Reading for May 21, 2023
Matthew 28:16-20

Adults:

Jesus told his followers to "...make disciples of all nations; baptizing them in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the holy Spirit..." How do you "make disciples of all nations?"

We offer this form of *Lectio Divina* (sacred reading) for pondering Scripture and for faith sharing with family members and other people.

- Listen/ Read (*Lectio*): Ponder God's word and listen for what touches your heart.
- Meditate (*Meditatio*): Attend to what you notice. Allow God's word to resonate in you.
- Speak/Share (*Oratio*): Prayerfully share with Jesus or with the group your thoughts and feelings.
- Rest in God's presence (*Contemplatio*): Notice God's presence and be still, surrounded by God's love.
- Choose to act (*Actio*): Trusting in God's nearness, commit to action rooted in love.

Children:

What can you do to show others you are a follower of Jesus?

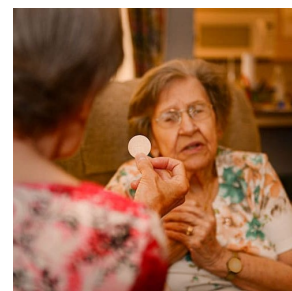
The ministry of visiting homebound parishioners continues to expand and we need your help...**only once a month.**

invites children ages 5 by June 30, 2023 through entering 5th grade in September 2023 to participate.

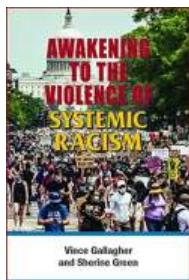

Olga's Story

Dear Parishioners,

There is an old saying that states when one door closes, another opens. In March 2014, following Ukraine's Revolution of Dignity, pro-Russian protests began in Ukraine's Donetsk and Luhansk regions, known collectively as 'the Donbas'. This area borders Russia; these problems emerged as Russia invaded Ukraine and annexed Crimea. Iryna's war story starts here. In 2014, she and her family were forced to leave their native home in the Donetsk region because of the hostilities. She says, "We didn't want to go, but we had two small children (a 5-year-old daughter and a 3-month-old son)." They moved to be near extended family, taking their parents, who had health issues, and sister with them.

Years of establishing a home, job and life ended with the war precipitated by the second Russian invasion of Ukraine in February 2022. They moved from their home, and tried to return sometime later, only to find the streets turned to trenches with rubble everywhere from the shelling and destruction, and their son's school leveled. They relocated several times in Ukraine, staying just ahead of the Russians.

Ultimately, they fled to Bulgaria, where they found a temporary shelter. Because it is in a resort area, they will need a new plan when summer comes. In this location, they are unable to work, their children can enroll in classes only online, and they cannot establish themselves permanently. Iryna describes their hope in this way: "We all have one dream - to return home..., to our own bed, to wake up and go to work or to school.... Our burning desire is a safe and peaceful life. We want our children to see life without explosions, without bomb shelters, without weapons, without hostility. We dream that they have friends, and not lose them. Just live, not survive, not suffer." "The war came to us twice, but our hearts did not become hard, we have children, so we have someone to live for. We are very grateful for all the help, attention, care, and warmth provided. We hope that Ukraine will win, as good wins over evil."

For the past few months, we have been working with Welcome NST to bring Olga and her daughters from Ukraine. Due to a change in her family's circumstances, they could not travel to the US as planned. NST reviewed the situation, and quickly identified Iryna and her family as people who needed to find immediate sanctuary. As described, they have no options. and are anxious to leave. We look forward to assisting them, we and appreciate your continued support.



serviceWORX

ServiceworX takes place at local parishes and schools and is a life-changing program for junior high students that explores service and social justice through the lens of the Catholic faith during a week-long service immersion day program (approximately 4 hours Sunday with times varying by location; Monday – Friday 8:30am-3:00pm).

ServiceworX is facilitated by passionate ministry staff who help participants live their faith through engaging prayer services, lively discussions, and dynamic community service.
