Bishop Lumen Monteiro, C.S.C.



Christ Our Light welcomes Bishop Lumen Monteiro, C.S.C. of Agartala, India who will be preaching at all Masses on Saturday, August 17th and Sunday, August 18th. Below is information on him and the mission he represents.

A New Diocese: Saint Pope John Paul II created the Diocese of Agartala, India on January 11, 1996, and appointed to 43 year old Holy Cross father Lumen Monteiro C.S.C. as the founding Bishop. On the Pentecost Sunday, May 26, 1996 he was ordained Bishop under the patronage of St. Francis Xavier with the motto *Duc in Altum*, Lead us Onward.

Mission territory: Catholics in other parts of India consider the Diocese of Agartala mission territory. It is the far northeast of India in tribal areas eager to welcome the Good News of the Catholic faith and especially favorable to Catholic education for their children.

Major challenges - lack of Personnel and Financial resources: Since there are very few diocesan clergy, the diocese relies heavily for personnel and resources on the commitment of religious communities of men and women and the generosity of the US and European mission appeals and in parishes like yours.

A New Context: Solidarity, outreach to the poor, dialogue, and sharing our fundamental values of our local church calling us to cross borders of ethnicity, language, class, culture, and religion as well as bridging the growing gap between rich and poor.

The pressing Need of the Hour: Four hours and 80 miles from Agartala city an impoverished village needs help to build a school. They already persuaded Bishop Lumen to purchase a piece of land and their primary school has opened and it makeshift tent because there is no money for a building. The money you donate will be used for this urgent and important.

1 Kings 19:7

National Eucharistic Congress



The National Eucharistic Congress that occurred in late July marked the end of phase two of the three-year Eucharistic Revival process. We now begin phase three...a **Year of Mission!**

Fr. Josh Johnson, one of the main emcees of the Congress, summarized this next phase beautifully: "Many of us are still soaking in the graces from our time at the 10th National Eucharistic Congress. Only in heaven will we know how many lives were transformed by the Holy Spirit at this Congress. **The Eucharistic Revival is not over.** Now we are being invited to "Walk With One" person in friendship & discipleship. I invite you to join me in asking our Lord who He is calling you to connect with this year in holy friendship. Perhaps you have a relative who no longer abides in the Sacramental life of the Church or you have a friend who has never been invited to participate in the Sacraments. Once you perceive the face of the one person in prayer, I encourage you to intercede for them before the Blessed Sacrament and offer up a fast for the person. In addition to praying and fasting for the one person who is in your mind and on your heart, I invite you to reach out to them as a friend. Perhaps you can begin by having coffee in the morning, going for a walk in the afternoon or drinking a glass of wine in the evening. Take time to get to know the person by listening to their story and sharing your testimony as well."

Maybe the fruit of your time together will result in the two of you going on a retreat together, serving the needy at a shelter, making a meal at the Ronald McDonald House, visiting your neighbors who are experiencing financial struggles, providing meals for Cathedral Kitchen, participating in a small group Bible study together at the parish, attending daily mass and praying the rosary together afterwards, learning more about the teachings of our Church, or sitting with each other in the silence of Adoration.

In this "Year of Mission," let's start praying for the Holy Spirit to help us identify our "one." 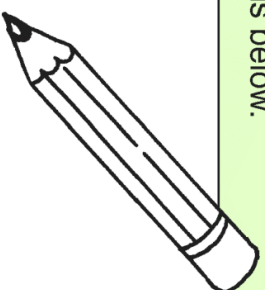
