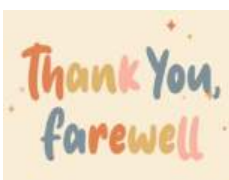

Temporary Closure of Kings Highway Entrance



On Monday, July 1, concrete repair work will commence on the Kings Highway driveway entrance to the Church parking lot. The entrance will be **CLOSED** to all vehicular traffic from Monday, July 1 until Saturday, July 6, 12 noon. During this time period, the exit drive will temporarily be used as a two-way entrance and exit driveway. There will be signage along Kings Highway indicating these changes.

The repair work is weather dependent. In the event of inclement weather on July 1, the repair work will be delayed until the week of July 8th.

Reading for June 30, 2024

Mark 5: 21-24, 35-43

Adults:

When have you sought or shown compassion in a time of need? Call to mind those you know who are in need of healing or forgiveness.

We offer this form of *Lectio Divina* (sacred reading) for pondering Scripture and for faith sharing with family members and other people.

- Listen/ Read (*Lectio*): Ponder God's word and listen for what touches your heart.
- Meditate (*Meditatio*): Attend to what you notice. Allow God's word to resonate in you.
- Speak/Share (*Oratio*): Prayerfully share with Jesus or with the group your thoughts and feelings.
- Rest in God's presence (*Contemplatio*): Notice God's presence and be still, surrounded by God's love.
- Choose to act (*Actio*): Trusting in God's nearness, commit to action rooted in love.

Youth:

We celebrate the Sacrament of Anointing of the Sick to bring healing and forgiveness to people who are sick. When have you experienced or offered healing or forgiveness?

Children:

One way we care for those who are sick is by praying for them. Who in your life needs a healing prayer?

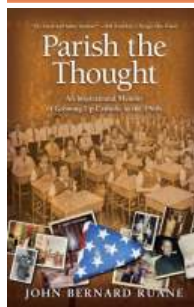

Christ Our Light is on a journey to know, love, and serve Christ in our parish community. Together we must embrace Christ's vision for missionary discipleship so our parish can thrive and be a place for others to grow together

in faith.

The very important step in this process involves **assessing our greatest strengths and opportunities**, and that is where the **Disciple Maker Index (DMI)** comes in! The DMI is an important survey tool that invites you to reflect on your discipleship journey here at Christ Our Light. The Disciple Maker Index is designed to:

- Invite parishioners to reflect on their journey of discipleship.
- Enable parish leadership to make data-driven decisions.
- Help parishioners grow in their faith.

The 10–15-minute survey can be accessed through an online link from July 30th through September 3rd and will ask you to reflect on your own spiritual growth and enable you to provide your perspective on our parish's efforts to help you grow in relationship with Christ. All responses will be confidential, and the parish will only receive information about the community as a whole. We will share the link with you a bit closer to the launch of the survey. Paper surveys will also be available for those who do not have the ability to complete the survey online.

Together we must embrace Christ's vision for missionary discipleship so our parish can thrive and be a place for others to grow together in faith.

Come and See



Two people needed healing that this world could not offer. A twelve year old girl was dying and none of her father's wealth and prestige could prevent it. A woman suffered from a bleeding

disorder for twelve years. She spent her life savings trying to be healed but the medical community could not cure her. The young girl came from a family of privilege. The woman was an outcast - considered unclean, impure, and not worthy to be in the presence of God or others.

Jairus *came to see* Jesus and pleaded with Him to come and save his daughter's life. The woman also *came to see* Jesus...but really, to be *near* Jesus. She could never dream of approaching Him face to face due to her condition. Both of them believed that Jesus could make a difference and so they went to encounter Him. Jairus' daughter died before Jesus arrived. It appeared to be over...but not for Jesus. He continued to the home of Jairus and awakened the girl from her sleep...for there is no death with God. The woman was healed by touching the garment of Jesus and the unimaginable happened - Jesus took her from the shadows and held her up as a model of faith. She had always been worthy of God's presence.

The Book of Wisdom proclaims, "God did not make death, nor does he rejoice in the destruction of the living." Where do we need healing in our lives? Do we believe and trust that Jesus can make a difference? Accepting the invitation of Jesus to *come and see* does not exempt us from suffering, challenges or even death. But our Gospel today reminds us that our suffering matters to God. Jesus is the living embodiment of hope. His presence among us confirms that God cares. God is here - journeying with us, loving us and healing us. So *come and see*...

Cherry Hill Food Pantry Collection



Semi-Annual Collection

Christ Our Light is one of several local churches which supports the Cherry Hill Food Pantry in

several ways, such as supplying volunteers several times a year and through an annual donation from our congregation. In the past, we have also supported them through several food collections during the year. Construction has started on their new parking lot to allow the CHFP to return to the food distribution model which allows clients to come in and shop for the food they need and like. The estimated cost of the parking lot is \$524,251. CHFP has secured \$300,000 in grants, and so they are working to raise the remaining \$224,251.

Our spring collection for the CHFP will take place from June 15-30. We will have marked envelopes at all the church doors. If you would like to make a donation, please put your donation in the envelope and put it in the regular offertory collection. Checks should be made out to the Cherry Hill Food Pantry (or CHFP). The CHFP is providing food to between 160-180 households per week. With rising food costs, this is an invaluable service. Thank you for your generosity!

As summer vacation is in full swing, RCS and Christ Our Light parish want to extend to you an invitation to join the reigning SJ Catholic League champion Resurrection Cross Country team. 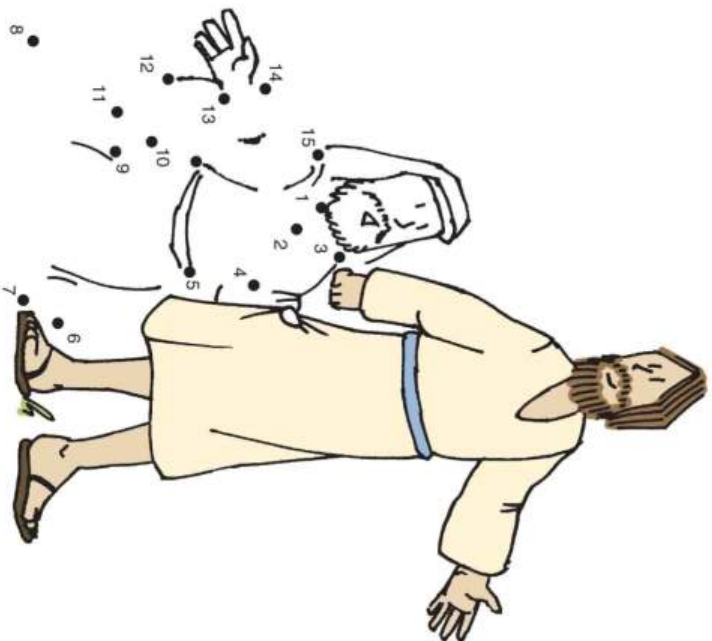

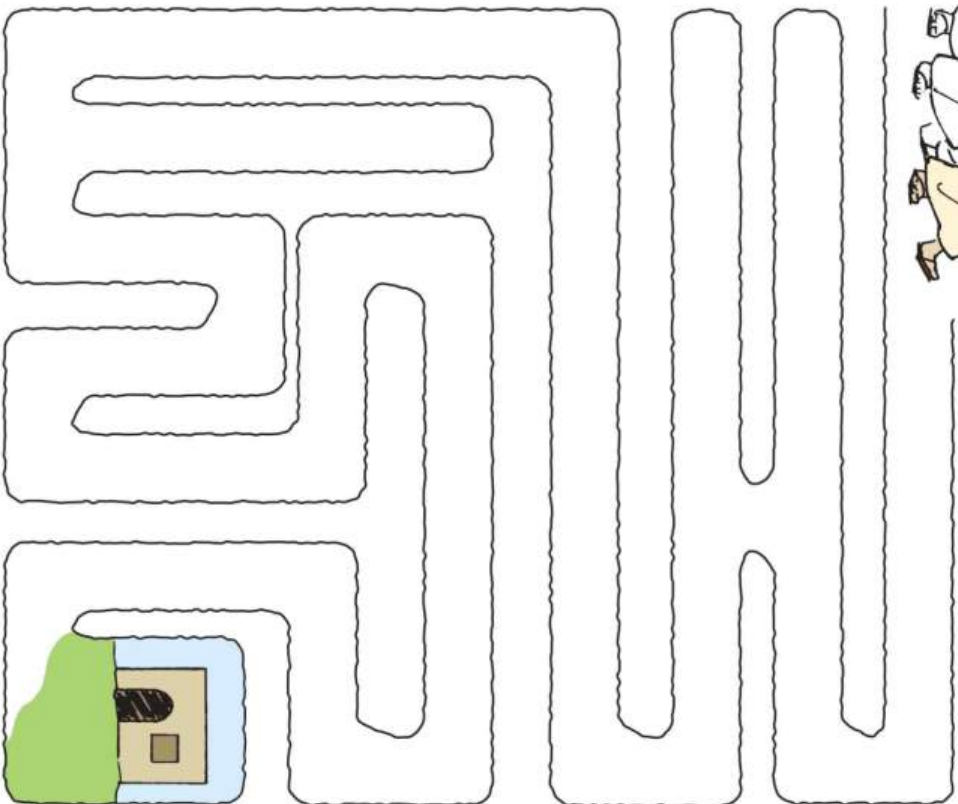
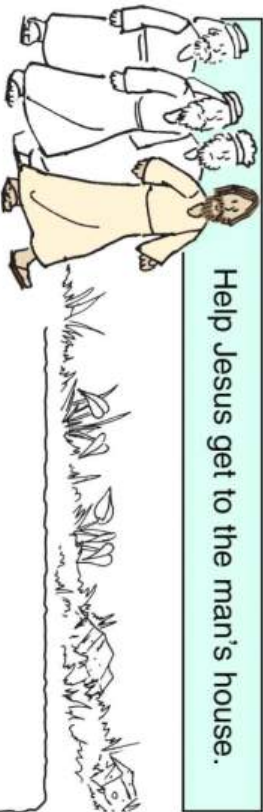
