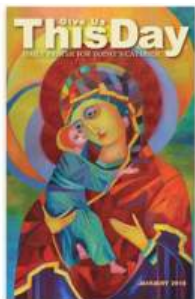
Prayer Requests List Update

Give Us This Day

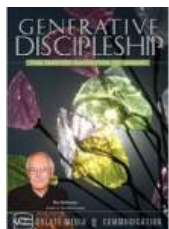

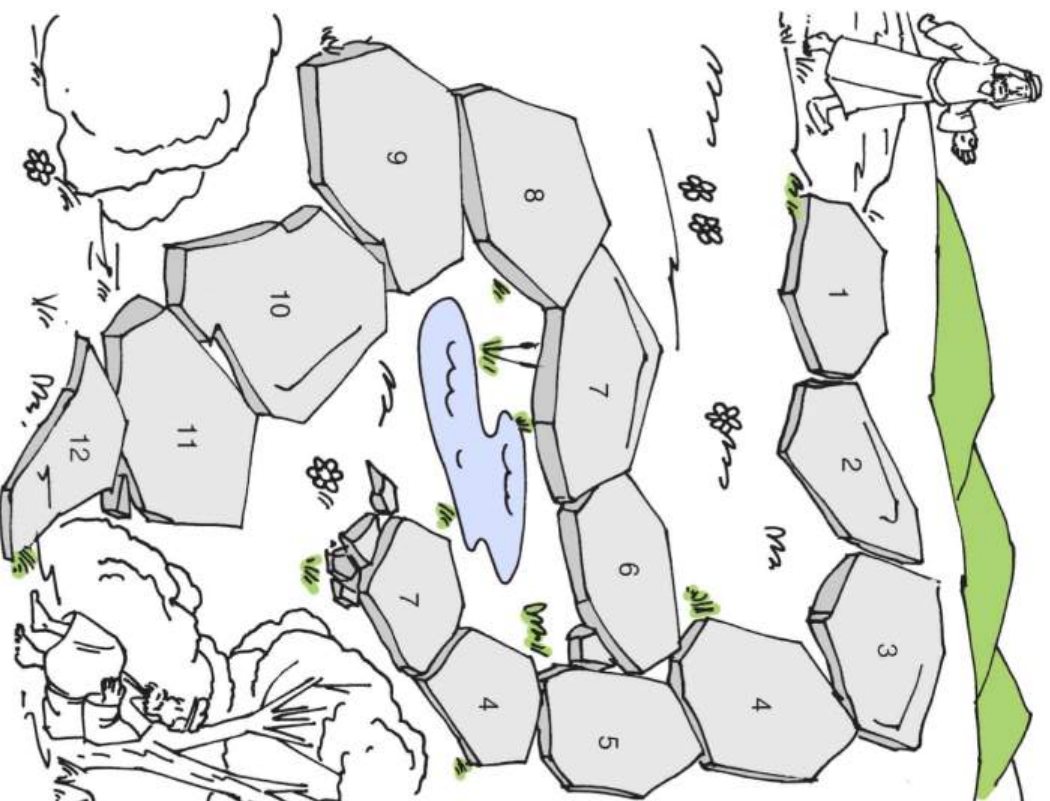

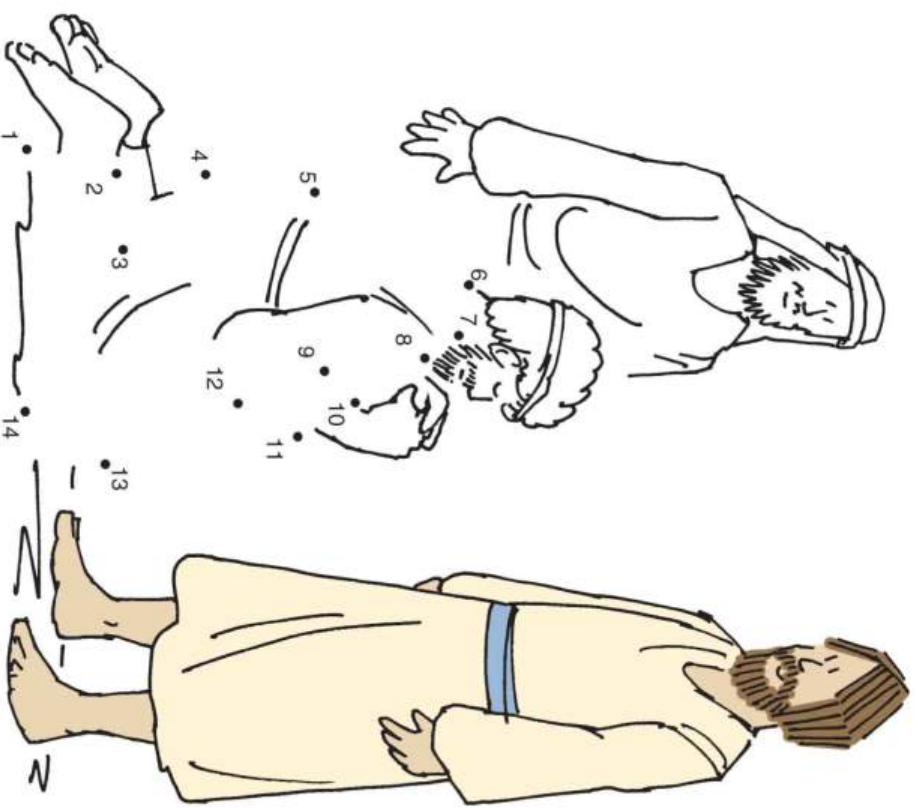
