Come and See



Jesus said to them, "I am the bread of life; whoever comes to me will never hunger..." John 6:24-35

I am the bread of life is the first of the seven "I am" statements that Jesus makes in John's Gospel.

However, this is not the first time the "I AM" statement appears in the Bible. In the Old Testament, God revealed himself to Moses with the statement "I AM" translated as Yahweh or Jehovah or Lord.

Jesus's "I am" statements clearly show His divine identity and mission. The statements demonstrate that God wants the best for us but we have to believe and to live by their tenets.

Each of these statements shows how Jesus fulfills the spiritual needs of his followers.

Jesus made the "I am the bread of life" statement shortly after He had fed the five thousand. With the incredible miracle of feeding these people with just a few loaves of bread and a fish, it is not surprising that Jesus compares himself to bread at this time.

In this Bible reading, the crowd is continuing to follow Jesus because they want free food. But Jesus wants the people to realize that physical food only satisfies hunger temporarily. Jesus wants the people to know that He is the One who can satisfy our spiritual hunger by providing bread that gives eternal life. While physical food only satisfies for a short time, Jesus's spiritual bread lasts forever. To believe in Jesus is to have eternal life.

Our faith will continue growing by studying, praying and living these statements. These "I am" statements are yet more examples of Jesus telling us to "Come and See".
