- Listen/ Read (*Lectio*): Ponder God's word and listen for what touches your heart.
- Meditate (*Meditatio*): Attend to what you notice. Allow God's word to resonate in you.
- Speak/Share (*Oratio*): Prayerfully share with Jesus or with the group your thoughts and feelings.
- Rest in God's presence (*Contemplatio*): Notice God's presence and be still, surrounded by God's love.
- Choose to act (*Actio*): Trusting in God's nearness, commit to action rooted in love.

Saturday Confession Time Changes



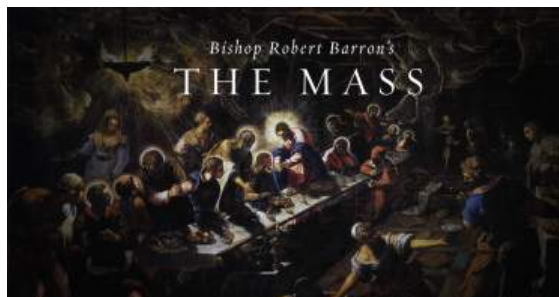
Dear brothers and sisters,

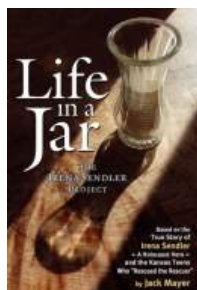

Overview: During World War II, Irena Sendler, a Polish Catholic social worker, organized a rescue network of fellow social workers to save 2,500 Jewish children from certain death in the Warsaw ghetto. Incredibly, after the war her heroism, like that of many others, was suppressed by communist Poland and remained virtually unknown for 60 years. Unknown, that is, until three high school girls from an economically depressed, rural school district in southeast Kansas stumbled upon a tantalizing reference to Sendler's rescues, which they fashioned into a history project, a play they called *Life in a Jar*. Their innocent drama was first seen in Kansas, then the Midwest, then New York, Los Angeles, Montreal, and finally Poland, where they elevated Irena Sendler to a national hero, championing her legacy of tolerance and respect for all people. *Life in a Jar: The Irene Sendler Project* is a Holocaust history and more. It is the inspirational story of Protestant students from Kansas, each carrying her own painful burden, each called in her own complex way to the history of a Catholic woman who knocked on Jewish doors in the Warsaw ghetto and, in Sendler's own words, "tried to talk the mothers out of their children." Inspired by Irena Sendler, they are living examples of the power of one person to change the world and models for young people everywhere.

CHILDREN'S LITURGY OF THE WORD

Children's Liturgy of the Word (CLOW) will resume on September 24th at the 8:30 a.m. and 10:30 a.m. Masses.

The purpose of this special Liturgy is twofold:

- To provide a quality liturgical experience
- To facilitate the proclamation and breaking open of Scripture with the children

What is Children's Liturgy of the Word?

- CLOW is a part of the Mass
- The Church encourages a separate liturgy to allow the children to participate and understand
- Appropriate for children between the ages of 5 and 12
- All are welcome - No registration is necessary
- We meet in the church and the children remain with the assembly and their parents for the opening of Mass
- The children are dismissed by the celebrant after the Opening Prayer.

Gather the Children

- The children form two groups: second grade and younger; third grade and older
- They are led to rooms in the Ministry Center of the church
- A candle is lit to remind the children of the presence of the Lord; they are reminded that they are still at Mass.
- A Reading, Responsorial Psalm, and Gospel are read.
- An interactive sharing follows: the children discuss what they heard; what the readings mean to them; practical ways they can incorporate what they heard into their everyday lives.
- The children return to the assembly after the Offertory Procession



VOLUNTEERS ARE NEEDED

- Adults and teens are needed to proclaim and share the Word of God
- Requirements: enthusiasm and the willingness to share your faith with the children of Christ Our Light Parish
- Scheduling is approximately once a month
- All materials are provided and emailed and mailed home the week before you are scheduled
- Facilitators do not have to come up with ideas - just present them and, most of all, let the children LEAD you.
- Feel free to come back with the children during a CLOW session to observe
- Facilitators have commented that they learn so much from the children
- As one child said, "CLOW helps me understand; I don't understand all those big words."

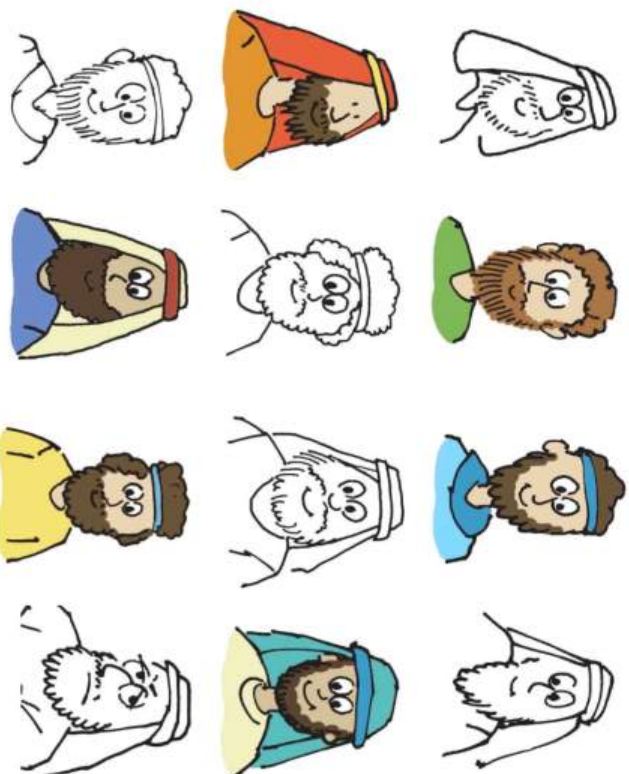

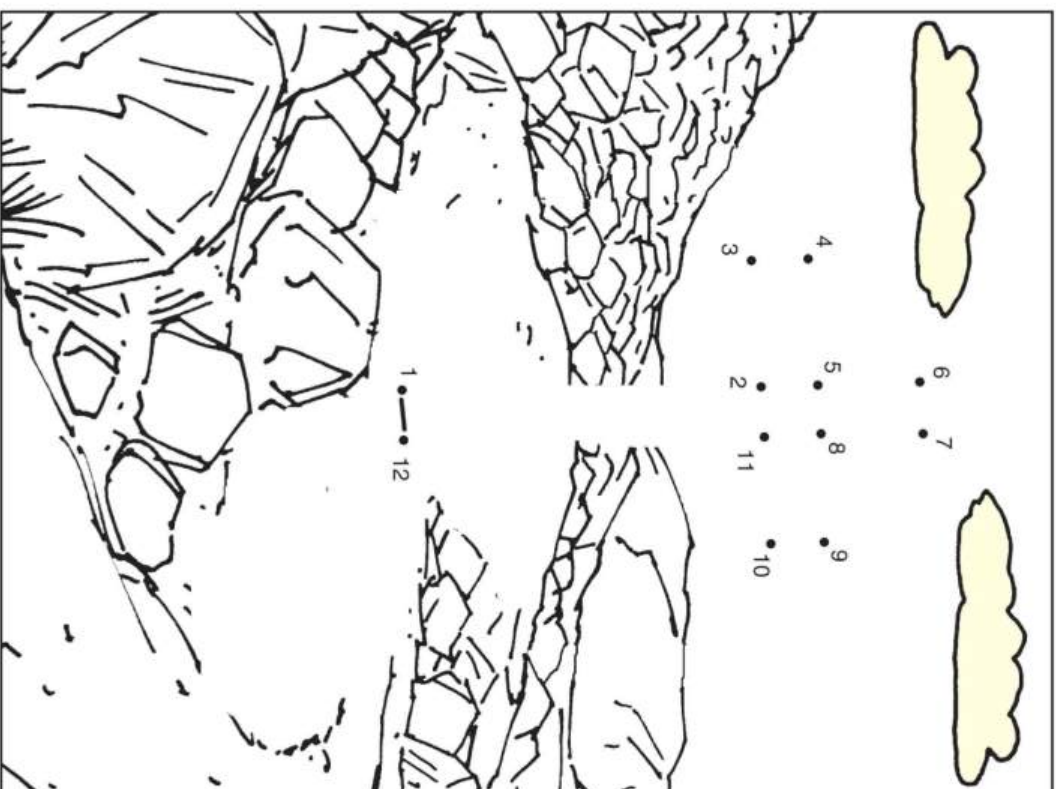

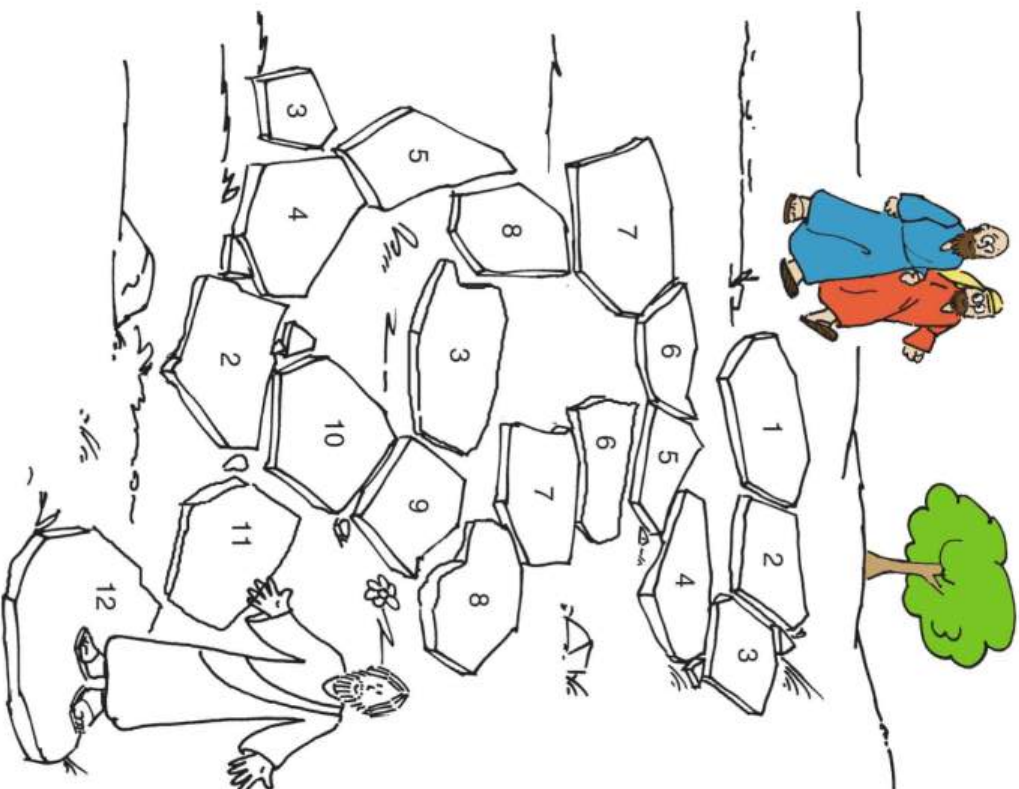
