Eucharistic Revival



Mark your calendars! Be sure to join fellow parishioners in a pilgrimage to Our Lady of Hope Parish for the **Blessed Carlo Acutis Exhibit**, being held there between October 25th and November 5th, 2023.

Blessed Carlo Acutis is a patron of the Eucharistic Revival and is on the path to sainthood; Pope Francis beatified him on Oct. 10, 2020. The exhibition is based on a website Acutis created that catalogs the 100-plus Eucharistic miracles recognized by the Catholic Church.

According to the National Catholic Register, Acutis, a gamer and computer programmer born in London and raised in Italy, was fifteen when he died of leukemia in 2006. He was devoted to serving the poor, and his deep faith led to the conversion of his family and sent him on pilgrimages to the birthplaces of saints and the sites of Eucharistic miracles.

Acutis asked to be buried in Assisi because of his love for St. Francis of Assisi, patron saint of the poor. The teenager was known for buying sleeping bags for the homeless and giving away what money he had.

And Acutis was passionate about the Holy Eucharist.

"The more often we receive the Eucharist," Acutis wrote on his website, "the more we will become like Jesus, so that on this Earth we will have a foretaste of heaven."

Acutis is nicknamed the "millennial saint" because of his youth and computer skills. Although he loved to play video games like "Halo" on his PlayStation, he reportedly limited himself to an hour of gaming a week.

40 Days for Life



Praise be to God that Roe vs. Wade was overturned by the Supreme Court. Abortion will no longer be promoted as a constitutional right! Now it is up to each

state to set limits. Sadly, New Jersey permits abortion through the entire 9 months of pregnancy. The Cherry Hill Women's Center performs over 200 abortions per week up through 28 weeks of pregnancy and invites mothers from other states with less liberal abortion laws to come to NJ for an abortion.

The next 40 Days for Life campaign runs from September 27th to November 5th. For our Fall campaign we aim to have at least 2 people praying peacefully on the sidewalk in front of the Cherry Hill Women's Center each hour Tuesdays-Saturdays. We especially need new volunteers for afternoon hours.

2023 Palmyra Cove Beach Sweep



2023 Palmyra Cove Beach Sweep – October 21 from 10 AM to 1 PM

Looking for your giant 3-foot teddy bear. It is one of the 376,969 items collected during the two 2022 Clean Ocean Action (COA) Beach Sweeps. COA continues to use community science data to advocate for laws to reduce plastic pollution. Since the recent law “Single-Use Waste Reduction Act” which became fully effective in May 2022, the New Jersey Food Council estimated that 3.44 billion plastic bags and 68 million paper bags were eliminated from the waste stream in just the first 5 months. The bill is the result of advocacy using the data that the New Jersey COA beach sweeps compiled. You can be part of this 38-year-old grass roots effort.

Parishioners from Christ Our Light-preschoolers to seniors- have an opportunity to be “citizen scientists” for a few hours on October 21st from 10 AM to 1PM at the Palmyra Cove Nature Center. All you need is a willingness to be a “citizen scientist” for three hours.

You can wear old sneakers (no sandals), rain boots or hiking boots, comfortable warm clothes (river front is often cooler and windier) and work gloves. Garbage bags, grabbers, and tally sheets will be provided. The Clean Ocean Action Beach Sweep requires everyone to register and sign a waiver. Volunteers under 18 will need a parent to complete the waiver for them. Children under 12 must be accompanied by an adult and both must be registered.

To register, visit <https://cleanoceanaction.org>. Click on Beach sweeps tab. At bottom of that page look at third bullet point (Beach Sweep Volunteer) and then click on the link to register at the top of the page. Sign the waiver and then click next. Complete your name and for group/organization type Christ Our Light Catholic Church. Complete your address and phone number. At the bottom of the page will be an arrow with a county showing. Click on arrow and scroll to Burlington County. Click on Burlington County. Click on next. Palmyra Cove is one of two Burlington County sites.

Also contact Sandy Czerniakowski at dczerniakowski@comcast.net to let her know that you have registered and to answer any questions you may have. It is suggested that you bring a large bucket with a handle which is more environmentally friendly than a plastic bag. The Palmyra Cove Beach Sweep is held when the tides are good for the sweep. That is why Palmyra Cove Beach Sweep starts at 10 AM and not 9:00 AM. There will be a Captain from Clean Ocean Action to assist us on October 21.

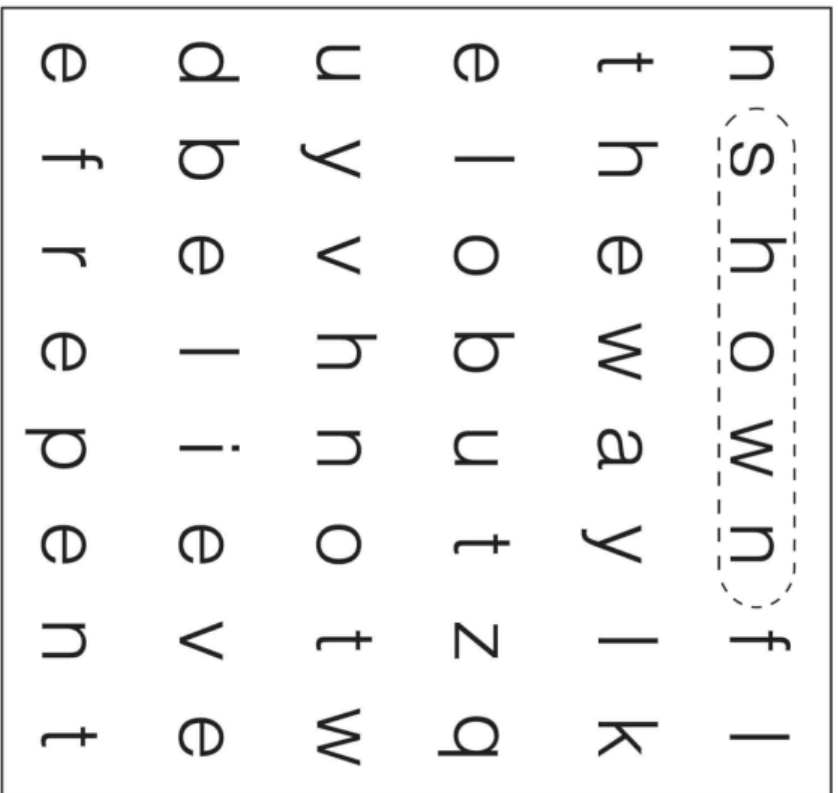
