Eucharistic Revival



Mark your calendars! Be sure to join fellow parishioners in a pilgrimage to Our Lady of Hope Parish for the **Blessed Carlo Acutis Exhibit**, being held there between October 25th and November 5th, 2023.

Blessed Carlo Acutis is a patron of the Eucharistic Revival and is on the path to sainthood; Pope Francis beatified him on Oct. 10, 2020. The exhibition is based on a website Acutis created that catalogs the 100-plus Eucharistic miracles recognized by the Catholic Church.

According to the National Catholic Register, Acutis, a gamer and computer programmer born in London and raised in Italy, was fifteen when he died of leukemia in 2006. He was devoted to serving the poor, and his deep faith led to the conversion of his family and sent him on pilgrimages to the birthplaces of saints and the sites of Eucharistic miracles.

Acutis asked to be buried in Assisi because of his love for St. Francis of Assisi, patron saint of the poor. The teenager was known for buying sleeping bags for the homeless and giving away what money he had.

And Acutis was passionate about the Holy Eucharist.

"The more often we receive the Eucharist," Acutis wrote on his website, "the more we will become like Jesus, so that on this Earth we will have a foretaste of heaven."

Acutis is nicknamed the "millennial saint" because of his youth and computer skills. Although he loved to play video games like "Halo" on his PlayStation, he reportedly limited himself to an hour of gaming a week.

CHILDREN'S LITURGY OF THE WORD

Children's Liturgy of the Word (CLOW) will resume on September 24th at the 8:30 a.m. and 10:30 a.m. Masses.

The purpose of this special Liturgy is twofold:

- To provide a quality liturgical experience
- To facilitate the proclamation and breaking open of Scripture with the children

What is Children's Liturgy of the Word?

- CLOW is a part of the Mass
- The Church encourages a separate liturgy to allow the children to participate and understand
- Appropriate for children between the ages of 5 and 12
- All are welcome - No registration is necessary
- We meet in the church and the children remain with the assembly and their parents for the opening of Mass
- The children are dismissed by the celebrant after the Opening Prayer.

Gather the Children

- The children form two groups: second grade and younger; third grade and older
- They are led to rooms in the Ministry Center of the church
- A candle is lit to remind the children of the presence of the Lord; they are reminded that they are still at Mass.
- A Reading, Responsorial Psalm, and Gospel are read.
- An interactive sharing follows: the children discuss what they heard; what the readings mean to them; practical ways they can incorporate what they heard into their everyday lives.
- The children return to the assembly after the Offertory Procession



VOLUNTEERS ARE NEEDED

- Adults and teens are needed to proclaim and share the Word of God
- Requirements: enthusiasm and the willingness to share your faith with the children of Christ Our Light Parish
- Scheduling is approximately once a month
- All materials are provided and emailed and mailed home the week before you are scheduled
- Facilitators do not have to come up with ideas - just present them and, most of all, let the children LEAD you.
- Feel free to come back with the children during a CLOW session to observe
- Facilitators have commented that they learn so much from the children
- As one child said, "CLOW helps me understand; I don't understand all those big words."

NexTrex Bench Plastic Challenge



Plastic bags and film, such as shipping mailers, bubble wrap and case wrap cannot be placed in curbside recycling because they jam sorting equipment. However, if collected separately by volunteer groups, The Trex Company processes them into high quality decking and furniture. Christ Our Light, starting October 1, will be on a mission to collect at least 500 lbs. of plastic within six months. If we reach this goal, we will receive a beautiful recycled bench from Trex. Consider saving the plastic now. **IMPORTANT; ALL PLASTIC MUST BE CLEAN, DRY AND FREE OF FOOD RESIDUE.** Save these items for the challenge: Bread bags, Bubble wrap (pop the bubbles), Dry

Cleaning bags, Newspaper sleeves, Ice bags, Plastic shipping envelopes, Ziplock and other reclosable food storage bags, Cereal bags, Case overwrap, Salt bags, Pallet wrap & stretch film, Wood pellet bags, Produce bags.

DO NOT INCLUDE THESE ITEMS: Frozen food bags, candy bar wrappers, chip and snack bags, net or mesh produce bags, Pet food bags, pre-washed salad mix bags, degradable/compostable bags or film packaging, six-pack rings, PPE – gloves, masks, or protective wear, bedding or linen packaging, shiny, crinkly films like floral wrap, vinyl shower curtains or tablecloths

DON'T SEE YOUR ITEM ON THE LIST? See if the package will stretch when you pull it. If yes, it can be included. If it tears like paper, then please don't put it in the bin. Is the package shiny or does it make a crinkly/crunchy sound in your hand? If yes, NO DOT RECYCLE in the NexTrex bin.
