- Meditate (*Meditatio*): Attend to what you notice. Allow God's word to resonate in you.
- Speak/Share (*Oratio*): Prayerfully share with Jesus or with the group your thoughts and feelings.
- Rest in God's presence (*Contemplatio*): Notice God's presence and be still, surrounded by God's love.
- Choose to act (*Actio*): Trusting in God's nearness, commit to action rooted in love.

How can you help in your family, school, and community?

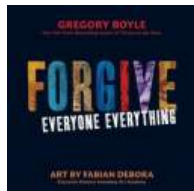

Eucharistic Revival



Today, on his feast day, Catholics worldwide remember St. John Paul II. His "secret" to life and all that he did, he said, was the Eucharist - Christ present on earth.

Born Karol Józef Wojtyła in Wadowice, Poland, in 1920, the saint served as pope from 1978 until his death in 2005. During his nearly 27-year pontificate, his teachings transformed the Catholic Church. He is perhaps most remembered for his charismatic nature, his love for young people, his world travels, and his role in the fall of communism in Europe. He was canonized a saint in 2014, less than ten years after his death.

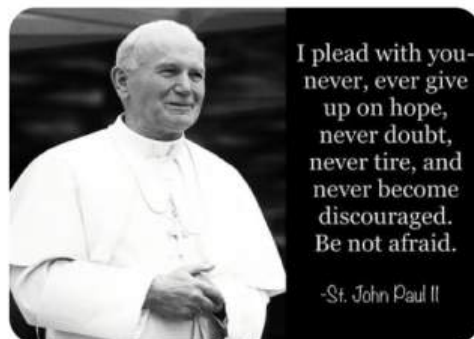
As we continue this year of Eucharistic Revival at the parish level, let us meditate on several of this beloved saint's quotes reflecting on his love for the Eucharist.

"The Eucharist is the secret of my day. It gives strength and meaning to all my activities of service to the Church and to the whole world ... Let Jesus present in the Blessed Sacrament speak to your hearts. It is he who is the true answer of life that you seek. He stays here with us: He is God with us. Seek him without tiring; welcome him without reserve; love him without interruption: today, tomorrow, forever!" — Address to young people of Bologna, Italy, Sept. 27, 1997

"Jesus is not an idea, a sentiment, a memory! Jesus is a 'Person,' always alive and present with us! Love Jesus present in the Eucharist. He is present in a sacrificial way in Holy Mass, which renews the Sacrifice of the Cross. To go to Mass means going to Calvary to meet him, our Redeemer. He comes to us in Holy Communion and remains present in the tabernacles of our churches, for he is our friend." —

Who served?

We had 111 individuals/families who completed projects at home, at Christ Our Light, or out in the local community.

In addition, we are grateful for several groups that signed up to serve together such as the RCS 6th, 7th, and 8th grade religion classes, RCS Girl Scout Troop 30311, COL Boy Scout Troop 70, the COL 1st grade catechism class, students at Westfield Friends School, and the Servus Dei prayer group.

We had 42 blood donors at our Blood Drive.

Where did they serve?

Teams served out in the community at United Methodist Communities, a green space in Cherry Hill, Saddler's Woods, the South Jersey Food Bank, Holy Name School, Good Counsel Home, Ronald McDonald House, Joseph's House, Cathedral Kitchen, Cherry Hill Food Bank and Kids Alley.

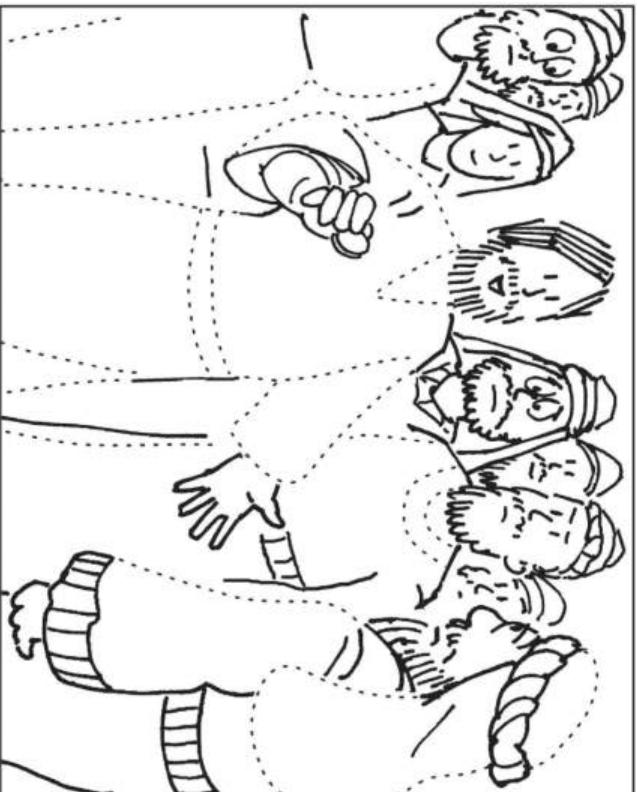

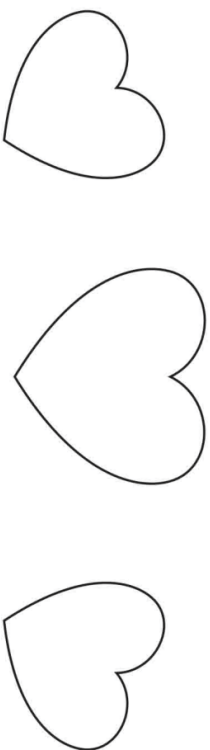

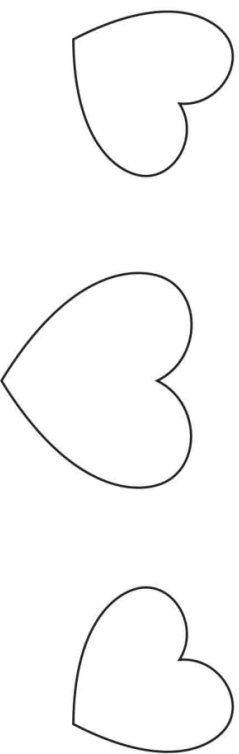
