4th Sunday of Advent & Christmas Masses

My dear brothers and sisters,

I pray that you are all blessed as we continue our journey during Advent to Bethlehem, the place where our Lord was born.

The Church has celebrated the Great Solemnity of Christmas for two thousand years. It is a Solemnity that moves, since it is always celebrated on the 25th of December, that means that it can fall on different days of the week according to the movement of the yearly calendar. Sometimes we have a longer Advent Season, for example, if Christmas falls on a Saturday or Sunday, the previous Sunday would be the 4th Sunday of Advent with six \ seven more days to Christmas, however, when Christmas falls on a Monday, there are only a few hours before Christmas. And that is the case for this year, which may cause some confusion in terms of one's duties to fulfill their obligation for Sunday and Christmas.

This year the 4th Sunday of Advent falls on Sunday December 24th. See the schedule following.

The Solemnity of Christmas begins on the evening of Sunday the 24th into Monday the 25th, also see the schedule following.

So far instance there are no two for ones. I.e., I attend the 4pm Mass on Christmas Eve which is a Sunday, trying to fulfill both my Sunday Obligation and Christmas obligation. That is incorrect and not possible, you would only be fulfilling your Christmas obligation and vice-versa if one attends the 10:30am Mass on the 4th Sunday of Advent which is also Dec. 24th thinking they fulfilled their Sunday obligation as well as their Christmas obligation.

I don't like to sound legalistic, and I always prefer using the language of invitation, being called by Christ and as faithful disciples we answer that call to come and praise and worship him – as you know we are all called to a great wedding banquet, even if our Lord calls us twice in one day. I will provide a simple schedule below. The purple is one invitation - obligation and the gold is another invitation – obligation.

I hope I did not cause more confusion but that I have simplified the schedule. We will not have to worry about this occurring again for about 4-5 years as next year, 2024, Christmas falls on a Wednesday due to 2024 being a leap year.

You are all in my prayers as I pray that you will all have a wonderful, blessed and Merry Christmas.

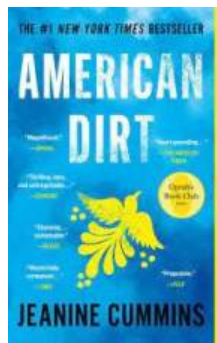
Charitable Giving

Year-End Charitable Giving via a Qualified Charitable Distribution (QCD)



If you are looking to lower your taxable income, you may want to consider a QCD. If you are age 70½ or older, IRS rules require you to take required minimum distributions (RMDs) each year from your tax-deferred retirement accounts. This additional taxable income may push you into a higher tax bracket and may also reduce your eligibility for certain tax credits and deductions. To eliminate or reduce the impact of RMD income, charitably inclined investors may want to consider making a qualified charitable distribution (QCD). A QCD is a direct transfer of funds from an IRA custodian, payable to a qualified charity, as described in the QCD provision in the Internal Revenue Code. Amounts distributed as a QCD can be counted toward satisfying your RMD for the year, up to \$100,000, and can also be excluded from your taxable income. This is not the case with a regular withdrawal from an IRA, even if you use the money to make a charitable contribution later on. In this scenario, the funds would be counted as taxable income even if you later offset that income with the charitable contribution deduction. Please consult a tax advisor to learn more. If you are 70½ or older, own an IRA, and donate to charity, QCDs may make sense for you; consult a tax advisor regarding your specific situation.

Eucharistic Revival



On this fourth Sunday of Advent, we hear these words of Mary during the Annunciation: "*Behold, I am the handmaid of the Lord. May it be done to me according to your word.*" -Luke 1:38a.

The word "handmaid" means "servant." And Mary identifies herself as a servant...specifically, a servant of the Lord. Our Blessed Mother, however, is a brand new type of handmaid. Why? Because the one she was called to serve was the Most Holy Trinity. Our Blessed Mother's servitude, therefore, is new in that it is the most radical form of servitude, but it is also freely chosen. And the reciprocal effect upon her from the Most Holy Trinity was to direct all her thoughts and actions, all her passions and desires and every single part of her life to glory, fulfillment and holiness of life.

We must learn from the wisdom and actions of our Blessed Mother! She submitted her life completely to the Most Holy Trinity, not only for her own good but also to set an example for each one of us. Our deepest and daily prayer must become that of hers: "I am the handmaid of the Lord. May it be done to me according to your word." Following her example will not only deeply unite us with our Triune God, but it will also have a similar effect upon us by making us instruments of the Savior of the World. We will become His "mother" in the sense that we will bring Jesus into our world for others. What a glorious calling we have been given to imitate this most holy Mother of God.

Let this be our prayer during this fourth week of Advent, a week of LOVE as represented by the fourth purple candle:

Dearest Mother Mary, pray for me that I may imitate your perfect "Yes" to the Most Holy Trinity. May your prayer become my prayer, and may the effects of your surrender as a handmaid of the Lord also affect my life profoundly. Lord, Jesus, may Your perfect will, in union with the will of the Father and the Holy Spirit, be done in my life today and always. Jesus, I trust in You. Amen.
