August 20th: National Eye Exam Month



The Vision Council of America reports that even though more than 12 million Americans require vision correction, less than half of children under the age of 12 have ever had an eye exam. The American Optometric Association reports that more than 15 million Americans have an diagnosed eye disease or visual impairment and less only approximately 50% of adults have routine eye exams. Routine eye exams can not only identify visual and eye problems early (when they are easiest to treat) they can also identify other potential health concerns.

Other benefits of routine eye exams include:

- Reduction in vision related eye strain and/or headaches with an accurate visual correction prescription
- Eye exams can potentially help identify conditions such as diabetes (did you know, 90% of diabetes related blindness is preventable!), glaucoma, and even high blood pressure.

Be sure to talk to your doctor about scheduling an eye exam. Many health conditions (such as diabetes) will allow for individuals to see an eye doctor using their medical insurance, even if they do not have separate vision coverage.

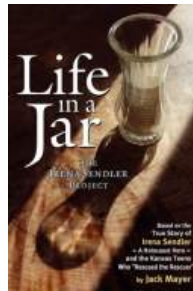

Overview: During World War II, Irena Sendler, a Polish Catholic social worker, organized a rescue network of fellow social workers to save 2,500 Jewish children from certain death in the Warsaw ghetto. Incredibly, after the war her heroism, like that of many others, was suppressed by communist Poland and remained virtually unknown for 60 years. Unknown, that is, until three high school girls from an economically depressed, rural school district in southeast Kansas stumbled upon a tantalizing reference to Sendler's rescues, which they fashioned into a history project, a play they called *Life in a Jar*. Their innocent drama was first seen in Kansas, then the Midwest, then New York, Los Angeles, Montreal, and finally Poland, where they elevated Irena Sendler to a national hero, championing her legacy of tolerance and respect for all people. *Life in a Jar: The Irena Sendler Project* is a Holocaust history and more. It is the inspirational story of Protestant students from Kansas, each carrying her own painful burden, each called in her own complex way to the history of a Catholic woman who knocked on Jewish doors in the Warsaw ghetto and, in Sendler's own words, "tried to talk the mothers out of their children." Inspired by Irena Sendler, they are living examples of the power of one person to change the world and models for young people everywhere.
