Seeking Finance Council Members



The parish finance council is a consultative body which assists the pastor to act justly and prudently in the administration of the

parish's temporal goods.

The finance council has three main areas of responsibility: 1) Administration and Finance, 2) Facility Management, and 3) Stewardship and Development.

The ways the council fulfills its shared responsibility are: the spiritual enrichment and growth of the members; formation of financial policies, including the devising and regular monitoring of the parish and school budgets; formation of policies for the proper formation of the buildings and grounds of parish and school; long-range financial planning; and attention to civil law pertaining to the administration of temporal goods of the parish.

Scheduled meetings are held four times a year and ad hoc meetings are scheduled, as needed.

The council responsibilities require persons who are skilled in accounting and finance, property and personnel management and business law. The pastor appoints the members. To be considered, the candidate must be a practicing catholic in good standing who participates in the ongoing life of the parish and who is truly expert in financial affairs or business law with outstanding integrity.

The Word

Reading for August 24, 2025

Luke 13: 22 - 30

Adults:

How can you strengthen your commitment to Christ so that you may “enter through the narrow gate?”

We offer this form of *Lectio Divina* (sacred reading) for pondering Scripture and for faith sharing with family members and other people.

- Listen/ Read (*Lectio*): Ponder God’s word and listen for what touches your heart.
- Meditate (*Meditatio*): Attend to what you notice. Allow God’s word to resonate in you.
- Speak/Share (*Oratio*): Prayerfully share with Jesus or with the group your thoughts and feelings.
- Rest in God’s presence (*Contemplatio*): Notice God’s presence and be still, surrounded by God’s love.
- Choose to act (*Actio*): Trusting in God’s nearness, commit to action rooted in love.

Children:

What can you do to be more like Jesus?

Come and See



“Strive to enter through the narrow gate”

Although many Bible passages may require more explanation, this reading is straightforward. Yet,

there are nuances to this reading which we will examine.

The man asks “Lord, are only a few going to be saved?” but Jesus does not really answer the man’s question. Jesus instead replies with the command “Strive to enter the narrow gate...” The word “strive” is translated from a Greek word used for athletic contests or war. Use of this word means that entering the Kingdom of Heaven requires effort, commitment, and a willingness to struggle against temptation and worldly distractions.

Jesus uses the metaphor of a narrow gate to represent the path to salvation and ways of life. Jesus is the only way to be saved. Jesus has taught us through His teachings and commandments what it means to be good. But when we are confronted with choices do we select what is good (narrow gate) or bad (wide gate).

Jesus is also telling the man to stop looking at everyone else and instead focusing on himself. Basically, Jesus is saying “Be focused on you. Are you going to be saved?” Jesus is directing you and me toward self-reflection as well. How confident are we about being saved when the last day comes?

Another aspect of the reading is that Jesus states that the “master of the house” will eventually close the door. We know our time on earth is numbered and that it can happen at any time and should always be ready.

The rock group Pink Floyd song “Time” contains these poignant lyrics:

“And you are young and life is long, and there is time to kill today
And then one day you find ten years have got behind you
No one told you when to run, you missed the starting gun
And you run and you run to catch up with the sun but it's sinking”

What are you doing to be saved? Don’t miss the starting gun.

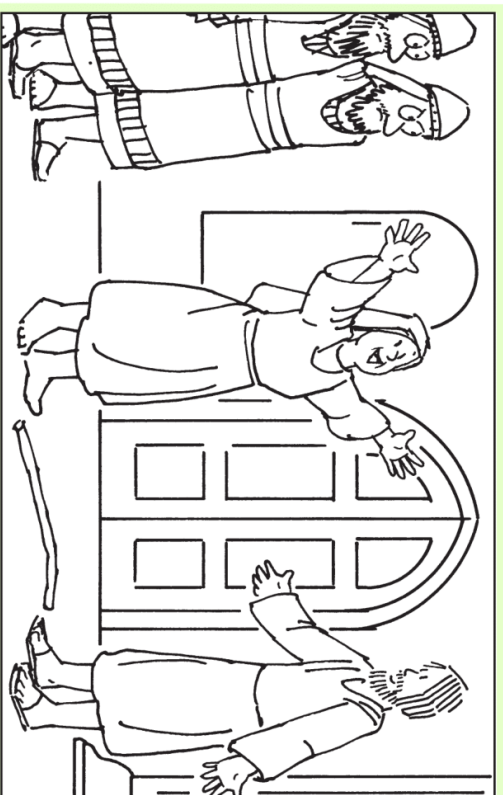

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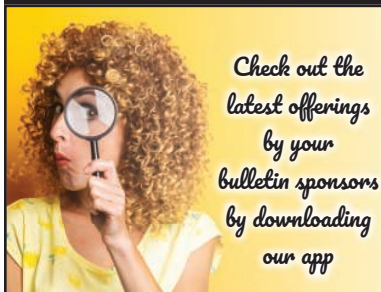
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
