Come and See



For the measure with which you measure will in return be measured out to you.

Wow! These words of Jesus are both amazing and challenging.

Imagine living a life filled with unconditional love, mercy and forgiveness...that would be truly amazing! This is made possible when we become agents of God's unconditional love, mercy and forgiveness to others. There's the challenge. We tend to love...within limits, forgive...with conditions, and lend...with the expectation of a return. We tend to judge and condemn our enemies, offering them little to no mercy...and we feel *very* justified. But placing limits and burdens on others inadvertently limits our own ability to experience the fullness of God's love. To be filled with God's presence necessitates us emptying ourselves. Having limits and conditions on our love, mercy, and forgiveness are signs that values and priorities of this world are taking up space in our lives - leaving less room for God to fill.

So how do we free up space and empty ourselves? *Agape*. Unconditional love. *Agape* is an act of the will and not rooted in emotion. Emotions are fleeting - they surge strongly one day and disappear the next. *Agape* is different. It is *choosing* to be concerned for the welfare of another even when our emotions are lacking. This is an act of the will. It enables us to care for another even when we are mad at someone, dislike someone, are indifferent about someone, or do not know someone...but when that someone is in need, we *decide* to care. *Agape* is how we can respond to Jesus' call for us to do good, to bless and to pray for those who mistreat us. Why would we do this? Because this is what *unconditional* means - there are no boundaries or limits. How serious is Jesus about this? He showed us on Good Friday. He did not return the hate, violence and suffering that He endured. Even on the cross, He offered forgiveness and mercy. He died so we could live. He chose to be concerned for our welfare despite the cost. His death and resurrection manifest the transformative power of unconditional love.

Once we embrace the challenge of living and loving beyond what we perceive to be our limits, the bounty of God's love and grace rushes in and fills us to the point of overflowing. Interested? *Come and See!* Jesus offers a roadmap... *Stop judging and you will not be judged. Stop condemning and you will not be condemned. Forgive and you will be forgiven. Give and gifts will be given to you; a good measure, packed together, shaken down, and overflowing, will be poured into your lap. For the measure with which you measure will in return be measured out to you.*

- Listen/ Read (*Lectio*): Ponder God's word and listen for what touches your heart.
- Meditate (*Meditatio*): Attend to what you notice. Allow God's word to resonate in you.
- Speak/Share (*Oratio*): Prayerfully share with Jesus or with the group your thoughts and feelings.
- Rest in God's presence (*Contemplatio*): Notice God's presence and be still, surrounded by God's love.
- Choose to act (*Actio*): Trusting in God's nearness, commit to action rooted in love.

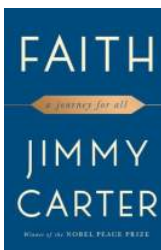
Chair Yoga

Cardiovascular disease is a leading cause of death around the globe with heart attacks and strokes being the most common). While this statistic is alarming, most cardiovascular diseases can be prevented by addressing risk factors proactively or managed by lifestyle modification and medical treatment to limit the progression of the disease.

Common risk factors for cardiovascular disease include:

- Tobacco use
- Unhealthy diet and obesity
- Physical Activity
- Family History

What Do You Need to Know?

- Signs and Symptoms of a Heart Attack: Chest Pain, Shortness of Breath, Pale and Sweaty Skin, Fatigue, Pain that radiates to the Back, Arm, or Jaw, Loss of Consciousness
- Signs and Symptoms of a Stroke: BE FAST: Balance Loss, Eyesight Changes, Facial drooping, Arm (or other limb) weakness, Speech difficulties = Time to call 911). Other symptoms – numbness, difficulty walking, confusion, severe headache.
- When in Doubt: Call 911!
- Simple Steps to Modify Risk Factors: See your doctor regularly and take medications as directed, eat a healthy and balanced diet, be physically active (as you are able).

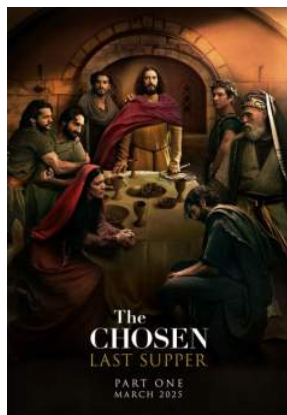

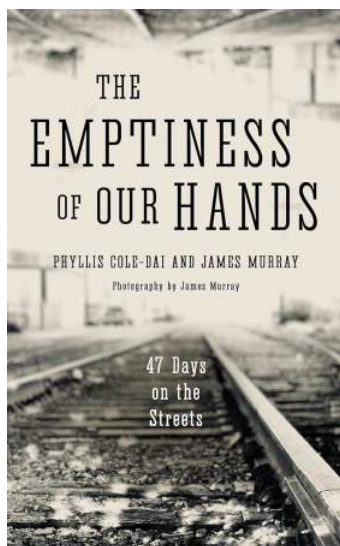

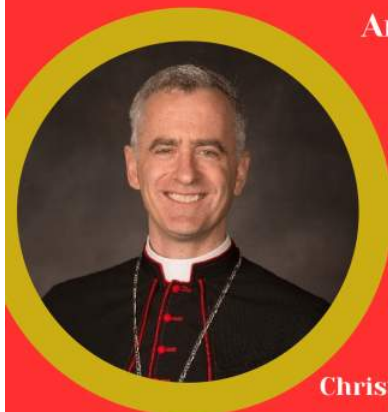

Virtual Guided Tour of the Former Death Camp in Sobibór



The Nazi death camp Sobibór functioned as part of Operation Reinhardt, the plan responsible for the murder of nearly 2 million Jews in German-occupied Poland. From May 1942 until the uprising on October 14, 1943, more than 180,000 Jews were murdered in Sobibór. The mission of the Sobibór Museum and Memorial is to cultivate the memory of those murdered in the Sobibor death camp.

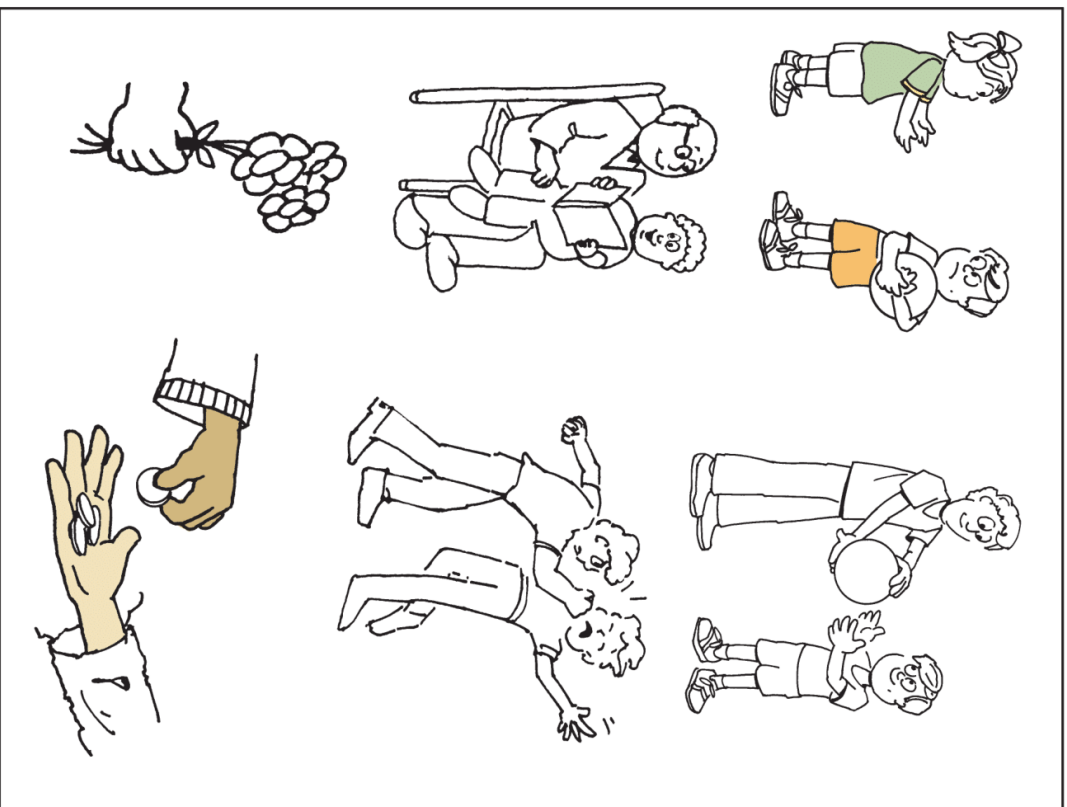

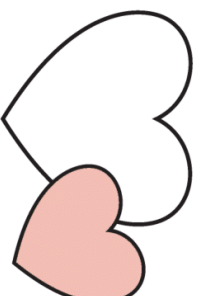
