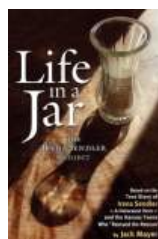

Reading for August 6, 2023

Matthew 17: 1 - 9

Adults:

We offer this form of *Lectio Divina* (sacred reading) for pondering Scripture and for faith sharing with family members and other people.

- Listen/ Read (*Lectio*): Ponder God’s word and listen for what touches your heart.
- Meditate (*Meditatio*): Attend to what you notice. Allow God’s word to resonate in you.
- Speak/Share (*Oratio*): Prayerfully share with Jesus or with the group your thoughts and feelings.
- Rest in God’s presence (*Contemplatio*): Notice God’s presence and be still, surrounded by God’s love.
- Choose to act (*Actio*): Trusting in God’s nearness, commit to action rooted in love.

When you listen to Jesus as God commands, what do you hear?

Children:

What can you do this week so that, like Jesus, God is pleased with you?

Summer fun for all.

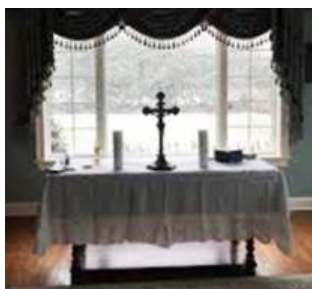

NOTE: In accordance with sacramental guidelines of the Diocese of Camden, children are eligible to prepare for and celebrate the sacraments of 1st Reconciliation and 1st Eucharist after having completed a full year of religious instruction. Children should continue faith formation classes through 8th grade in order to be eligible to prepare for and celebrate the sacrament of Confirmation in the Fall of 9th grade.

Parish Nursing



These brain exercises may help stimulate the brain and improve memory recall as some studies have shown.

1. Try switching up your daily activity using non-dominant hand for 10-15 min a day. Examples: eating-holding fork, writing (Gives different parts of brain exercise).
2. Try singing and whistling daily.
3. Try eyes closed while chewing food - helps brain experience different sensations.
4. Try listening to music and concentrate on just one instrument at a time and then switch instrument next song.
5. Walk barefoot for a few minutes daily in safety of residence if medically appropriate.
6. Stand on one foot at a time holding onto stable table for 10 seconds - do 10 times each leg.
7. Listen to music (music that you enjoy or music that you enjoyed from the past. Especially music enjoyed from when you were 10-30 years old. Psychologists have called this the, "reminiscence bump." More memories associated with that time in life.

Care for Creation

The Inflation Reduction Act allocates \$369 billion to tackle climate change and promote lower-carbon living using a combination of rebates and tax credits. Here are some savings you can receive by buying items that will lower your carbon footprint.

Electric Vehicles (EV). The legislation provides qualifying buyers up to \$4,000 in tax credits for buying a used electric vehicle and up to \$7,500 for a new EV. These credits are available for some models now. In 2024, they will be issued through dealerships at the time of sale. There are caveats. For example, EVs must have final assembly in North America to qualify, so some brands won't be able to offer credits until they start up their North American assembly operations.



Energy Star Appliances, Smart Thermostats, and Other Products. If you are planning to replace a major appliance or purchase items like air purifier, dehumidifier, ventilation fans, check out the website [Energy Star.gov](https://www.energy.gov) for information on rebates and discounts. Most of you will find a link to PSE&G for details on rebates. For example, if you purchase a new energy star washer or dryer, you can qualify for a rebate of up to \$300. Rebates for water heaters can be as high as \$500. For most rebates, you need to complete a rebate form on PSE&G's Energy Star website. To learn more, go to [Energy Star.gov](https://www.energy.gov).

Looking for a more energy-efficient way to cool and heat your home? Consider a heat pump, a heating and cooling system that transfers heat between your home and the outdoors and can save you thousands of dollars each year in energy costs. Most households can qualify for a tax credit of up to \$2,000. If you add a smart thermostat, you can obtain an additional \$100 rebate.

PSE&G offers a home energy assessment. They send out certified energy efficiency advisors to inspect your home and assess your insulation levels, air leakage, lighting and appliances, heating and cooling systems, and water heater equipment. Contact them through [Energy Star.gov](https://www.energy.gov) (PSE&G).

Solar Panels. The new climate law provides tax credits of up to 30% to households that invest in clean energy. The credit is retroactive to the beginning of 2022 to 2032. The average cost of a residential solar system is about \$19,000, so that is \$5,700 in savings. Most people recoup the cost of installing a solar-powered system within 12 years through savings on electricity. This tax credit is taken off your federal tax return for the year when the solar panel installation is completed.

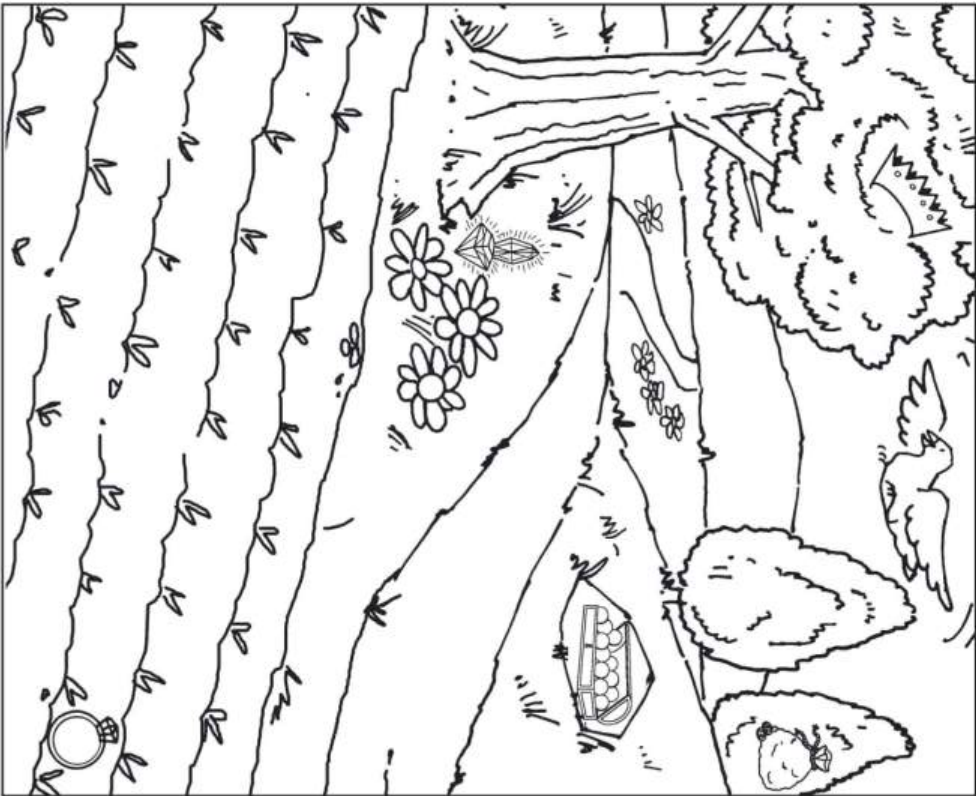
