Luke 14: 25 - 33

Adults:

We offer this form of *Lectio Divina* (sacred reading) for pondering Scripture and for faith sharing with family members and other people.

- Listen/ Read (*Lectio*): Ponder God's word and listen for what touches your heart.
- Meditate (*Meditatio*): Attend to what you notice. Allow God's word to resonate in you.
- Speak/Share (*Oratio*): Prayerfully share with Jesus or with the group your thoughts and feelings.
- Rest in God's presence (*Contemplatio*): Notice God's presence and be still, surrounded by God's love.
- Choose to act (*Actio*): Trusting in God's nearness, commit to action rooted in love.

Children:

What can you do to follow Jesus more closely?

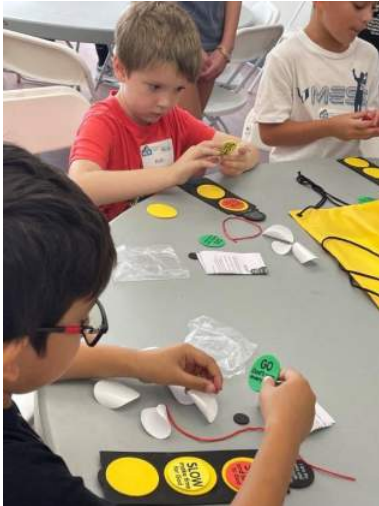

This summer, I was **blessed** with the opportunity to take part in Christ Our Light's Leadership Service Week (*Sunday-Friday*), where I saw how faith and kindness can shine through in every-day moments. My peers and I served at two organizations in Camden: Urban Promise and Mighty Writers.

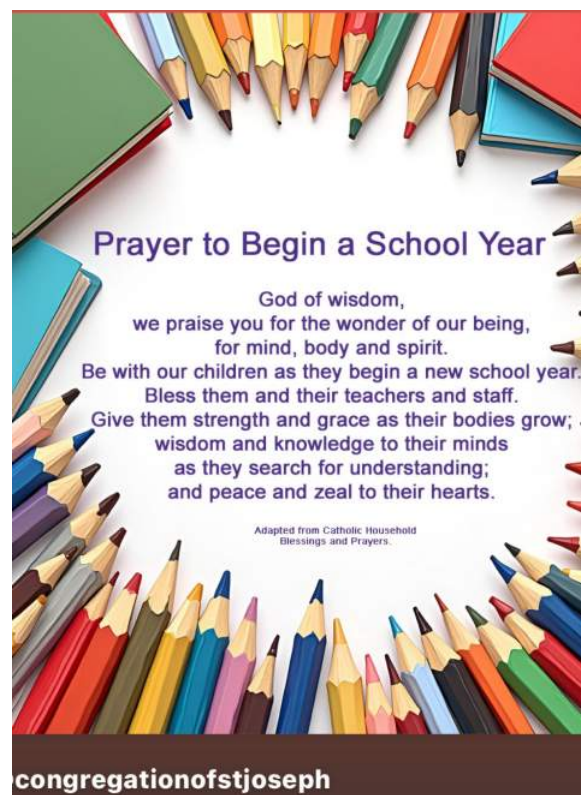
At Urban Promise, I worked with middle school students in "Camp Spirit." On our second day, their art teacher, a Rutgers Art scholar, wasn't feeling well, so my friends and I along with the kids made artwork to brighten her day. Their excitement and care demonstrated how even simple acts of kindness can make a big difference. It was a powerful reminder that when a community comes together in faith, anything is possible. Later in the week, we volunteered at Mighty Writers, an organization that helps children read but we were there helping with food distribution.



While serving, I had a funny and memorable moment with an elderly woman who caught me by surprise. What began as a startled reaction quickly turned into laughter we shared together. That moment reminded me that **we are all God's children, navigating life in our own way, yet always connected by His love.** These experiences opened my eyes to the many ways faith can be lived out including caring for one another, spreading joy, and recognizing God's presence in the people around us.

This week of service strengthened my faith and reminded me that **God connects us all.** At the conclusion of our service week, I left feeling grateful, inspired, and ready to live more fully as the person God is calling me to be.

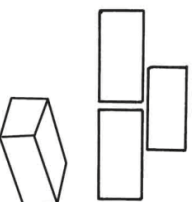
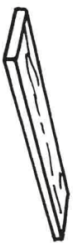

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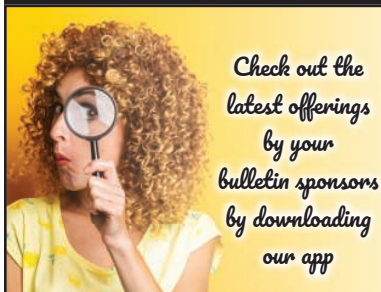
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
