Parish Nursing

At the May 10th meeting of the Pastoral Council, our Parish Nurses came to tell the Council all about their wonderful ministry and the benefits to the Parish's well-being.

They concentrate on three areas – a Healthy Body, a Healthy Spirit, and a Healthy Community. They continue to work hand in hand with the Diocesan office – Vitality – in presenting our parish with very valuable services. They put people in touch with the resources they need. Through all their programs, they have had 558 contacts with parishioners so far this year!

Some of the services provided were blood pressure checks and health screening; caregiver support groups for diabetes, stroke and cancer caregivers; chair yoga; How to Prevent Falls workshop; visitation of the sick in hospitals, assisted living facilities, or in homes; providing transportation to doctor's visits and Mass; their phone ministry where they call to check up on parishioners and provide comfort; and they organized a Family and Friends CPR class.

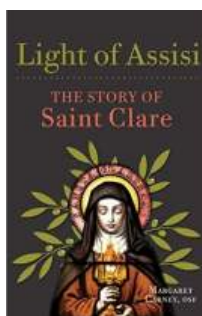

Eucharistic Revival

Thank you to all who joined our Corpus Christi Procession this past weekend after the 4:30 PM Mass. It was a beautiful day and a moving experience for all!



Shortly after his Resurrection, Jesus accompanied two disciples on their journey from Jerusalem to Emmaus—walking with them in their grief, offering hope, and finally revealing himself through the breaking of the bread. Jesus wants to do the same for YOU!

The **National Eucharistic Pilgrimage** will accompany Jesus from city to city, lighting hearts on fire along the way. Then, at the National Eucharistic Congress in July 2024, all these flames will blaze together. This will be one of the largest Eucharistic pilgrimages in history! Just as throngs followed Christ throughout his earthly ministry, our nation will process with our Eucharistic Lord through cities, along highways, and past rural towns on his way to the 10th National Eucharistic Congress.

There will be four main routes, coming from north, south, east and west. Leaving from New Haven, Connecticut, the eastern arm of the Pilgrimage will begin near the Atlantic coast, journey through our nation's oldest diocese, and cross the Appalachian Mountains. The "Seton Route," named in honor of St. Elizabeth Ann Seton, will be punctuated by many meaningful stops. Pilgrims will visit holy sites, embrace the sacraments daily, and publicly proclaim Christ's Real Presence in the Eucharist as they accompany him on his way to the 10th National Eucharistic Congress. Make your plans now to meet up with this historic Pilgrimage! It will be in Philadelphia, PA from May 31–June 2, 2024.
