Disciple Maker Index



The Disciple Maker Index Survey is Open this Week!

Christ Our Light is on a journey to know, love, and serve Christ in our parish community. Together we must embrace Christ's vision for missionary discipleship so our parish can thrive and be a place for others to grow together in faith.

The very important step in this process involves **assessing our greatest strengths and opportunities**, and that is where the **Disciple Maker Index (DMI)** comes in! The DMI is an important survey tool that invites you to reflect on your discipleship journey here at Christ Our Light. The Disciple Maker Index is designed to:

- Invite parishioners to reflect on their journey of discipleship.
- Enable parish leadership to make data-driven decisions.
- Help parishioners grow in their faith.

The 10–15-minute survey can be accessed through an online link from July 30th through September 3rd and will ask you to reflect on your own spiritual growth and enable you to provide your perspective on our parish's efforts to help you grow in relationship with Christ. All responses will be confidential, and the parish will only receive information about the community as a whole. Paper surveys will also be available for those who do not have the ability to complete the survey online.

Come and See



This week, the scriptures repeatedly show us that God gives to us abundantly, even when there is no clear path forward— or, at least a path that makes sense to the ration-

al human mind. In the Old Testament, the prophet Elisha confidently gives food donated by the man from Baal-shalishah, despite his servant's protests that it won't be enough. Similarly, the disciples wonder how five bread loaves and two fish are going to satisfy a crowd of five thousand people following Jesus. In both stories, the math doesn't add up, but it's because we and the people present for these miracles overlook the most important part of the equation: the power of our endlessly merciful and loving Creator who makes possible what humans cannot on their own. Our psalm today succinctly sums it up: "[God] answers all of our needs."

However, we are still responsible for contributing our part of the "equation" to generate abundant life for all. For example, the United Nations reports that enough food is produced today to feed everyone on Earth, yet so many remain hungry. So what might it look like for you to co-create with God to realize God's dream for our parish, the South Jersey community, our nation, and the world?

It helps to first spend quiet time in prayer and reflection to listen to where God may be calling you, knowing your unique gifts and talents. Then, the invitation requires a response! Christians are called to go out into the world and be Jesus' hands and feet as Christ's incarnate love. Remember that Elisha and Jesus didn't provide the food; they magnified the gifts brought to them by others. How are you being called to help others live more abundantly, especially those who need it most?

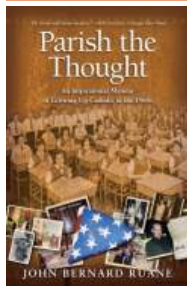
An active Catholic with a heart for Missionary Discipleship who is knowledgeable in Catholic Liturgy and Music is preferred. The candidate

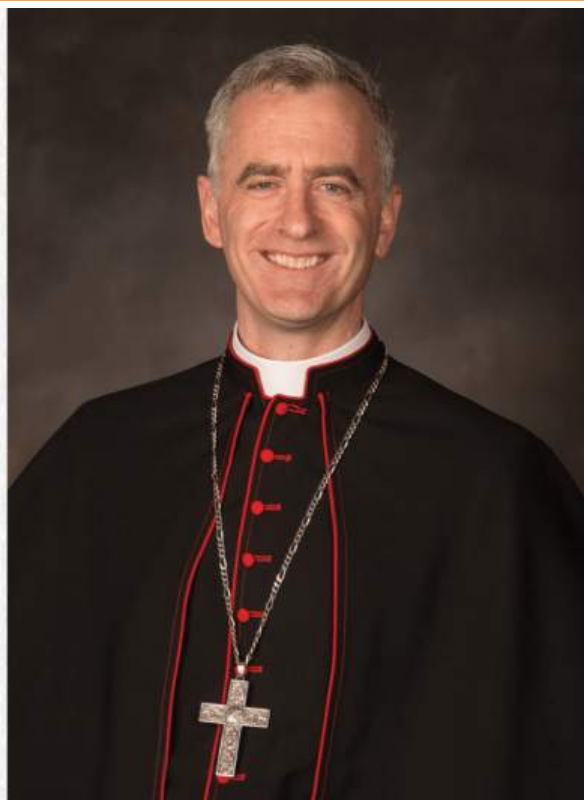

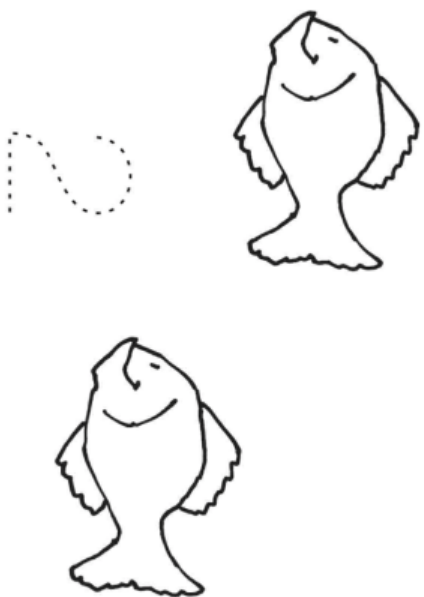

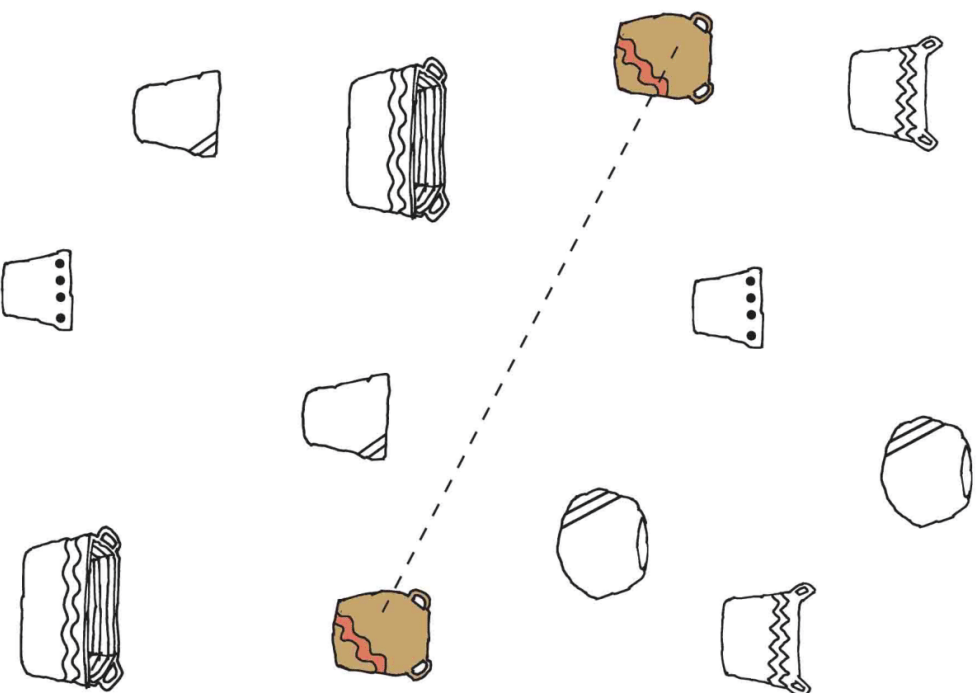
