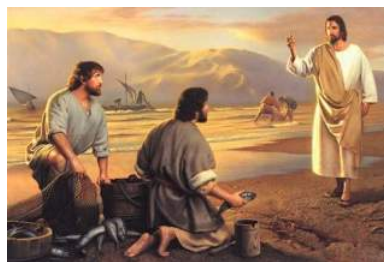

Come and See



"And one of them, realizing he had been healed, returned, glorifying God in a loud voice; and he fell at the feet of Jesus and thanked Him."

In our Gospel today, Jesus healed ten people who were afflicted with leprosy, but only one of them returned to thank Him. Why? It seems that all ten were healed on the surface (i.e., their skin), but something more happened to the Samaritan. It wasn't just his skin that was healed, but his heart and mind as well. His response? Not just a mere thank you, but a vocal and physical response in praise of Jesus for all to see.

So, which of the lepers do we identify with today? Are we like the nine who receive God's blessings and continue on our way each day, maybe saying a quick, surface-level "Thank you, God" in our head as we move on to the next task? Or, like the Samaritan, do we recognize God's blessings in our lives and actually *witness with a loud voice to those around us? Do we fall on our knees to thank and praise God? Are we too embarrassed to tell others when we received God's blessings? Do we chalk our good fortunes up to coincidence, or are we mindful that these blessings, big or small, are gifts from God? (I like to call them the "God Winks" of everyday life!)*

As we go into this new week, let us remember the words of today's psalm, Psalm 98, that remind us to say more than a mere thanks to God but to actually sing to the Lord for all of his wondrous deeds in our lives: "Sing joyfully to the Lord, all you lands: break into song, sing praise!"

Luke 17: 11 - 19

Adults:

How do you show gratitude for what God has given you?
Why is showing gratitude important?

We offer this form of *Lectio Divina* (sacred reading) for pondering Scripture and for faith sharing with family members and other people.

- Listen/ Read (*Lectio*): Ponder God's word and listen for what touches your heart.
- Meditate (*Meditatio*): Attend to what you notice. Allow God's word to resonate in you.
- Speak/Share (*Oratio*): Prayerfully share with Jesus or with the group your thoughts and feelings.
- Rest in God's presence (*Contemplatio*): Notice God's presence and be still, surrounded by God's love.
- Choose to act (*Actio*): Trusting in God's nearness, commit to action rooted in love.

Youth:

What is something you are grateful for in your life and how do you show your appreciation for it?

Children:

Can you think of something someone has given you that you were happy to get? Did you thank them for it?

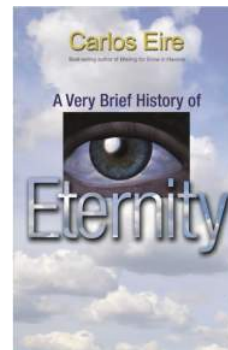
Congratulations to our own Paul Goebel on his ordination to the diaconate!

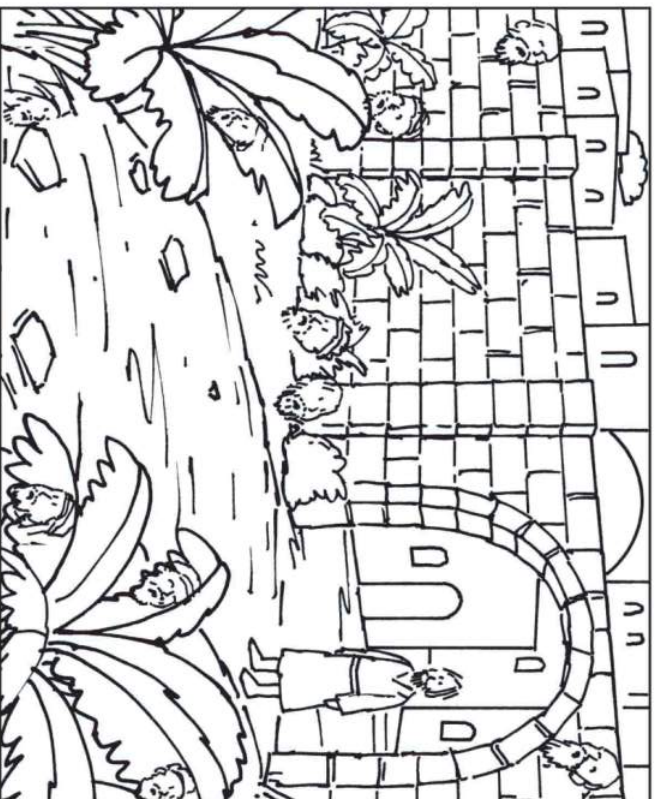

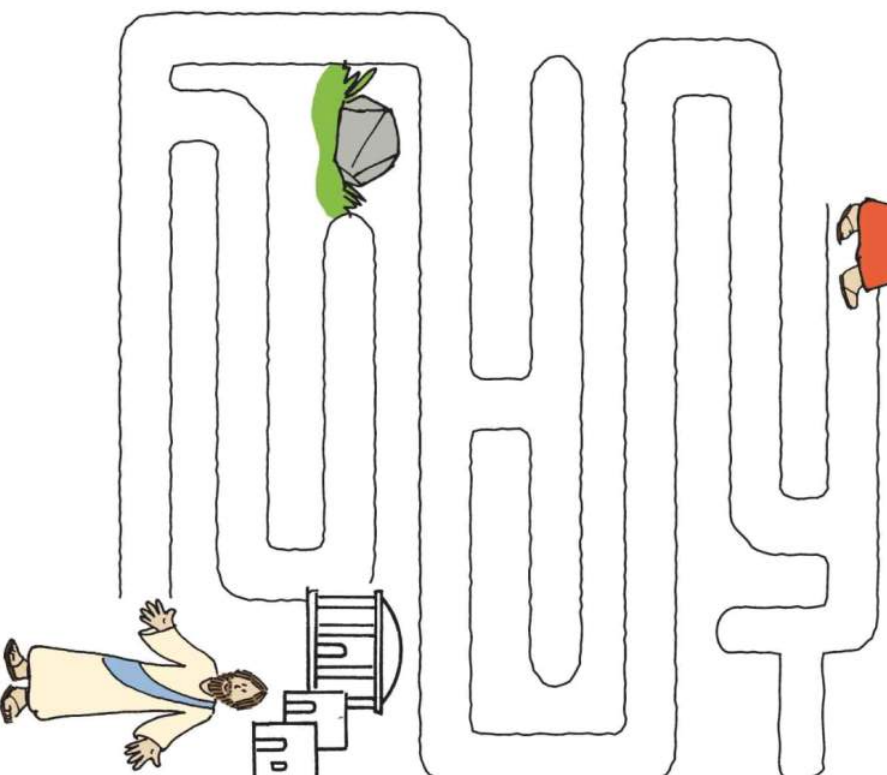
