One of the main principles of living a Stewardship lifestyle is to give without expecting anything in return. This is difficult for some to comprehend in our "consumerist" culture that we live in. This is even difficult for many parish communities that have become heavily dependent on parish fundraising events to support the mission and ministry of their local parish. Generally speaking, at a parish fundraiser, you pay money and receive something in return, it's just a financial transaction. This is opposed to our parish offertory at Holy Mass, where you unite your sacrifice with Jesus', renewing our covenant relationship with Him.

Seeking Finance Council Members



The parish finance council is a consultative body which assists the pastor to act justly and prudently in the administration of the

parish's temporal goods.

The finance council has three main areas of responsibility: 1) Administration and Finance, 2) Facility Management, and 3) Stewardship and Development.

The ways the council fulfills its shared responsibility are: the spiritual enrichment and growth of the members; formation of financial policies, including the devising and regular monitoring of the parish and school budgets; formation of policies for the proper formation of the buildings and grounds of parish and school; long-range financial planning; and attention to civil law pertaining to the administration of temporal goods of the parish.

Scheduled meetings are held four times a year and ad hoc meetings are scheduled, as needed.

The council responsibilities require persons who are skilled in accounting and finance, property and personnel management and business law. The pastor appoints the members. To be considered, the candidate must be a practicing catholic in good standing who participates in the ongoing life of the parish and who is truly expert in financial affairs or business law with outstanding integrity.

Come and See



HOPE... just a 4-letter word being proclaimed as that paradoxical exhortation resounding in homilies that sounds so naïve and impossible in light of concrete

evidence of devastation and darkness all around us. Time and again our late beloved Pope Francis reminded us of the wisdom of the Scriptural challenge in the Letter to the Hebrews: "*Keep your eyes fixed on Jesus.*" (Ch. 12) And, **HOPE** is the theme he chose for our present Jubilee Year!

Even the N.Y. TIMES has adopted this perspective. Imagine my shockful wonder when I saw in huge, bold letters on the entire cover page of the Opinion Section in the 7/27/25 issue a simple message --- **H O P E!**

HOPE is the enduring sense, even in the midst of troubles, that it is all in God's control, that God's loving Word will have the final say, not to be confused with wishful thinking. **HOPE** is simply a matter of taking Jesus at his word, trusting that he keeps his promises. Jesus didn't promise that our path would always be smooth, but he did promise to walk beside us to the end of the road. He didn't promise that our lives would be without pain and disillusionment, but he did promise that he would bring new life and growth out of our pain. **HOPE** is simply a matter of taking Jesus at his word. How often he admonished: "Do not be afraid".

For me, as a Dominican Sister of **HOPE**, how can I not heed the truth of the message of **HOPE** in the midst of a world suffering from violence, injustice, starvation, endless poverty. We need to be liberated from empty promises that omit the enduring promise of a faithful God: "**I AM WITH YOU ALWAYS!**"
