Children should continue faith formation classes through 8th grade in order to be eligible to prepare for and celebrate the sacrament of Confirmation in the Fall of 9th grade.

Parish Nursing

At the May 10th meeting of the Pastoral Council, our Parish Nurses came to tell the Council all about their wonderful ministry and the benefits to the Parish's well-being.

They concentrate on three areas – a Healthy Body, a Healthy Spirit, and a Healthy Community. They continue to work hand in hand with the Diocesan office – Vitality – in presenting our parish with very valuable services. They put people in touch with the resources they need. Through all their programs, they have had 558 contacts with parishioners so far this year!

Some of the services provided were blood pressure checks and health screening; caregiver support groups for diabetes, stroke and cancer caregivers; chair yoga; How to Prevent Falls workshop; visitation of the sick in hospitals, assisted living facilities, or in homes; providing transportation to doctor's visits and Mass; their phone ministry where they call to check up on parishioners and provide comfort; and they organized a Family and Friends CPR class.

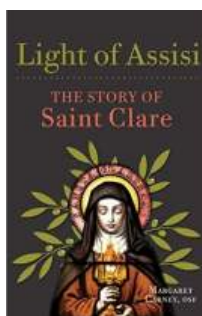

The diocesan Office of Life and Justice is sponsoring a bus for people to attend the advocacy day regarding the reauthorization of the Farm Bill. There is a two step registration process for the trip. Both steps are outlined on the parish website (christourlight.net). The first step is for the parish. This allows us to see who is going and to see what legislators we will be visiting on this advocacy day. The second stage is to register through Bread for the World's website. There is a link on our website. The cost of the registration with Bread for the World is \$15 (probably to cover lunch). Registrants will be notified as to what time and from where the bus is leaving (guesstimate for departure is around 5 am).

The morning program will consist of education regarding food policy and specifically the Farm Bill. After lunch we will walk to the offices of our senators and representatives to meet with staff regarding the Farm Bill. The program in Washington concludes around 6:30 pm.

Who doesn't like balloons?

We're not talking about Zeppelins or big hot air balloons that can carry you up among the clouds, we're talking about those ordinary everyday balloons that you see at any party or celebration. They're great fun and they brighten up any space with brightness and color. They're easily set up and easily taken down. Children love to play with them. Even when they get popped it's no big deal, just find another. Popping balloons can be fun too. So many games to play with balloons. You can also fill balloons with helium or some other gas and release them to float away into the sky. That's entertaining, beautiful and impressive

too.

Just good and harmless fun with balloons, right? But wait, what do you do with spent and broken balloons after the party?

Some things to know about balloons:

1. Make sure that they were put into the trash, they are not recyclable
2. animals, birds and fish get sick or choke when they try to eat balloon fragments
3. Small creatures can also drown when they get entangled in trailing ribbon or string
4. It's true of pets, but it's much more of a problem for wild animals, they often die as a result
5. Partially inflated balloons can clog their digestive tract, starving the animal to death
6. Latex balloons are biodegradable, mylar or foil balloons are not.
7. Latex balloons will generally degrade within 6 months but can survive for over 5 years.

Some tips for safeguarding the environment:

1. Keep balloons inside if possible
2. If balloons are to go home with children, tie them to their wrist or have an adult carry the balloon
3. Never release a balloon outside. Even with biodegradable balloons, they are a serious risk to wildlife and marine environments.
4. When you plan to dispose of the balloons, deflate the balloons before putting them in the garbage.
5. spent balloons should be disposed of in a responsible manner, either in a compost heap where they will have the best conditions in which to biodegrade within a few months, or in landfill waste where they will also break down safely.
6. Use natural raffia ribbon because it is compostable, particularly if it has been dyed with natural dyes.
