The Word

Reading for December 1, 2024

Luke 21:25-28, 34-36

Adults:

What habit of prayer could you strengthen during this Advent season to help you stay focused so that you will be prepared to receive the salvation we celebrate at Jesus' birth and anticipate at Jesus' second coming.

We offer this form of *Lectio Divina* (sacred reading) for pondering Scripture and for faith sharing with family members and other people.

- Listen/ Read (*Lectio*): Ponder God's word and listen for what touches your heart.
- Meditate (*Meditatio*): Attend to what you notice. Allow God's word to resonate in you.
- Speak/Share (*Oratio*): Prayerfully share with Jesus or with the group your thoughts and feelings.
- Rest in God's presence (*Contemplatio*): Notice God's presence and be still, surrounded by God's love.
- Choose to act (*Actio*): Trusting in God's nearness, commit to action rooted in love.

Youth:

How do you turn destructive habits into constructive habits as you prepare for the coming of Jesus at Christmas?

Children:

What are some good choices you can make this Advent as you prepare to celebrate Jesus' birth at Christmas?

Come and See



"There will be signs in the sun, the moon, and the stars, and on earth nations will be in dismay, perplexed by the roaring of the sea and the waves... But when these signs begin to happen, stand erect and raise your heads because your redemption is at hand." Luke 21:25, 28

In this Sunday's Gospel, Jesus speaks to his disciples of astonishing signs that will occur at the end of the world when the Son of Man comes again in glory. I can just imagine his followers giving each other sidelong glances, scratching their heads, and wondering what on earth their teacher is talking about. We might feel the same way if we stop to ask ourselves on this First Sunday of Advent, leading up to Christmas, "What does this have to do with the baby Jesus?"

The word "Advent" comes from the Latin "*adventus*," which means "coming." During the season of Advent, we celebrate *three* "comings" of Jesus. Most obviously, the season of Advent is a time of preparation for us to commemorate the birth of Jesus at Christmas two thousand years ago. In this Sunday's Gospel, Jesus exhorts us to prepare ourselves for his Second Coming at the end of time: "Beware that your hearts do not become drowsy... Be vigilant at all times" (Luke 21: 34, 36). Finally, this season of Advent calls us to prepare our hearts to better receive Jesus *today* in all the ways that he makes himself known to us—in the Eucharist, in the silence, in our joy and our pain, in our neighbor.

Today's psalm gives us words to articulate our desire to know Jesus: "Your ways, O LORD, make known to me; teach me your paths, guide me in your truth and teach me..." (Psalm 25:4-5a). As we prepare our hearts for the coming of Jesus—past, present, and future—"may the Lord make [us] increase and abound in love for one another and for all" (Thessalonians 3:12).

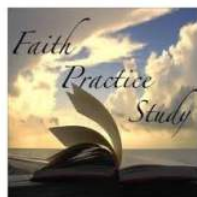
December 5, 2024 – Christmas Show at American Music Theater - SOLD OUT!

Charitable Giving

Year-End Charitable Giving via a Qualified Charitable Distribution (QCD)

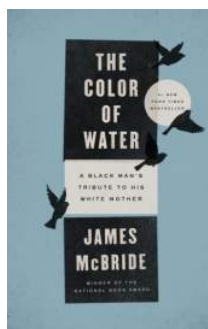


If you are looking to lower your taxable income, you may want to consider a QCD. If you are age 70½ or older, IRS rules require you to take required minimum distributions (RMDs) each year from your tax-deferred retirement accounts. This additional taxable income may push you into a higher tax bracket and may also reduce your eligibility for certain tax credits and deductions. To eliminate or reduce the impact of RMD income, charitably inclined investors may want to consider making a qualified charitable distribution (QCD).

A QCD is a direct transfer of funds from an IRA custodian, payable to a qualified charity, as described in the QCD provision in the Internal Revenue Code. Amounts distributed as a QCD can be counted toward satisfying your RMD for the year, up to \$100,000, and can also be excluded from your taxable income. This is not the case with a regular withdrawal from an IRA, even if you use the money to make a charitable contribution later on. In this scenario, the funds would be counted as taxable income even if you later offset that income with the charitable contribution deduction.

Please consult a tax advisor to learn more. If you are 70½ or older, own an IRA, and donate to charity, QCDs may make sense for you; consult a tax advisor regarding your specific situation.

Christmas Programs for Families in Need



We are already preparing several programs to assist families in need this Advent and Christmas season:

- The parish Elementary Faith Formation program coordinates a toy drive benefiting **Sacred Heart Church in Camden's Annual Christmas Toy Store**. This program invites qualified families to shop for Christmas presents at greatly reduced prices for children 12 years and under. Our drive will run from **November 25-December 6**. All toy donations must be new and unwrapped. Children can bring the donations with them to EFF class or parishioners can drop them off in the Parish Center vestibule.
- Suggested gift donations over \$15 include: sports equipment (footballs, basketballs, Nerf balls/no blasters), dolls (African American and Hispanic), doll accessories (houses, strollers, etc.), Lego sets, games (Connect 4, Operation, Trouble, Memory, Scrabble Jr, etc.), Playskool and Fisher Price toys, and Minecraft.
- Please do NOT donate the following items: stuffed animals, puzzles, coloring books, crayons, Play-Doh, clay, any sports items for soccer, hockey, and tennis, and games such as CandyLand, Chutes & Ladders, and Yahtzee.
- **The Giving Tree** provides gifts to families served by Guadalupe Family Services in Camden. The tree will stand in the Gathering Space Alcove during Advent beginning the evening of Saturday, November 30. If you would like to participate, please take a tag, purchase the requested item, and return the gift to the tree **by Monday, December 16**. Gifts should be returned unwrapped with the tag attached to it, though a gift bag or wrapping paper with tape is much appreciated.



- The **"Adopt-a-Family"** Christmas gift program invites parishioners to sponsor a local family in need. Last year we were able to help close to 60 families with physical gifts and gift cards. There are several ways to be a part of the Adopt-a-Family program: you may choose to buy physical gifts for a specific family, donate gift cards for a specific family so the parents can shop for their children, or you can donate gift cards/checks to a general program fund for parish staff to disburse among our program recipients.
