Greetings to everyone at Christ Our Light parish! I would like to take a moment to introduce myself. My name is Fr. Titus Joseph Karimattathil, O. Carm. I was born on May 28, 1968, and grew up alongside eight siblings. Sadly, my father and mother passed away in 1996 and 2016 respectively. My native language is

Malayalam, which is commonly spoken in Kerala, a state in South India.

I belong to the Carmelite Order, formally known as the "Order of the Brothers of the Blessed Virgin Mary of Mount Carmel", often abbreviated as "O. Carm." I began my journey in the Carmelite order by joining the Carmelite Minor Seminary in 1986 after completing my matriculation. I completed my Novitiate in 1988 and officially became a Carmelite with my First Profession on May 9, 1988. Following my Philosophy and Theology studies at Dharmaram Vidya Kshetram in Bangalore, India, I was ordained as a Deacon in June 1994 and later became a Priest on January 3, 1995. After a year of serving as the assistant Parish Priest at a parish in Kerala, I continued my academic journey.

From 1996 to 1998, I successfully pursued a Licentiate in Biblical Theology at the Milltown Institute of Theology and Philosophy in Ireland. I then attended the Pontifical Biblical Institute in Rome from 1998 to 2002, where I earned a Licentiate in Biblical Exegesis. During that time, I was fortunate to study for a semester at the Hebrew University of Jerusalem. Following this, I spent another two years conducting research at the Pontifical Biblical Institute in preparation for my Doctorate. I completed my doctoral research at the Pontifical Gregorian University in Rome, where I defended my thesis on a section of the Book of the Prophet Jeremiah in February 2011. Prior to completing my Doctorate, I moved to the Archdiocese of Cologne, Germany, in April 2009 to engage in pastoral ministry. I feel truly blessed and enriched by my experiences as an assistant parish priest in two different communities of parishes (several parishes put together to form larger communities, each maintaining its identity).

After spending several years abroad, I returned to my Carmelite Province in India in August 2017 to assume the role of Rector at Our Minor Seminary. Towards the end of my tenure, during our Provincial Chapter in 2020, I was honoured to be elected Prior Provincial of the St. Thomas Province of the Carmelite Order in India. After three fulfilling years in that role, I transitioned to a small community within our Province that also oversees a retreat centre. I originally planned to stay there only for a short time, as I was in discussions with the Camden Diocese about assuming a role to serve there. During my stay in this community, I contributed by assisting with retreat talks and various activities necessary for the retreat.

I feel blessed to serve the Lord and His people in any way I can, and I'm thrilled to be part of this community alongside Fr. John Picinic and the entire pastoral team. I pray that the Lord bless us all abundantly. I understand that I may have limited pastoral experience in the USA, and I appreciate your patience with my shortcomings. I look forward to meeting each of you in person soon. May God bless us all.

Immaculate Conception Mass Schedule

The Solemnity of the Immaculate Conception of the Blessed Virgin Mary (National and Diocesan

Patronal Feast) is celebrated on Monday. The Solemnity is transferred from December 8 (which celebrates the Second Sunday of Advent) and supersedes the Optional Memorial of Saint Juan Diego Cuauhtlatoatzin. Even when transferred, this solemnity remains obligatory. Please note that there is NO 8AM Mass on Monday, December 9.
