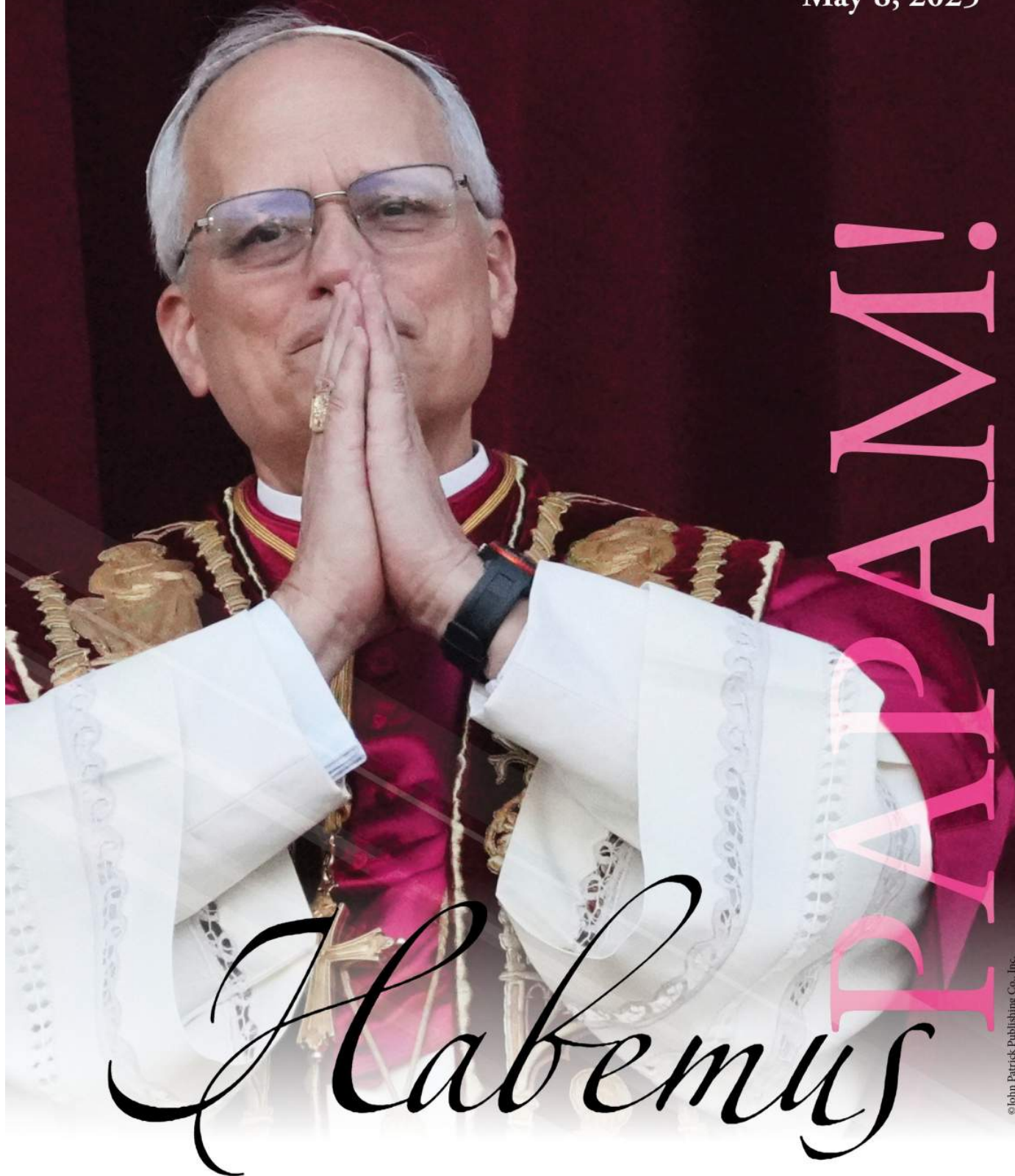

John 13:31-33A, 34-35

Adults:

Who is your role model for being a person who follows this command of Jesus?

We offer this form of *Lectio Divina* (sacred reading) for pondering Scripture and for faith sharing with family members and other people.

- Listen/ Read (*Lectio*): Ponder God's word and listen for what touches your heart.
- Meditate (*Meditatio*): Attend to what you notice. Allow God's word to resonate in you.
- Speak/Share (*Oratio*): Prayerfully share with Jesus or with the group your thoughts and feelings.
- Rest in God's presence (*Contemplatio*): Notice God's presence and be still, surrounded by God's love.
- Choose to act (*Actio*): Trusting in God's nearness, commit to action rooted in love.

Come and See



I give you a new commandment: love one another. John 13:31-35

You may be wondering what is so new about this

commandment? The commandment of love is often in the Old Testament with stating that the greatest commandment is to love God. Loving your neighbor is the next commandment.

What is new about this commandment, though, is that we are called to love in the way that Jesus loved.

Think about the situation when Jesus proclaimed this new commandment. Jesus and the disciples were at the Last Supper. This was the night He was betrayed. Earlier in the evening, Jesus had washed the feet of the disciples in a display of humbleness, servitude and love. This included washing the feet of Thomas (the doubter), Peter (the denier) and Judas (the betrayer). Even though these disciples sinned against Jesus in various ways, He still showed his love for them.

It is the same with us. When we doubt, deny and betray in Jesus in our sinful words and actions, He still loves us unconditionally.

Jesus is commanding us to do the same for others. Loving others is not always easy and we need to continually work at it. Loving people who are like us is probably easier than loving those who are different or who have hurt us. This does not mean we have to accept or agree with what they are doing. But we need to follow Jesus' example and love them unconditionally.

Let's follow Jesus's commandment through our own thoughts and actions by inviting others to "Come and See" what His love for us truly means.

We're so proud of their big hearts and helping hands!



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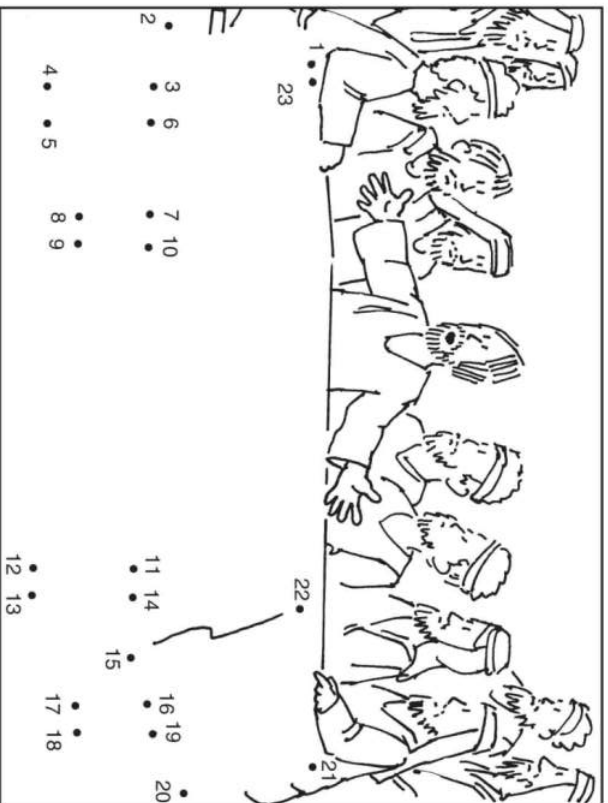

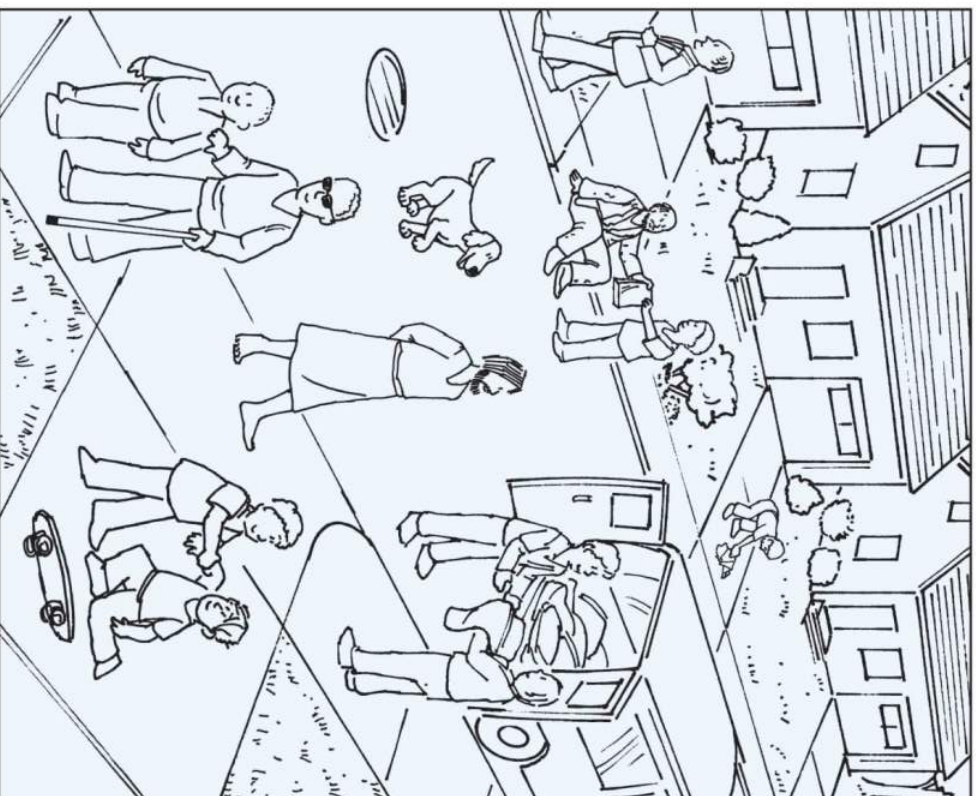
