Now that the weather is improving maybe the able bodied could consider parking there so our elderly or those not able to walk the distance could park closer to the church.

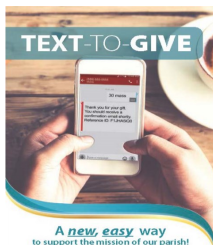
Let's be careful and considerate of one another. It appears many are in a great hurry to get on their way so maybe this is an invitation for all of us to slow down.

Then he asked them, "Why are you terrified? Do you not yet have faith?" (Mark 4:35-41)

In reading today's Bible story, I think about the popular slogan "Jesus Saves" that appears on bumper stickers, road-side billboards and at sporting events.

What does the phrase "Jesus Saves" really mean? As Catholics, we know Jesus is God in human form who came to earth as a true human being in order to save us. We also know from the Bible that all humans have sinned. Therefore, because of Jesus's great love for us, He sacrificed himself by laying down his life to pay the penalty for our sins. Then, with Jesus's rising from the dead three days later, He showed two things. First, His death was an adequate payment for our sins. Second, Jesus shows His life has conquered death on our behalf.

But this is not a one-sided relationship with Jesus doing everything. We have to do our part in deepening our faith in Jesus. Having faith means fully trusting in Jesus. Everyone who has faith in Jesus will receive His gift of salvation.

So how do we continue to increase our faith in Jesus? Keep doing some of the things you are already doing, for example:

- Attending weekly Mass
- Praying a few minutes every day
- Go to confession
- Read the daily Mass readings
- Find a way to volunteer your time in one of the numerous Christ Our Light ministries

Also, become an advocate and participant in our Parish's Come and See initiative. The premise of Come and See is to deepen our faith in the Lord and inviting others to get to know Jesus so they can also be saved. You can accomplish this by signing up for the upcoming Fall sessions and inviting others to attend these sessions with you.

Cherry Hill Food Pantry Collection



Semi-Annual Collection

Christ Our Light is one of several local churches which supports the Cherry Hill Food Pantry in

several ways, such as supplying volunteers several times a year and through an annual donation from our congregation. In the past, we have also supported them through several food collections during the year. Construction has started on their new parking lot to allow the CHFP to return to the food distribution model which allows clients to come in and shop for the food they need and like. The estimated cost of the parking lot is \$524,251. CHFP has secured \$300,000 in grants, and so they are working to raise the remaining \$224,251.

Our spring collection for the CHFP will take place from June 15-30. We will have marked envelopes at all the church doors. If you would like to make a donation, please put your donation in the envelope and put it in the regular offertory collection. Checks should be made out to the Cherry Hill Food Pantry (or CHFP). The CHFP is providing food to between 160-180 households per week. With rising food costs, this is an invaluable service. Thank you for your generosity!
