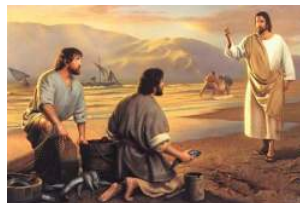

Come and See



The Most Holy Trinity—Father, Son, and Holy Spirit—is the central mystery of the Christian faith, revealing the unity and communion of God's love. God the Father, the source of all life and love, created us out of love and continually calls us into a deeper relationship with Him. His love is not only creative but redemptive, seen most fully in the gift of His Son, Jesus Christ. In the spirit of the Eucharistic Revival's current Year of Mission, we are invited to recognize how the Father's love sends us forth—to walk with one another, just as He first walked with humanity in love and fidelity. This mission flows directly from the heart of the Trinity, where love is always outward-reaching, always seeking communion.

Jesus, the Son of God, is the perfect example of how to live in unity with the Father and for others. Through His life, death, and resurrection, He models self-giving love, humility, and service. In the Eucharist, we receive His real presence—Body, Blood, Soul, and Divinity—so that we may be strengthened to imitate Him in our daily lives. As we soon conclude this year of mission, Jesus shows us how to "walk with one" -- to accompany the lonely, uplift the suffering, and love without condition. Mary, His mother, lived this path most closely. She walked with Jesus from Bethlehem to Calvary and beyond, always in total fidelity to the will of the Father and in deep communion with the Spirit, becoming the first and most faithful disciple.

The Holy Spirit empowers us to live this mission, filling us with grace, courage, and the gifts necessary to be witnesses of God's love in the world. At Pentecost, the Spirit ignited the Church, just as today the Spirit ignites our hearts to invite others to walk with us, to come and see! We are not sent alone—the Spirit is our constant companion, guiding us as we bring Christ to others. Mary, overshadowed by the Spirit at the Annunciation and present at Pentecost, shows us how to be fully receptive to the Spirit's work in us. In her closeness to the Trinity, she embodies what it means to be a missionary disciple: rooted in the Father's love, formed by the Son's example, and empowered by the Spirit's presence. Through her intercession, and by the grace of the Triune God, we are called and sent to walk with one another, in love and unity, for the life of the world.

We offer this form of *Lectio Divina* (sacred reading) for pondering Scripture and for faith sharing with family members and other people.

- Listen/ Read (*Lectio*): Ponder God's word and listen for what touches your heart.
- Meditate (*Meditatio*): Attend to what you notice. Allow God's word to resonate in you.
- Speak/Share (*Oratio*): Prayerfully share with Jesus or with the group your thoughts and feelings.
- Rest in God's presence (*Contemplatio*): Notice God's presence and be still, surrounded by God's love.
- Choose to act (*Actio*): Trusting in God's nearness, commit to action rooted in love.

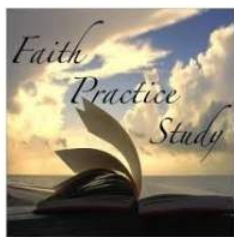

Elementary Faith Formation



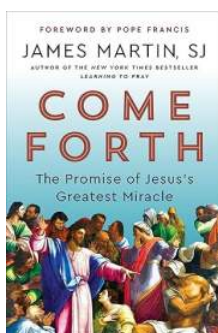

IMPORTANT: Christ Our Light, in compliance with the Diocese of Camden's sacrament guidelines, requires that students have a full year of religion classes prior to preparing for the sacraments of 1st Reconciliation and 1st Eucharist. Students wishing to prepare for the sacrament of Confirmation must attend religion classes consistently from 1st through 8th grade.

One Book Immersion Experience

Immersion Experience at Joseph's House One Book 2025

At the outset of Lent, the awe-inspiring author, Phyllis Cole-Dai, shared the impetus for her 47 days on the streets with the homeless in Columbus, OH: *"I was trying to get at something utterly heart breaking..."* Phyllis shared more stories and how the experience changed her during a second evening with us.

Once our reading concluded, to deepen our awareness of ministries and shelter for the homeless in our community, we heard from Cathedral Kitchen staff, as well as CoL volunteers who serve at Joseph's House in Camden each month.

Our last phase will be local immersion experiences; we will visit **Joseph's House** to help serve dinner and encounter the guests. The dates are **Monday, June 9 and Monday, July 14**. We will meet at 4:45 PM in the CoL parking lot and carpool to Camden. We return to CoL at approximately 7:30 PM.

Congratulations to Joseph's House

Joseph's House of Camden has transitioned from an overnight shelter to a 24/7 operation. In achieving this long-held dream, Joseph's House can now provide continuous, reliable support to those experiencing homelessness, offering not only a place to sleep but also ongoing access to shelter, services and hope, around the clock.

Such a major undertaking involved hiring new staff, moving to three shifts a day, and introducing new meal schedules, all of which helped to facilitate a seamless transition. Today, Josephs House can accommodate 75 guests overnight and more than 100 guests for its day program. In March 2025, 97% of the rostered guests used the HUB services, with the shelter referring nearly 150 guests to targeted providers for mental health and addiction counseling, health care, social services, housing, employment and more.

To help sustain this expanded level of care, Joseph's House is launching a call to action, "Give Today, Change a Life Tomorrow." Please consider donating to support this 24/7 effort. Donations can be made online at jhoc.org or mailed to: Joseph's House of Camden, PO Box 555, Camden, NJ 08104.
