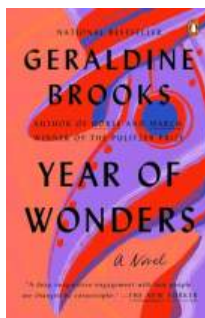
Saturday Bible Study

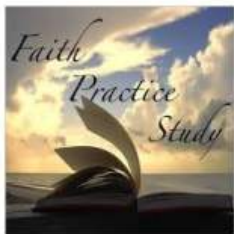

We are especially in need of more volunteers at Dwellside Care and Rehab Center in Cherry Hill, led by Jean Carbone. The volunteer commitment there is only once a month on Thursdays from 10:30-11:45 am (rosary at 10:30, 11 am Eucharistic service for 30-40 Catholic residents). Come and See



Jesus then said to the twelve, "Do you also want to leave?" Simon Peter answered him, "Master, to whom shall we go? You have the words of eternal life." John 6:60-69

The setting of this gospel is the aftermath of Jesus' feeding of the multitude and Jesus' invitation to eat his flesh and drink his blood. Jesus himself realizes that what he asks of his disciples is quite shocking. There is no adequate answer on an intellectual level to the question, "how can this man give us his flesh to eat?" The disciples have committed themselves to Jesus, but now faced with this disturbing proclamation many of his followers left him.

It is not easy to be a disciple of Jesus. We know that his teachings are counter cultural. Instead of focusing on our own needs, he wants us to serve others. This is precisely why Jesus offers himself - "body, blood and soul" - for us to eat, to give us the grace and strength to walk with him through the narrow gate. Despite his sacrifice on the cross to save us, Jesus leaves it up to us to make a choice: stay or leave.

When Peter is asked if he too will walk away from Jesus, he replied, "to whom shall we go?" If we believe that Jesus' words are in fact the way to eternal life, we must be steadfast in getting to know Jesus and to find ways to keep others close to him. I invite you to commit yourself to Jesus everyday, no matter how hard, and experience the joy and peace in living the good news of the gospel. All are welcome. Come and See!

Season of Creation



Donation Collection

During the Season of Creation (September 1 through October 4, the Feast of St. Francis) the Care for Creation team will be collecting donations for the Animal Welfare Association (AWA). AWA is South Jersey's oldest and largest no kill animal shelter. We will have a collection box in the Gathering Space during September and October. The shelter can use both used and new items for their animals.

Many items you have in your home can be repurposed for the animals such as clean towels, wash cloths, flat sheets, light weight blankets (NO COMFORTERS). Other items that can be recycled include shower curtain rings, paper bags, socks, golf, whiffle and ping-pong balls, pill bottles (clean and labels removed), craft pom-pom balls, unused straws, and containers with shaker tops. AWA will also accept any cat/dog food (even if previously opened) in its original bag.

New items are also welcome. (Please check out their wish lists online for Amazon and Chewy.) Food items: tuna fish, salmon, dry dog/cat food, cans of dog/cat food, peanut butter, spray cheese, bacon bits. Other: Non-clumping clay cat litter. Dog toys: Kong, rope, plush, nylabones. Cat toys: crinkle pom-poms, catnip, scratching boards. Medical Supplies: pill pockets for dogs and cats; E-collars – soft/fabric, inflatable (NO PLASTIC CONES). In addition, AWA would appreciate any time you could provide as a volunteer. You can check out their website for details. However, the best way to help would be to consider adopting a dog or cat!

Care for Creation



Our Care for Creation team has so many successful projects going on that it needs more volunteer help! Please contact Sandy and Dave Czerniakowski at 856-231-7879 if you can assist with these initiatives:

- Volunteers are needed weekly OR once a month to collect bagged plastic that parishioners donate for the Trex plastic recycling challenge. Donation pick-ups are usually done on Sunday afternoons and then again mid-week. There are multiple local drop-off locations that you can choose from, such as ACME, Whole Foods, Sprouts, and Occupational Training Center.
- For the month of September, we will be collecting items for the Voorhees Animal Welfare Association. We are looking for a volunteer to drive the donations from the church to the AMA once a week in September, but you can sign up for just one week. The AWA is open Mon-Fri from 12-5 pm.
