Call to Prayer to the Holy Spirit

**A Parish-wide call to prayer to the Holy Spirit
Discernment, Reflection, and Action Towards a Pastoral Council
Wednesday October 1st at 7pm in the St. Mary's Room (Parish Center)**

They devoted themselves to the teaching of the apostles and to the communal life, to the breaking of the bread and to the prayers. Awe came upon everyone, and many wonders and signs were done through the apostles. (Acts 2:42-43)



I invite you all to join me for a parish wide call to prayer, asking the Holy Spirit, for His guidance, wisdom, and movement to be informed and active disciples of Christ. The call for prayerful discernment, reflection and action began when we were going through our, "Come and See" initiative, which entailed a reflection on, "Divine Renovation," which Deacon Joe led with our Alpha Sessions.

Bishop Williams is also an avid supporter and proponent of evangelization, which he did in his previous Church by going door to door. Our discernment will be rooted in reflection on our own discipleship and how, why, when, and what we evangelize in our parish and wider community.

We will pray and reflect on the following questions

What is God's plan for Christ Our Light?

What makes Christ our Light special?

How can the parish support our growth in holiness and virtue?

What is needed in the parish to deepen our personal relationship with Jesus?

How have I been a disciple | apostle of Jesus?

This call to discernment is an opportunity to unify our parish around a renewed vision and mission. We will continue to hold prayerful discernment sessions for the next couple of months.

This past June we celebrated a first ever in our Diocese, five Sundays that were Solemnities: The Ascension of our Lord, Corpus Christi, The Most Holy Trinity, and the Solemnity of Saints Peter and Paul. It is a most opportune time for us to come together now and answer our call to prayer, discernment, reflection and action. This will help us in our own call to discipleship, our parish's call as a community, and in a wider response to our Diocese and Universal Church.

The discernment evenings will assist in forming The Pastoral Council which will greatly assist me in what will be our first and most important task, to revisit and renew our mission and vision. I hope to have the Pastoral Council established by January 1, 2026. More information will follow as our discernment evenings continue through October and November of 2025.

Luke 16: 19 - 31

Just a reminder that Membership dues of \$25 are now due. See Carolyn Taylor at our welcome table before and during the October 14th meeting if you have not already paid.

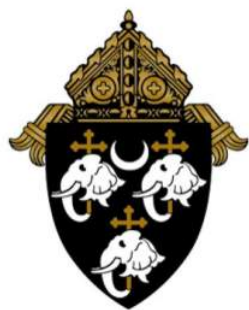

... was a lived expression of Genesis 1:26—a reminder that we're ALL created in God's image and called to reflect love. We kicked things off with an incredible week of immersion.

It started with Mass at the Cathedral in Montego Bay, con-celebrated with Fr. Jon Thomas, Vicar General at the diocese of Camden, a beach day where the waves became the soundtrack for our prayers.

Under the sun, surrounded by God's creation, we spent time in silence, singing, service, and gratitude with the children of Mustard Seed Communities. Throughout our time in Jamaica with the Archdiocese of Montego Bay and Mustard Seed, we saw God's presence in every face and felt the strength and dignity of His people.

Back in NJ Vacation Bible School brought a whole new kind of joy—watching our youth step up as mentors, guiding younger kids and realizing their own gifts. Of course, no summer week is complete without food and laughter. Whether it was authentic Mexican food, Passarellios' salads, compliments of Susan, Johnny's pizza, Raising Cane, Shake Shack evening, or Deb's famous brownies, sharing meals reminded us how good it feels to simply be together.

Service Week stretched us in the best way—challenging us to look outward to those in need and inward to our own hearts. We wrestled with a big question: Who am I in a suffering world? Along the way, we dug into Catholic Social Teaching—learning about dignity, solidarity, care for creation, the option for the poor, and what it really means to be part of a community that protects rights and responsibilities. Our hands and hearts were busy: helping at Urban Promise's children's camp, serving food with Mighty Writers, stocking shelves at the Tuesday Cherry Hill Food Pantry, and standing in solidarity at SSI Neighborhood in August.

Through every prayer, shared meal, and act of service, our circle grew wider, and our faith grew deeper. We became more than just a group—we became a stronger Eucharistic community, rooted in goodness and righteousness. 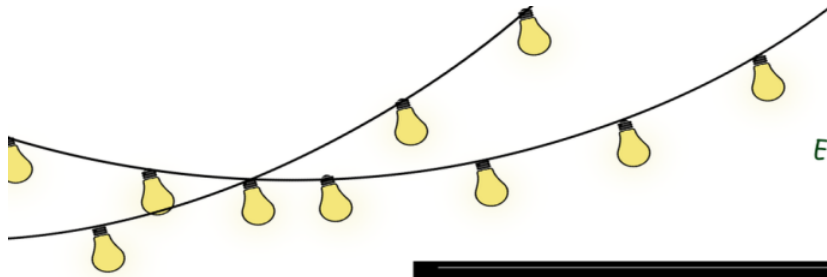

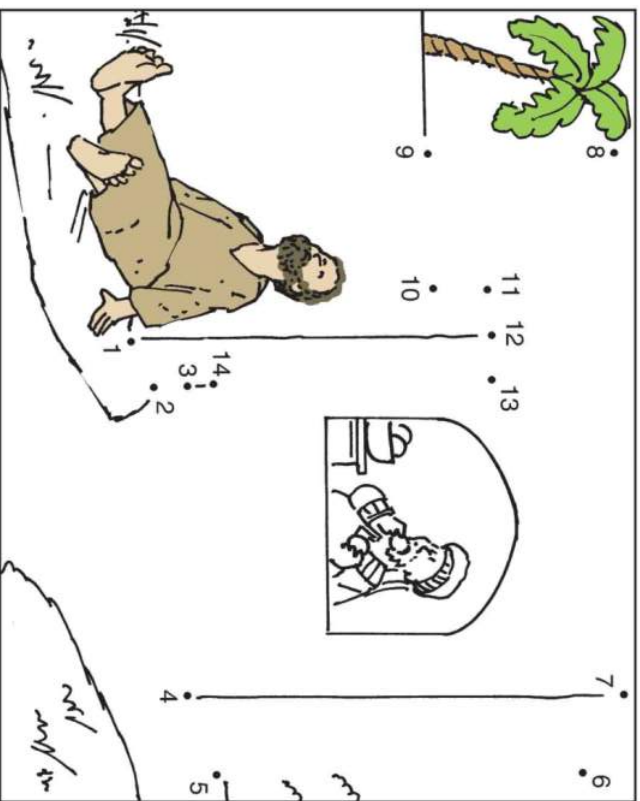

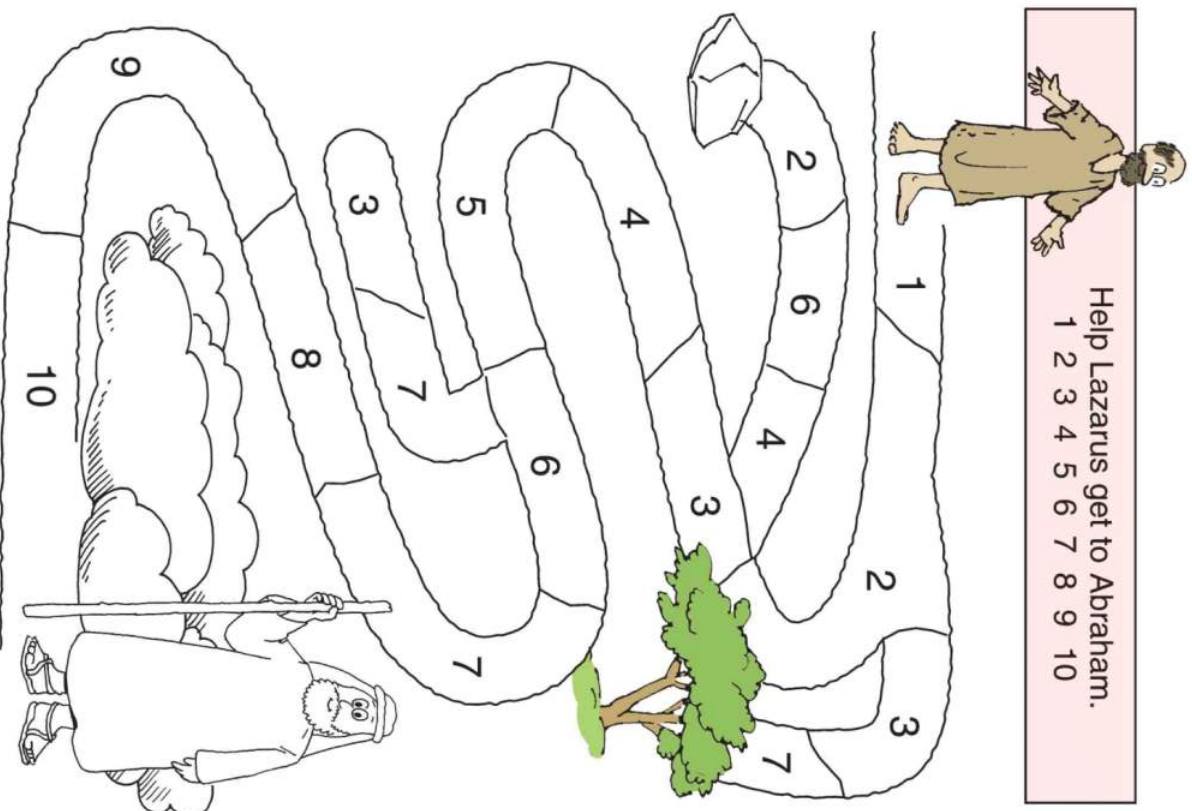
