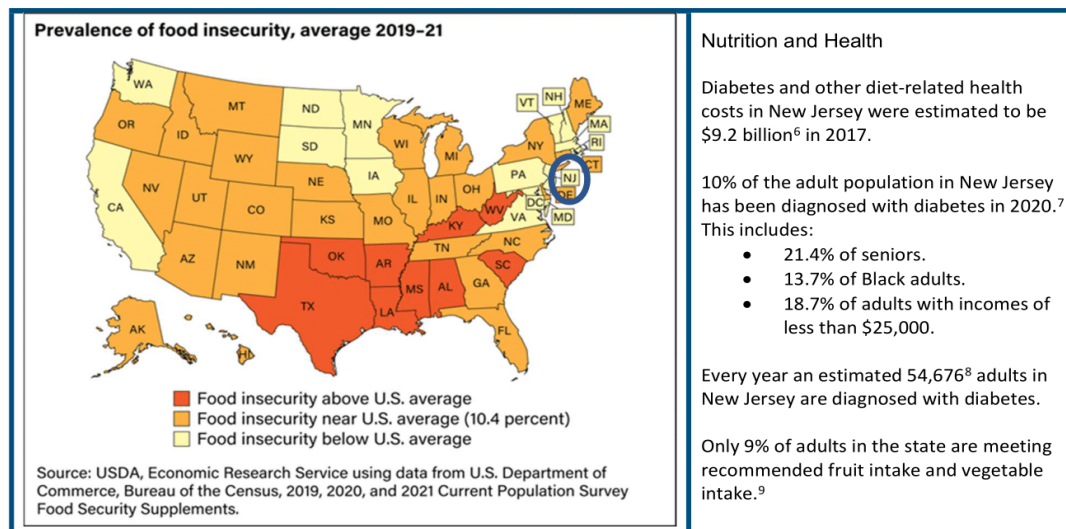


New Jersey

A Hunger and Poverty Snapshot

Between 2019-2021:

- Food insecurity in New Jersey averaged 8.3%.¹
- New Jersey's food insecurity rate was 20% lower than the national average of 10.4%.²
- The poverty rate in New Jersey in 2021 (using the Supplemental Poverty Measure) was 8.1%, which was 0.3 percentage points higher than the national average of 7.8%.³
- New Jersey's poverty rate is high compared to the rest of the nation in large part because of the high cost of housing. Four in 10 low-income people in New Jersey are homeless or pay over half their income for rent.⁴
- SNAP, alone, lifted 155,000 people above the poverty line in New Jersey, including 70,000 children, per year between 2013 and 2017, on average.⁵



Why Bread for the World is Focused on the Farm Bill

The Farm bill is scheduled to be reauthorized in 2023. No legislation has more impact than a farm bill on the US food system and the nation's ability to provide healthy food at affordable prices to everyone.

Bread for the World's farm bill priorities include a focus on nutrition, equity, and sustainability. We believe New Jersey has a lot to gain from a farm bill legislated with these priorities in mind.

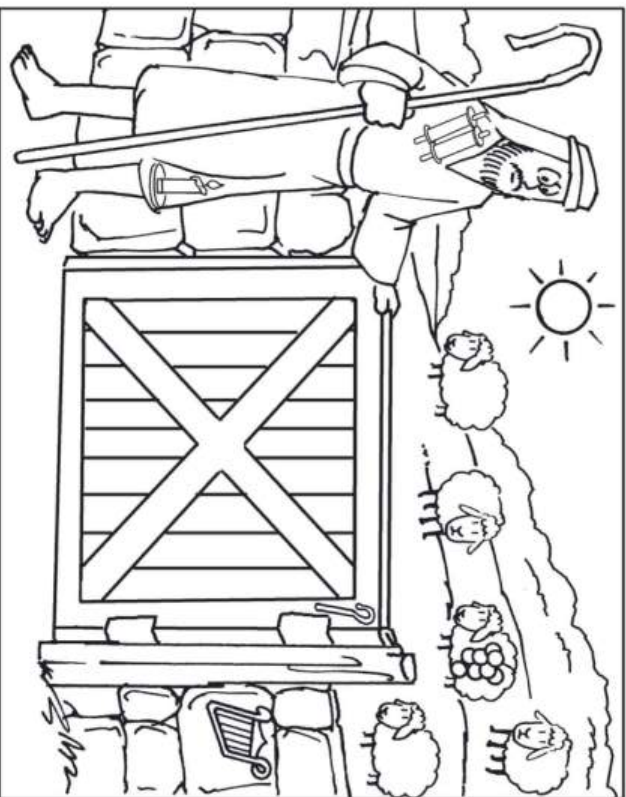

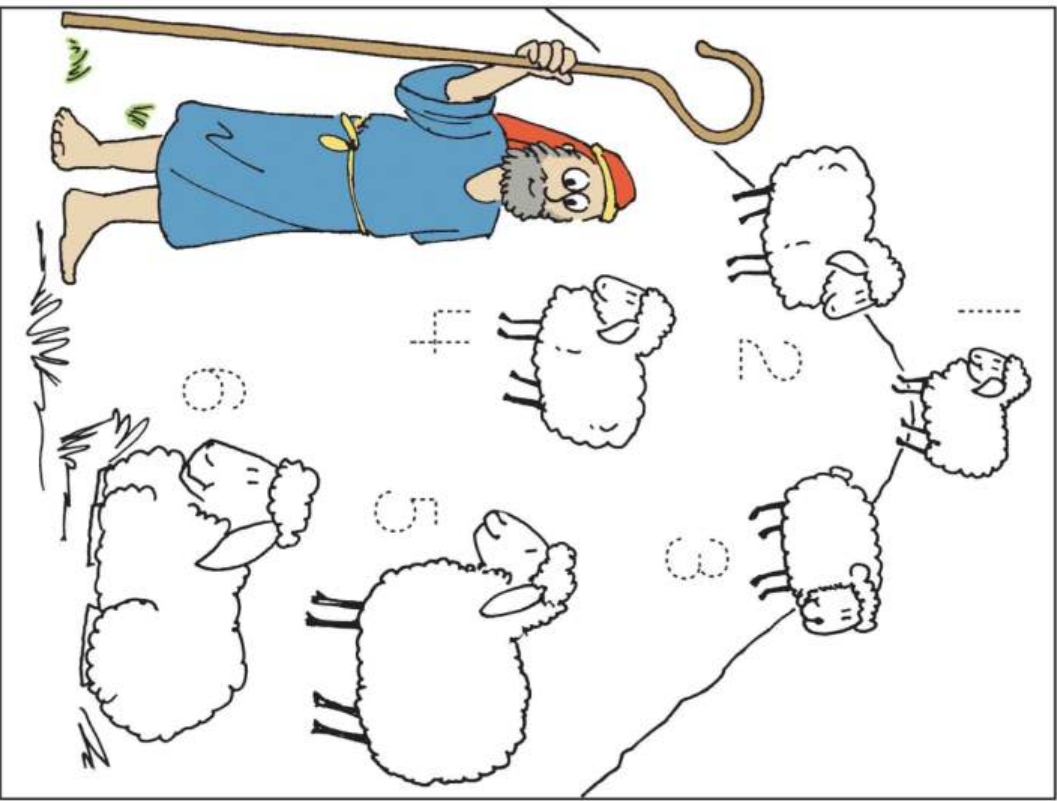
