Welcome to Bishop Joseph A. Williams



Christ Our Light would like to congratulate and welcome Bishop Joseph A. Williams as coadjutor bishop of the Diocese of Camden. He will replace Bishop Sullivan when his resignation is officially accepted on his 80th birthday, March 17, 2025. During this time of transition, Bishop Sullivan retains the full responsibility for the Diocese of Camden, as Bishop Williams learns the diocese and acquaints himself with South Jersey.

Bishop Williams was ordained a priest of the Archdiocese of Saint Paul and Minneapolis in 2002. Bishop Williams holds a B.A. in biology from the University of Minnesota, Morris, graduating summa cum laude in 1996. He studied philosophy and pre-theology at Franciscan University of Steubenville, Ohio, from 1996-1998 and attended The St. Paul Seminary School of Divinity in St. Paul from 1998-2002, where he earned a Master of Divinity degree.

Bishop Williams is known for his longtime ministry to Latino and Spanish-speaking Catholics in the Archdiocese of Saint Paul and Minneapolis, beginning in Faribault, where he and other parish leaders worked to bring healing to a Latino community that had been wounded by drug raids.

A coadjutor bishop appointed to a Catholic diocese or archdiocese to assist the diocesan bishop. Unlike an auxiliary bishop, he has the right of succession, meaning that he automatically becomes the new bishop when the diocesan bishop retires or dies. By canon law, he is also vicar general of the diocese. In recent years, a growing number of U.S. bishops in larger dioceses or archdioceses have requested and received a coadjutor in their final year or two before their retirement, in order to familiarize their successor with the workings of the (arch)diocese before he has to take over the reins. This minimizes the learning curve of a new bishop and eliminates completely the possibility of the diocese being vacant following the old bishop's retirement.

Today's Gospel Acclamation says it all.

"The seed is the word of God, Christ is the sower. All who come to him will live forever."

Cherry Hill Food Pantry Collection



Semi-Annual Collection

Christ Our Light is one of several local churches which supports the Cherry Hill Food Pantry in several ways, such as supplying volunteers several times a year and through an annual donation from our congregation. In the past, we have also supported them through several food collections during the year. Construction has started on their new parking lot to allow the CHFP to return to the food distribution model which allows clients to come in and shop for the food they need and like. The estimated cost of the parking lot is \$524,251. CHFP has secured \$300,000 in grants, and so they are working to raise the remaining \$224,251.

Our spring collection for the CHFP will take place from June 15-30. We will have marked envelopes at all the church doors. If you would like to make a donation, please put your donation in the envelope and put it in the regular offertory collection. Checks should be made out to the Cherry Hill Food Pantry (or CHFP). The CHFP is providing food to between 160-180 households per week. With rising food costs, this is an invaluable service. Thank you for your generosity!

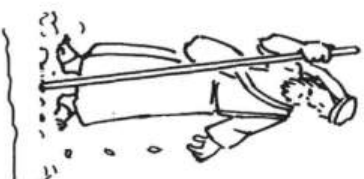
