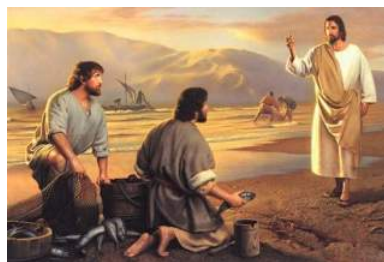

Come and See



The scripture readings for this Twenty-Fifth Sunday in Ordinary Time are challenging and thought-provoking. In the first reading, the prophet Amos chastises those who store up wealth for themselves

through selfishness, dishonesty and disregard for the dignity and well-being of others. The Gospel gives us the parable of the steward who is entrusted with managing another's household and related affairs. He is expected to be faithful to the owner's intentions and accountable for how he is managing the resources placed in his care. However, the steward is found to be wasteful and irresponsible, serving his own interests over that of the household's owner. As always, there is a teaching here for us.

By virtue of our creation, we are stewards in the household of God. We are collaborators with our Creator God and with one another in this earthly home that we share. The riches that have been entrusted to each of us include time, resources, our skills and talents, our personality and character traits, and our very lives. Everything we are and have has been given to us as gift by our gracious God. However, these riches have not been given for ourselves alone. God trusts us to also use the gifts we've been given for the well-being of others and of Earth itself. The Holy One depends on each of us to use what has been entrusted to us to advance the good that God desires for the household.

How do we know the good that God desires? Jesus is the One who reveals God's desire for us. If we ponder the life of Jesus as seen in the Gospels, we see that all in the household are treated with equal dignity and respect. Jesus moves with compassion towards those who have been pushed to the margins of society. He offers wholeness and healing to those who are in need physically, emotionally, and spiritually. He bends low to wash the feet of others and willingly dies to self so that greater life might come. The way he relates with others reveals that union with God and neighbor are inseparable. All are one in the household of God! Jesus puts flesh on the ways, the desires, of God—the One we call Divine Love.

As we allow the Word of God for this week to be "a lamp to [our] feet and a light to [our] path" (*Psalms 119:105*), I invite you to prayerfully reflect: What do I consider to be the "riches" of my life? How readily do I give God thanks for them? Do I live with "an attitude of gratitude"? . . . Why and for what purpose am I in this world? . . . Who do I want to be for others? . . . Who am I for God?

Together, let us be good stewards in the household of God. May who we are and what we have reveal the desire and presence of Divine Love in our midst!

Luke 16: 1 - 13

- Choose to act (*Actio*): Trusting in God’s nearness, commit to action rooted in love.

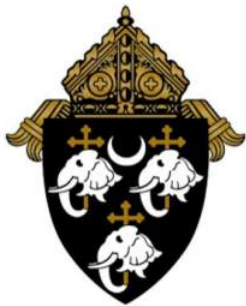

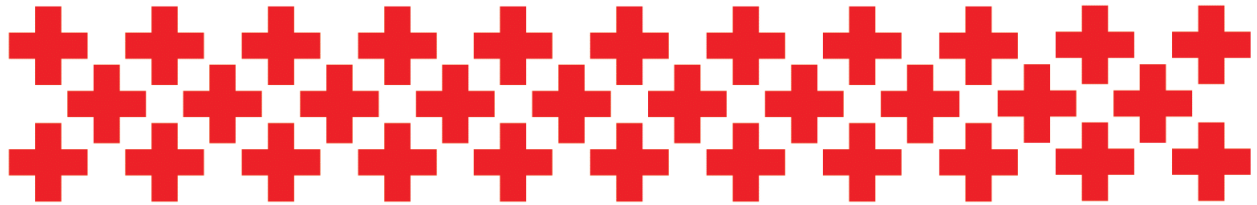

This Summer....

Back in NJ Vacation Bible School brought a whole new kind of joy—watching our youth step up as mentors, guiding younger kids and realizing their own gifts. Of course, no summer week is complete without food and laughter. Whether it was authentic Mexican food, Passarellios' salads, compliments of Susan, Johnny's pizza, Raising Cane, Shake Shack evening, or Deb's famous brownies, sharing meals reminded us how good it feels to simply be together.

Service Week stretched us in the best way—challenging us to look outward to those in need and inward to our own hearts. We wrestled with a big question: Who am I in a suffering world? Along the way, we dug into Catholic Social Teaching—learning about dignity, solidarity, care for creation, the option for the poor, and what it really means to be part of a community that protects rights and responsibilities. Our hands and hearts were busy: helping at Urban Promise's children's camp, serving food with Mighty Writers, stocking shelves at the Tuesday Cherry Hill Food Pantry, and standing in solidarity at SSI Neighborhood in August.

Through every prayer, shared meal, and act of service, our circle grew wider, and our faith grew deeper. We became more than just a group—we became a stronger Eucharistic community, rooted in goodness and righteousness. And none of it would have been possible without our amazing summer leaders—Mustard Seed, Mighty Writers, Urban Promise, SSI, CHFP, Margie, Drew, Domenica, David, Deb, Susan, Leslie, and Kathy. Your leadership and love turned this summer into something we'll carry with us always: a testimony of faith, fellowship, and belonging.
