- Speak/Share (*Oratio*): Prayerfully share with Jesus or with the group your thoughts and feelings.
- Rest in God's presence (*Contemplatio*): Notice God's presence and be still, surrounded by God's love.
- Choose to act (*Actio*): Trusting in God's nearness, commit to action rooted in love.

Come and See



When we think of some of the characteristics of God, such as *omnipotence*: referring to God's unlimited power, or *omniscience*: that He

possesses complete and perfect or His *omnipresence*: that He is not limited by space or time and is present everywhere simultaneously or that God is *eternal*: He is Alpha and Omega. He has no beginning or end and that He is so other but yet so close to us is hard to fathom.

Yet, in Genesis God speaks with His "friend" Abraham before the destruction of Sodom and Gomorrah and there is this back and forth conversation if 50, 40, 30, 20, and finally if 10 righteous people were to be found that God would spare the cities.

As apostles and disciples of Jesus we too have this access to the Father, one in which we come face to face with our Lord, even though He is so other than us.

The Lord calls us to prayer, be it privately or publically, at the source and summit of our faith – in the Eucharist. In these moments and others just like Abraham our father in faith we have conversations with God. And we should not be afraid to ask for that which is good. Abraham asked for a good, i.e. to save the people if he could at least find ten righteous folks.

Jesus invitation is, "come and see," to sit with Him and to have conversation. Fellowship! God called Abraham His friend, Jesus called His Apostles, "my friends," and so to us, we are the Lord's friends, may we also look to build that family up and share our joy with all whom we meet.

A Parish-wide call to prayer to the Holy Spirit
Discernment, Reflection, and Action Towards a Pastoral Council
Wednesday July 30th at 7:00 PM in the St. Mary's Room (Parish Center)

They devoted themselves to the teaching of the apostles and to the communal life, to the breaking of the bread and to the prayers. Awe came upon everyone, and many wonders and signs were done through the apostles. (Acts 2:42-43)



I invite you all to join me for a parish wide call to prayer, asking the Holy Spirit, for His guidance, wisdom, and movement to be informed and active disciples of Christ. The call for prayerful discernment, reflection and action began when we were going through our, “Come and See” initiative, which entailed a reflection on, “Divine Renovation,” which Deacon Joe led with our Alpha Sessions.

Bishop Williams is also an avid supporter and proponent of evangelization, which he did in his previous Church by going door to door. Our discernment will be rooted in reflection on our own discipleship and how, why, when, and what we evangelize in our parish and wider community.

We will pray and reflect on the following questions

What is God's plan for Christ Our Light?

What makes Christ our Light special?

How can the parish support our growth in holiness and virtue?

What is needed in the parish to deepen our personal relationship with Jesus?

How have I been a disciple | apostle of Jesus?

This call to discernment is an opportunity to unify our parish around a renewed vision and mission. We will continue to hold prayerful discernment sessions for the next couple of months.

In June we celebrated a first ever in our Diocese, five Sundays that were Solemnities: The Ascension of our Lord, Corpus Christi, The Most Holy Trinity, and the Solemnity of Saints Peter and Paul. It is a most opportune time for us to come together now and answer our call to prayer, discernment, reflection and action. This will help us in our own call to discipleship, our parish's call as a community, and in a wider response to our Diocese and Universal Church.

The discernment evenings will assist in forming The Pastoral Council which will greatly assist me in what will be our first and most important task, to revisit and renew our mission and vision. I hope to have the Pastoral Council established sometime this fall. More information will follow as our discernment evenings continue into September – October of 2025.
