Come and See



Whoever eats my flesh and drinks my blood remains in me and I in him.

Eucharist is not something.
Eucharist is Somebody. Eucha-

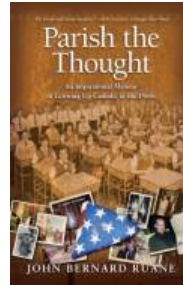
rist is the body, blood, soul, and divinity of Jesus. A person is body, blood and soul. Divinity means this person is God. Eucharist may appear to be bread and wine but it truly is the Real Presence of Jesus. Receiving Eucharist creates a mystical union - we abide in Jesus and Jesus abides in us. This *communion* is a very different interaction with God. We may sense God's Spirit in nature as we enjoy its beauty and grandeur. We can encounter the spiritual presence of Jesus through our interactions with others. Eucharist is so much more - our source and summit - because it is an intimate encounter with a *person* - the resurrected Jesus.

How can this be? Our gospel today discusses the reaction of the first century Jewish community to Jesus' teaching on Him being **real** food and drink. They do not understand...and Jesus is not using terms to allow them to think this is somehow spiritual or symbolic. They refrained from consuming the blood of animals because they believed it contained the life of the animal. Jesus wants us to consume His blood for that very reason - *so His life may be in us*. Ultimately, Jesus points them to the miracle of the manna. This food miraculously appeared and saved their ancestors from physical death. While the miracle itself is a mystery, its effect is not. How can bread and wine be transformed into the Resurrected Jesus? It is a miracle we cannot explain but the effect of the Eucharist on the lives of those who receive Jesus can be seen and known - for it has literally changed our world.

Being called to *Come and See* is an invitation to a deep and transformative relationship with Jesus. This is not just a spiritual encounter. We encounter the person - the real presence of Jesus...*Come and see!*

Donation Collection

During the Season of Creation
(September 1

through October 4, the Feast of St. Francis) the Care for Creation team will be collecting donations for the Animal Welfare Association (AWA). AWA is South Jersey's oldest and largest no kill animal shelter. We will have a collection box in the Gathering Space during September and October. The shelter can use both used and new items for their animals.

Many items you have in your home can be repurposed for the animals such as clean towels, wash cloths, flat sheets, light weight blankets (NO COMFORTERS). Other items that can be recycled include shower curtain rings, paper bags, socks, golf, whiffle and ping-pong balls, pill bottles (clean and labels removed), craft pom-pom balls, unused straws, and containers with shaker tops. AWA will also accept any cat/dog food (even if previously opened) in its original bag.

New items are also welcome. (Please check out their wish lists online for Amazon and Chewy.) Food items: tuna fish, salmon, dry dog/cat food, cans of dog/cat food, peanut butter, spray cheese, bacon bits. Other: Non-clumping clay cat litter. Dog toys: Kong, rope, plush, nylabones. Cat toys: crinkle pom-poms, catnip, scratching boards. Medical Supplies: pill pockets for dogs and cats; E-collars – soft/fabric, inflatable (NO PLASTIC CONES). In addition, AWA would appreciate any time you could provide as a volunteer. You can check out their website for details. However, the best way to help would be to consider adopting a dog or cat!
