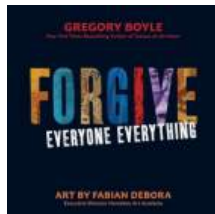

- October 16th - St. Margaret Mary Alacoque (associated with devotion to the Sacred Heart of Jesus)
- October 18th - St. Luke The Evangelist (apostle, Gospel writer)
- October 20th - St. Paul of The Cross
- October 22nd - Saint Pope John Paul II
- October 28th - St. Jude Thaddeus
