The Word

Reading for September 22, 2024

Mark 9: 30-37

Adults:

When has ego and self-interest kept you from being a follower of Jesus?

We offer this form of *Lectio Divina* (sacred reading) for pondering Scripture and for faith sharing with family members and other people.

- Listen/ Read (*Lectio*): Ponder God's word and listen for what touches your heart.
- Meditate (*Meditatio*): Attend to what you notice. Allow God's word to resonate in you.
- Speak/Share (*Oratio*): Prayerfully share with Jesus or with the group your thoughts and feelings.
- Rest in God's presence (*Contemplatio*): Notice God's presence and be still, surrounded by God's love.
- Choose to act (*Actio*): Trusting in God's nearness, commit to action rooted in love.

Come and See



"If anyone wishes to be first, he shall be the last of all and the servant of all" Mark 9:30-37

Jesus's teachings always seem to turn human thinking upside down. Humans tend to think in earthly ways while Jesus always thinks in Divine terms. In today's bible reading, shortly after Jesus tells the disciples about how his impending death will play out, the Twelve begin arguing who was the greatest among themselves.

Jesus must have been thinking "how do I get through to these guys"? I have been living and teaching them about the Kingdom of God and they still don't get it. So, Jesus uses two paradoxical examples to teach the Apostles what is important in growing closer to God.

Jesus starts the first example by stating the famous "If anyone wishes to be first..." sentence. Jesus is saying the disciples (and us) need to adopt a mindset of service to others. In other words, it is not all about you. Jesus is trying to teach everyone to be humble and showing them that greatness does not depend on power but in serving others.

The second example involves Jesus hugging a child. During ancient times, children were not seen as having much worth. If they had any value, it was in connection to the head of their household. The child is an example of the powerless, rejected, and humble people of the world,

What Jesus is revealing is that the Twelve (and us) must help to serve the powerless, destitute, and underserved people to meet their basic needs. By placing their needs before our own, we truly are doing His work. Additionally, we will develop a deeper relationship with God. This is how we become great in God's eyes.

Jesus is saying Come and See what happens when we serve the less fortunate and grow in our personal discipleship.

Children's Liturgy of the Word

CHILDREN'S LITURGY OF THE WORD

Children's Liturgy of the Word (CLOW) will resume on September 22nd at the 8:30 a.m. and 10:30 a.m. Masses.

The purpose of this special Liturgy is twofold:

- To provide a quality liturgical experience
- To facilitate the proclamation and breaking open of Scripture with the children

What is Children's Liturgy of the Word?

- CLOW is a part of the Mass
- The Church encourages a separate liturgy to allow the children to participate and understand
- Appropriate for children between the ages of 5 and 12
- All are welcome – No registration is necessary
- We meet in the church and the children remain with the assembly and their parents for the opening of Mass
- The children are dismissed by the celebrant after the Opening Prayer.
-

Gather the Children

- The children form two groups: second grade and younger; third grade and older
- They are led to rooms in the Ministry Center of the church
- A candle is lit to remind the children of the presence of the Lord; they are reminded that they are still at Mass.
- A Reading, Responsorial Psalm, and Gospel are read.
- An interactive sharing follows: the children discuss what they heard; what the readings mean to them; practical ways they can incorporate what they heard into their everyday lives.
- The children return to the assembly after the Offertory Procession



VOLUNTEERS ARE NEEDED

- Adults and teens are needed to proclaim and share the Word of God
- Requirements: enthusiasm and the willingness to share your faith with the children of Christ Our Light Parish
- Scheduling is approximately once a month
- All materials are provided and emailed and mailed home the week before you are scheduled
- Facilitators do not have to come up with ideas – just present them and, most of all, let the

children LEAD you.

- Feel free to come back with the children during a CLOW session to observe
- Facilitators have commented that they learn so much from the children
- As one child said, "CLOW helps me understand; I don't understand all those big words."

Recovery programs all over the country raise awareness about addiction treatment and share the positive stories of transformed lives. 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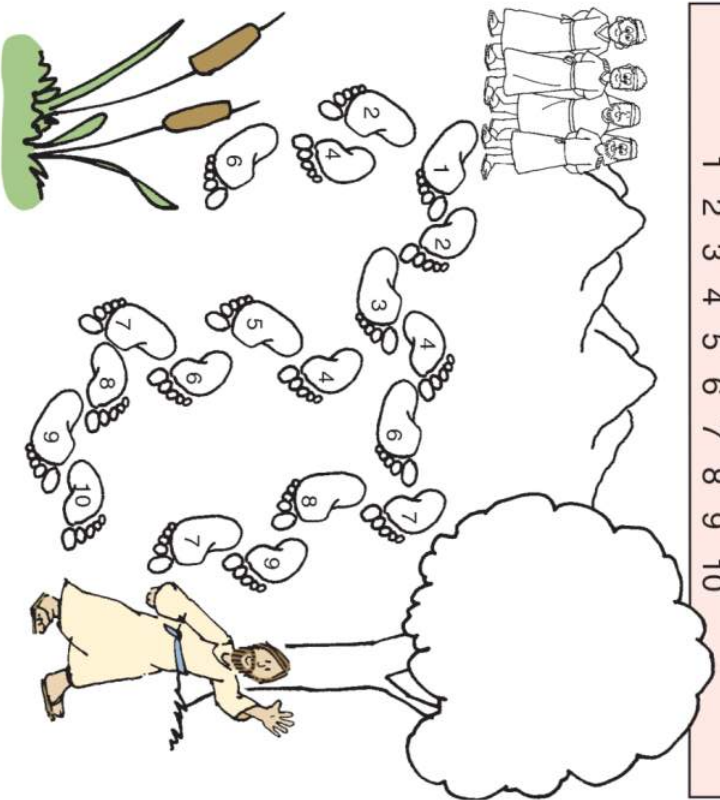

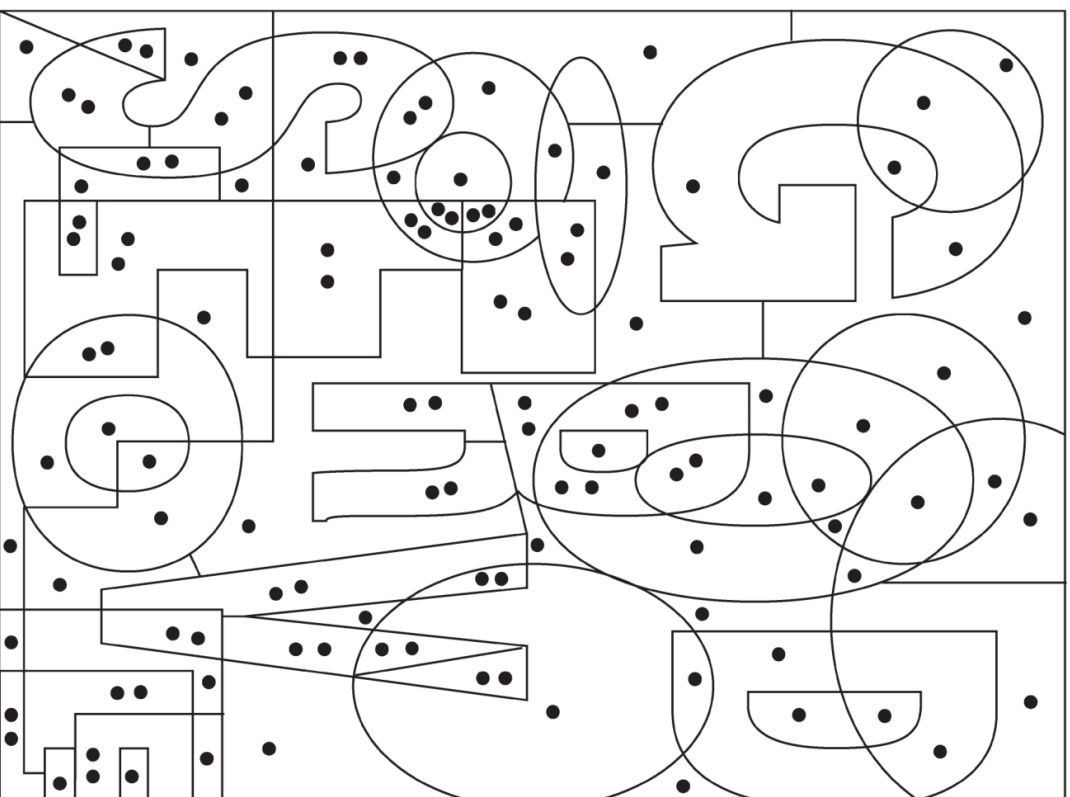

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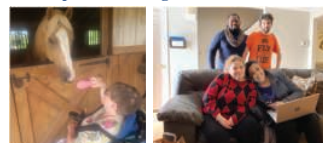
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
