### Come and See



*And looking around at those seated in the circle he said, "Here are my mother and my brothers. For whoever does the will of God is my brother and sister and mother."*

*Mark 3:20-35*

God's presence in the world, manifested through Jesus' words and actions, repeatedly upends traditional assumptions about what is normal. So it's no surprise that Jesus' attitude to the family is not conventional in any way. He redefines the criteria for who constitutes his true family. Jesus speaks to deeply embedded cultural assumptions when he determines his true family, not by blood relations or kinship ties but by doing the will of God. He sees his own Mother as blessed, not because she is his biological mother, but because she hears the word of God and does his will. Relationship with Jesus is not contingent on biology, genealogy and pedigree but on listening faithfully to the Spirit and actively doing the will of God. This establishment of relationship creates a new family based on faith and response to God through encounter with Jesus.

For believers today, this gospel passage is a source of great joy. We are offered a place in Jesus' family, not as a servant, but as a sister, mother or brother of the Lord himself. It is a great privilege and enormous responsibility powered through the Holy Spirit. It is up to us to hear God's word and do his will.

We are offered an opportunity to sit with the Mother of Jesus and ponder, as she did, on her faith journey as a disciple of her son. Do we often forget to embrace others in the church as our brothers and sisters in Christ? Are we often divided by liturgical preference and political leanings? But the unity Christ wants for us is the unity made real in the Eucharist. It is far greater and more real than anything that divides us. We can spread joy by living the Good News of our Lord and Brother Jesus Christ. Come and See!

#### **Semi-Annual Collection**

Christ Our Light is one of several local churches which supports the Cherry Hill Food Pantry in several ways, such as supplying volunteers several times a year and through an annual donation from our congregation. In the past, we have also supported them through several food collections during the year. However, their biggest ongoing need is money. **Our spring collection for the CHFP will take place from June 15-30.**

Construction has started on their new parking lot to allow the CHFP to return to the food distribution model which allows clients to come in and shop for the food they need and like. The estimated cost of the parking lot is \$524,251. Grants are paying \$300,000, and so CHFP is working to raise the remaining \$224,251. We will have envelopes at all the church doors during the second half of June. If you would like to make a donation, please put your donation in the envelope and put it in the regular offertory collection. Checks should be made out to the Cherry Hill Food Pantry (or CHFP).

The CHFP is providing food to between 160-180 households per week. With food costs remaining high, this is an invaluable service. Thank you for your generosity!

Please do not drop off unsolicited donations of books, clothing, medical supplies, cookware, appliances, etc. in the Church or Parish Center unless the donation is labeled for a specific recipient or is intended for a parish-coordinated donation drive. We thank you for your support and generosity!

### Donations Accepted Year-Round



- The COL Food Pantry always needs staples like toilet paper, laundry detergent, soup, tuna, canned dinners (like Chef Boyardee), peanut butter, jelly, canned vegetables, rice, beans, cereal, etc. We can only accept nonperishable goods since we do not have a pantry refrigerator.
- Sr. Mary Berryman of the SSJ Neighborhood Center collects red, white, or black beans (in bags or cans) and toilet paper in the Gathering Space monthly (see bulletin for dates) as well as baby diapers, wipes, and toys in the Parish Office.
- Sr. Helen Cole of Guadalupe Family Services collects baby diapers and wipes in the Parish Office.
- Joseph's House volunteers collect frozen homemade casseroles monthly in the Servers' Room freezer. They also collect coffee, tea, sugar, creamer, snacks and baked goods, bottled water and other drinks, men's and women's clothing, new socks and underwear, toiletries, backpacks, luggage, blankets, and towels on the table in the Servers' Room.
- Helping God's Precious Infants (a local pro-life ministry) collects worn sneakers in a bin outside of the Ministry Center Conference Room.
- Clothing that is too worn to be donated can go in the blue bin for textile recycling in the parking lot close to the main entrance.
