LIVING IN THE LIGHT

The Word

Reading for May 5, 2024
John 15:9-17)

Adults:

Jesus has called you His friend, what does friendship with Christ mean to you?

We offer this form of *Lectio Divina* (sacred reading) for pondering Scripture and for faith sharing with family members and other people.

- Listen/ Read (*Lectio*): Ponder God's word and listen for what touches your heart.
- Meditate (*Meditatio*): Attend to what you notice. Allow God's word to resonate in you.
- Speak/Share (*Oratio*): Prayerfully share with Jesus or with the group your thoughts and feelings.
- Rest in God's presence (*Contemplatio*): Notice God's presence and be still, surrounded by God's love.
- Choose to act (*Actio*): Trusting in God's nearness, commit to action rooted in love.

Youth:

In your life of faith what brings you joy?

Children:

Jesus asks us to follow His commandments; one of them is to love your neighbor. Do I ever find it hard to love someone and why?

May we reflect on our relationship with Jesus borrowing the words of St. Teresa - substituting our own name for hers and then hearing Jesus add our name to His. And as Jesus speaks our name, we find our joy. So remain in His love.

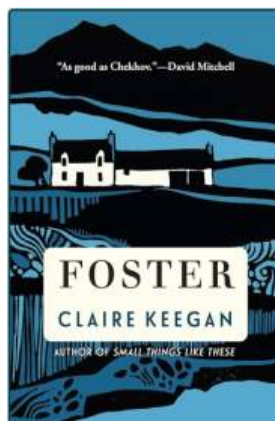
Hospitality - Coffee & Donuts

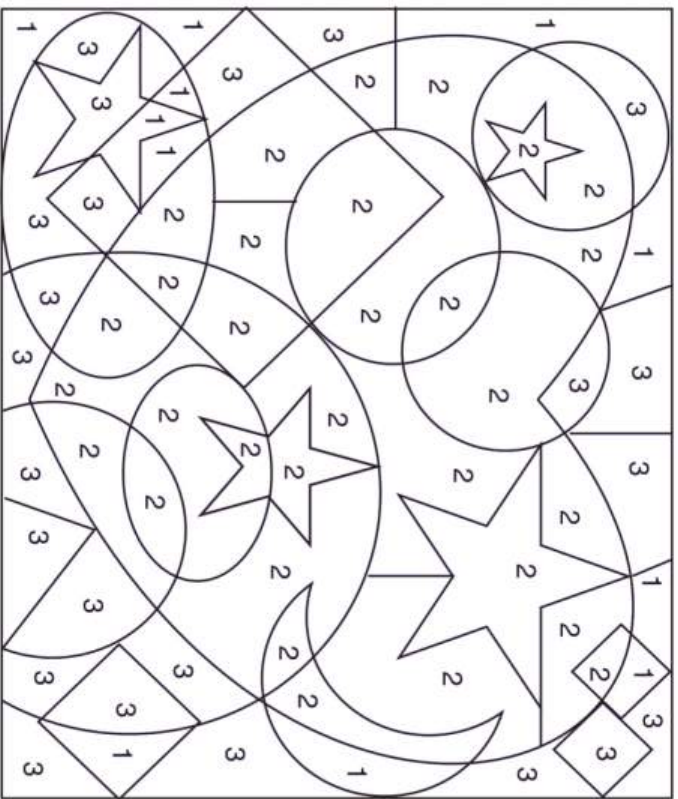
