Giving Sunday

My dear brothers and sisters in Christ,

As we approach the Thanksgiving season, I pray that God continues to bless you, your families and friends.

Part of our duties and responsibilities is to support our parish, diocese and universal Church so that each can operate in an efficient and effective manner bringing the many ministries of the Church to life, so that they are active and vigorous.

I think you would agree that Christ Our Light is a vibrant parish with our multitude of ministries, services and activities provided to the community.

Without the support and involvement of a very large group of parishioners it would be impossible to provide these programs and accomplishing the greater good for our parishioners and community.

However, we need your further support now more than ever.

With the financial oversight and guidance of our parish Finance Council, our Church has operated with the best possible stewardship while facing increasing challenges.

For instance, since 2017, the Church's weekly Sunday donation income has declined by 13%. Please note that your generous donations are critical to the Church as they account for 75% of the income. During this same period, utilities and insurance expenses have increased by 22%.

The combination of lower income and higher expenses is squeezing the Church finances into an uncomfortable position. At this time, we need to raise \$50,000 in additional income to maintain our budget.

It has been over five years since the Church has appealed to our parishioners to consider their level of financial support. [In order to invite our parishioners to consider their level of financial support, we are designating the weekend of November 18 and 19, 2023, as Giving Sunday.](#)

There are different ways that you can help:

- If you use the Church envelopes, please consider increasing your weekly contribution by 10% or whatever amount that you are comfortable with.
- Similarly, if you donate through an electronic means, such as Parish Giving or your bank's electronic transfer fund, please go into the application and consider increasing your weekly contribution.
- You may also make a one-time donation by placing more money in the collection basket when attending Church on the weekend of November 11 and 12.

On behalf of the Finance Council and myself, we are deeply appreciative of your kind consideration and generosity to continue supporting the wonderful and necessary programs benefiting our parishioners and community. Without you, we would not be the welcoming and caring community of Christ Our Light. May the Lord Jesus continue to bless you for your great love and support of our parish.

Eucharistic Revival



THIS SUNDAY IS THE FINAL DAY! During this year of Eucharistic Revival at the parish level, be sure to make it a point this week to visit Our Lady of Hope Parish Chapel in Blackwood, NJ for the **Blessed Carlo Acutis Exhibit**, being held there between October 25th and November 5th, 2023.

Blessed Carlo Acutis is a patron of the Eucharistic Revival and is on the path to sainthood; Pope Francis beatified him on Oct. 10, 2020. Throughout his short life, and from an early age, Acutis was passionate about the Holy Eucharist.

“Thousands of people stand in interminable lines to buy tickets to rock concerts or soccer matches, but I don’t see crowds of people lined up outside church waiting to see Jesus in the Eucharist. This should make us pause and reflect.” - Blessed Carlo Acutis

The exhibition is based on a website Acutis created that catalogs the 100-plus Eucharistic miracles recognized by the Catholic Church. The exhibit highlights information about the Eucharistic miracles; each panel names a miracle, recounts the story of its occurrence, and the country where it took place. The panels are arranged in chronological order from the early Third Century to 2013. Be sure to notice the date on the timeline and some of the world events that will help you to place it within the historical era. Remember that the historical miracles we are learning about on the walls of the exhibit are all pointing to the miracle in front of us—Jesus, present in the Most Holy Eucharist!

Though no one knows the mind of God, perhaps he allows Eucharistic miracles so that, like the doubting St. Thomas, we, too, may “see and believe.”

Note that the exhibit will also be coming to other local parishes:

- Nov 6 - Nov 20, 2023 - Our Lady of Perpetual Help in Moorestown
- Jan 13 - Jan 20, 2024 - St. Andrew the Apostle in Gibbsboro
- Feb 11 - Feb 24, 2024 - Christ the King in Had-donfield

Semi-Annual Collection

We support the Cherry Hill Food Pantry by supplying volunteers several times a year and through an annual donation from our congregation. In the past, we have also supported them through several food collections during the year. However, their biggest ongoing need is money. Presently, the CHFP is working to create a new parking lot. The parking lot will allow the CHFP to return to the food distribution model which allows clients to come in and shop for the food they need and like. The estimated cost of the parking lot is \$300,000. For the next few weeks, we will have envelopes at all the church doors. If you would like to make a donation, please put your donation in the envelope and put it in the regular offertory collection. Checks should be made out to the Cherry Hill Food Pantry (or CHFP). The CHFP is providing food to between 160-180 households per week. With rising food costs, this is an invaluable service. Thank you for your generosity.
