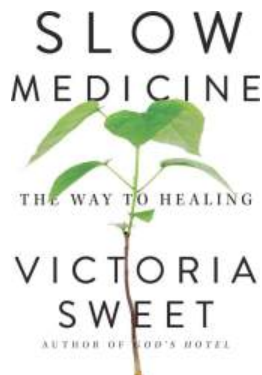

Reading for July 16, 2023

Matthew 13:1-9

Adults:

How are you sometimes rocky or thorny soil? How might you become more fertile for God's seeds to take root?

We offer this form of *Lectio Divina* (sacred reading) for pondering Scripture and for faith sharing with family members and other people.

- Listen/ Read (*Lectio*): Ponder God's word and listen for what touches your heart.
- Meditate (*Meditatio*): Attend to what you notice. Allow God's word to resonate in you.
- Speak/Share (*Oratio*): Prayerfully share with Jesus or with the group your thoughts and feelings.
- Rest in God's presence (*Contemplatio*): Notice God's presence and be still, surrounded by God's love.
- Choose to act (*Actio*): Trusting in God's nearness, commit to action rooted in love.

Youth:

What types of seeds might Jesus be trying to plant within you? What might you do better to allow these seeds to grow?

Children:

Can you remember a time a family member or friend tried to share the seed of a Godly gift with you, such as love, peace, joy, patience, kindness, or forgiveness?

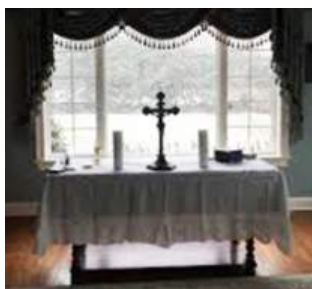

The Faith Formation office is accepting registrations for Elementary Faith Formation (Gr. 1-6) and Youth Faith Formation (Gr. 7 & 8) classes beginning September 2023. For information, to download and print forms, and to register students electronically go to our website at www.christourlight.net.

NOTE: In accordance with sacramental guidelines of the Diocese of Camden, children are eligible to prepare for and celebrate the sacraments of 1st Reconciliation and 1st Eucharist after having completed a full year of religious instruction. Children should continue faith formation classes through 8th grade in order to be eligible to prepare for and celebrate the sacrament of Confirmation in the Fall of 9th grade.

Eucharistic Revival



The Holy Spirit's call to renewal can be broken down into four invitations based on the pillars of the **Eucharistic Revival**: (1) reinvigorate worship, (2) create moments of personal encounter, (3) engage in robust formation, and (4) send Catholics forth as missionaries.

This week, let's think about ways we can *reinvigorate our worship*. *Let's pray that God will open our hearts and our minds to the true presence of Jesus in the Eucharist. Let us be mindful that Jesus is present in all the tabernacles of the world. Let us be mindful from the moment we enter the church for Mass or adoration that we are in the presence of our God! Let us mindfully, purposefully genuflect and make the sign of the cross with the reverence due to Jesus.*

St. Bernadette Soubirous, known throughout the world as the saintly visionary of Our Lady at the miraculous grotto in Lourdes, is said to have learned how to make the sign of the cross by Our Lady. During the seventh apparition, Jean-Baptiste Estrade (who came to the grotto to mock her) recorded of Bernadette, "During the ecstasy the child also made the sign of the cross from time to time, and, as I said myself on the way back from the grotto, if the sign of the cross is made in heaven, it can only be made in that manner." She was uneducated and extremely poor, but the way she lived and prayed spoke more theology than any book.

St. Maximilian Kolbe shared very good advice we should consider prayerfully: *"Be a Catholic: When you kneel before an altar, do it in such a way that others may be able to recognize that you know before whom you kneel."*
