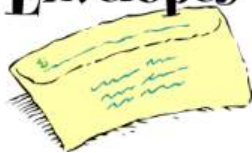

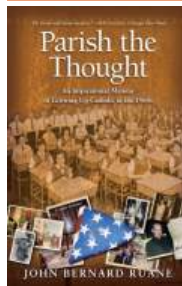

The very important step in this process involves **assessing our greatest strengths and opportunities**, and that is where the **Disciple Maker Index (DMI)** comes in! Come and See



Take nothing for the journey...

This life is a journey, not a destination. When the first disciples came to Jesus and asked

where

He was staying, He replied, "*Come and see.*" In responding to this calling of Jesus, they began a journey with Him.

Our Scriptures today center on the calling of the prophet Amos and the apostles so we may reflect on our own calling and journey with God. Each of us has a calling - a vocation - a way of life where we can be the best version of ourselves. We often use the term "vocation" when discussing a call to religious life but being married or living a single life are also vocations - sacred ways of living in relationship with God. Yet the journey cannot begin until we respond to God's call - and this takes trust.

Amos and the apostles had very different lives after responding to God's call. By allowing God to re-orient their lives, they *took nothing for the journey*. They depended on God for direction and support. They lived by faith. Faith is more than an intellectual belief in God. It is *faithfulness* to God and *entrusting* God with every aspect of our being - our heart, mind, soul and strength.

So how is the journey going? How can we better respond to God's call and rely on God for direction and support? *Taking nothing for the journey* produces a simplicity to our journey that enables the Spirit to animate our lives in ways we never could have imagined. You are being called...*Come and see!*

UV Safety Month

It is estimated that as many as 1 in 5 American will get skin cancer, it is the most common type of cancer in the United States. Ultraviolet (UV) exposure is the root cause of most skin cancers. Just five sunburns can double your risk of developing melanoma (the most serious form of skin cancer). Safe sun practices should be used all year long; however, sun exposure is most common in the summer. All skin tones are susceptible to damage from the UV rays of the sun.

Tips for Sun Safety:

- Seek shade when appropriate and possible - limit sun exposure especially during 10am and 2pm when the sun's rays are the strongest.
- Wear sun-protective clothing
- Apply a broad spectrum, water resistant sunscreen with an SPF of 30 or higher as directed (including reapplying at least every two hours and more often if you are swimming or sweating).

And find safety and hope in the midst of storms.

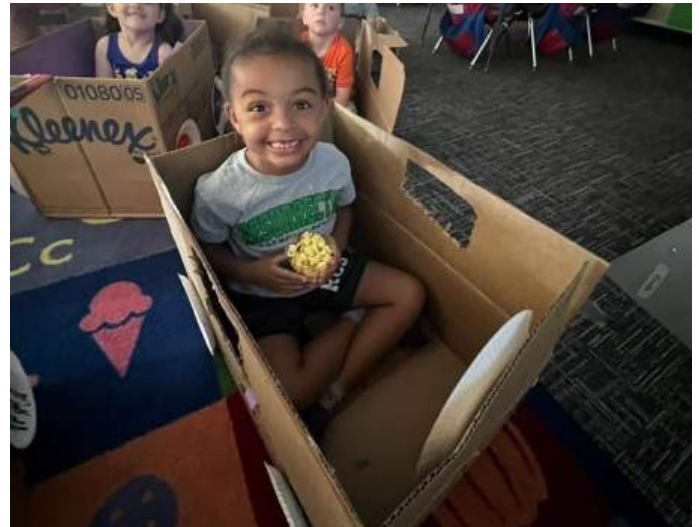
