Reading for February 16, 2025

Luke 6: 17, 20-26

Adults:

We offer this form of *Lectio Divina* (sacred reading) for pondering Scripture and for faith sharing with family members and other people.

- Listen/ Read (*Lectio*): Ponder God’s word and listen for what touches your heart.
- Meditate (*Meditatio*): Attend to what you notice. Allow God’s word to resonate in you.
- Speak/Share (*Oratio*): Prayerfully share with Jesus or with the group your thoughts and feelings.
- Rest in God’s presence (*Contemplatio*): Notice God’s presence and be still, surrounded by God’s love.
- Choose to act (*Actio*): Trusting in God’s nearness, commit to action rooted in love.

What are a few ways you can put the Beatitudes into practice in a concrete way?

Chair Yoga

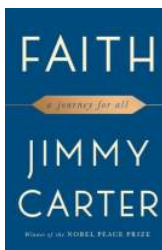


This practice links the movement of the breath with gentler yoga postures. De-stress while you stretch, strengthen, and breathe from the comfort of your chair.

Cardiovascular disease is a leading cause of death around the globe with heart attacks and strokes being the most common). While this statistic is alarming, most cardiovascular diseases can be prevented by addressing risk factors proactively or managed by lifestyle modification and medical treatment to limit the progression of the disease.

Common risk factors for cardiovascular disease include:

- Tobacco use
- Unhealthy diet and obesity
- Physical Activity
- Family History

What Do You Need to Know?

- Signs and Symptoms of a Heart Attack: Chest Pain, Shortness of Breath, Pale and Sweaty Skin, Fatigue, Pain that radiates to the Back, Arm, or Jaw, Loss of Consciousness
- Signs and Symptoms of a Stroke: BE FAST: Balance Loss, Eyesight Changes, Facial drooping, Arm (or other limb) weakness, Speech difficulties = Time to call 911). Other symptoms – numbness, difficulty walking, confusion, severe headache.
- When in Doubt: Call 911!
- Simple Steps to Modify Risk Factors: See your doctor regularly and take medications as directed, eat a healthy and balanced diet, be physically active (as you are able).

The Fair Trade Committee voted to donate some of the funds to Beyond Borders, a humanitarian aid nonprofit organization in Haiti, to support two families in need. Dear friends at Christ Our Light --

I am so grateful to the people of Christ Our Light for so generously sponsoring two families in Haiti. It means more than I can say -- especially in these extremely uncertain times. I'm pleased to introduce you to the Sufois and Tilus families.

Ketline Sufois (above left) and Makilia Tilus (above right) both live in the village of Titans with their families. Your sponsorship will ensure that they escape extreme poverty for good.

Work with all 160 families in this sixth cohort launched in November 2023. Even in ordinary times, families like these that are living in extreme poverty face hunger, illness, and homelessness. In times of crisis like this however, these families are even more at risk, making Christ Our Light's generous sponsorship even more life-changing for them.

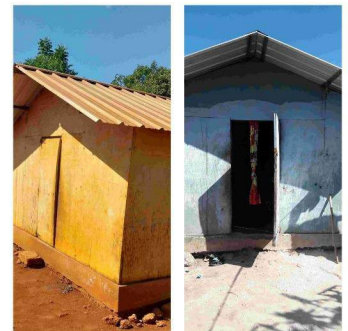
Here are a few details about Ketline Sufois and her family and Makilia Tilus and her family:

- Ketline, 18, and her husband Dadmy, 21, and their two-year-old daughter were homeless and living in a dilapidated house with five others.
- Ketline's husband sometimes works as a moto taxi driver or a day laborer to earn money but it's not enough to meet even the family's most basic needs.
- The family often goes an entire day without eating, according to their caseworker.
- Makilia, 55, and her husband Omilet, also 55, and their two children and one grandchild were homeless and living with others.
- The family has no source of income and they often go hungry.

Christ Our Light's sponsorship will give these families a path to a much brighter future, one that is filled with dignity, hope, opportunity, and self-reliance. Your generosity will allow them to begin earning the money needed so that they can care for their children. Your generosity will equip them with the skills they need so that they can provide for their families long after your sponsorship ends.

The house where Ketline and her family were living (left) and the house where Makilia and her family were living (right). Your sponsorship will ensure that both families will be able to build her own home so that they can live in dignity.

Caseworkers meet families on both an individual and group basis, providing training on everything from hygiene and sanitation, how to save and plan for the future, and how to work collectively as a community to protect and defend the rights of all children, so that no child is sent away and risks becoming enslaved. We will provide regular updates on the progress that the Sufois and Tilus families make as they move through the Family Graduation Program.



Having met many parents like Ketline and Makilia over the years and witnessed the transformation of their families, I really can't find words to adequately express the tremendous and lasting difference that the people of Christ Our Light will make in their lives. Please share our gratitude with everyone there!
